SILCA SPA was the 388th largest importer of beef from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 744 tons. This is a 68% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, SILCA SPA sources from 298 municipalities, or 10% of the beef production municipalities. The main destination of the beef imported by SILCA SPA is ITALY, accounting for 100% of the total.
