



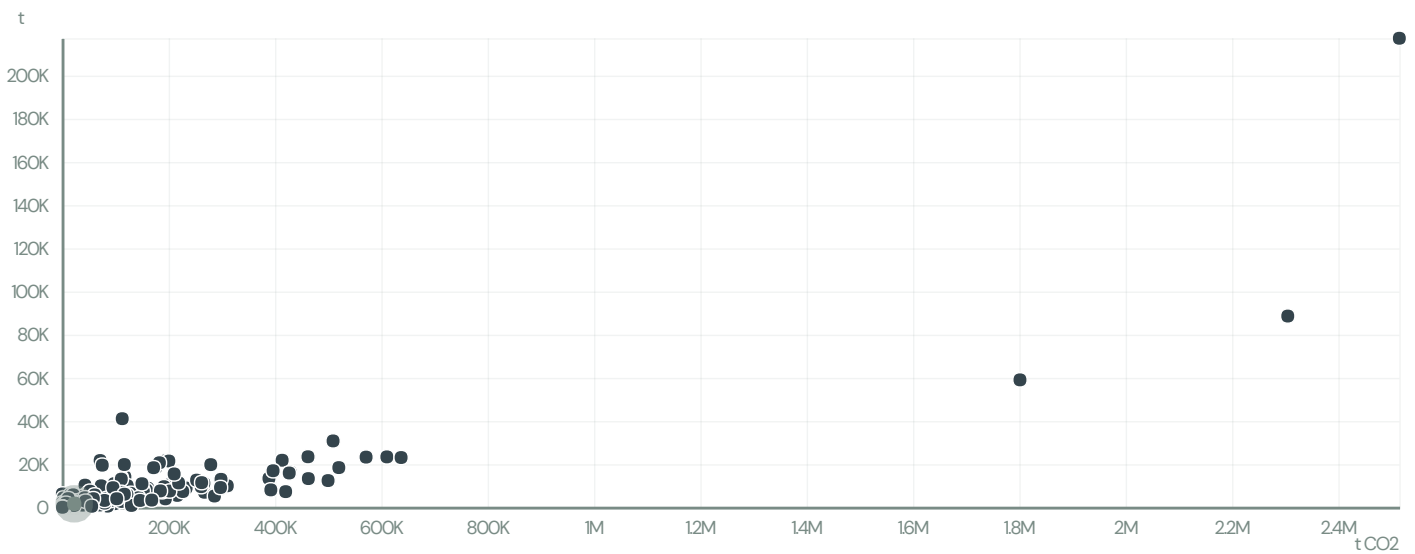
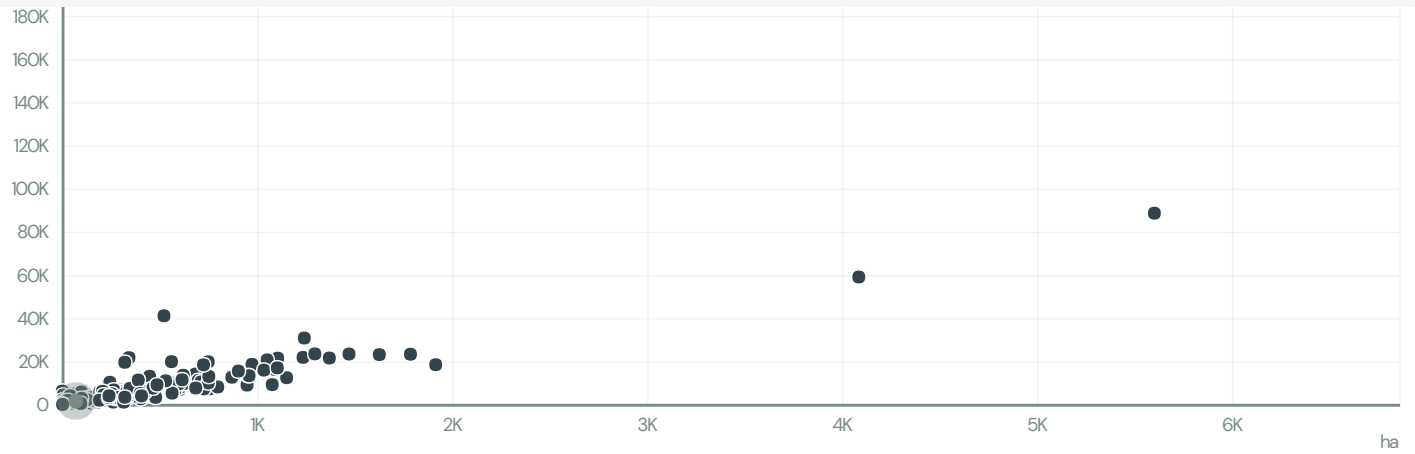
# IRAN GARMENT CO

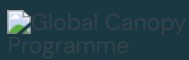
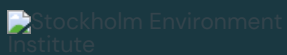
IRAN GARMENT CO was the 209th largest importer of beef from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 2 thousand tons. This is a 18% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, IRAN GARMENT CO sources from 99 municipalities, or 3% of the beef production municipalities.
