



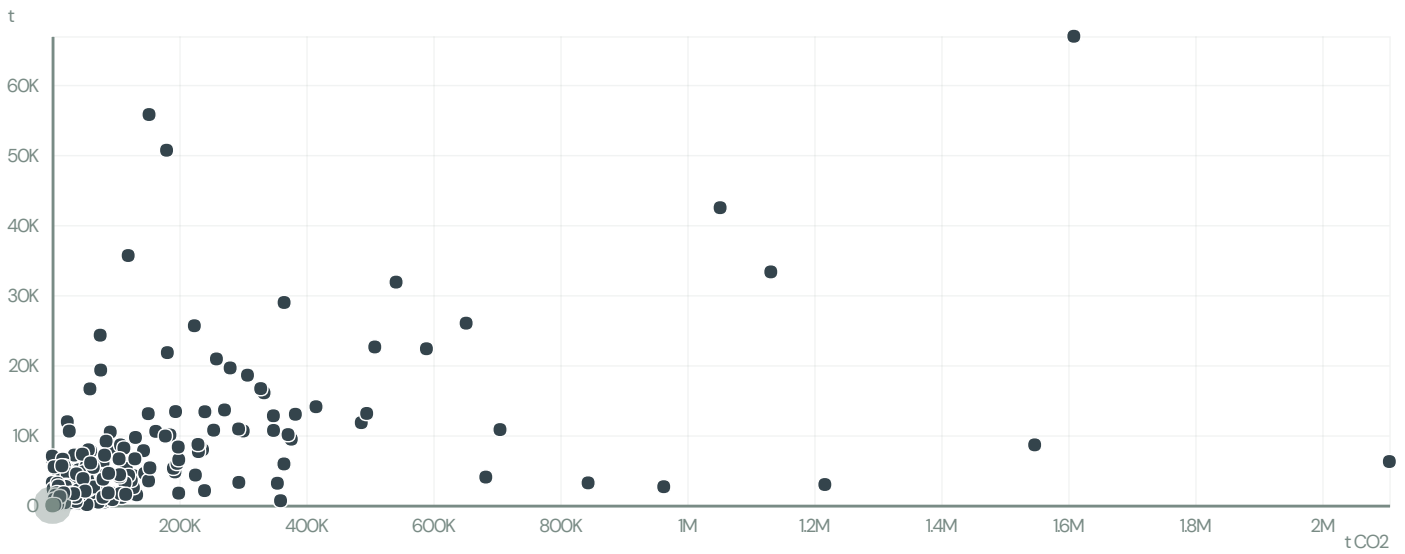
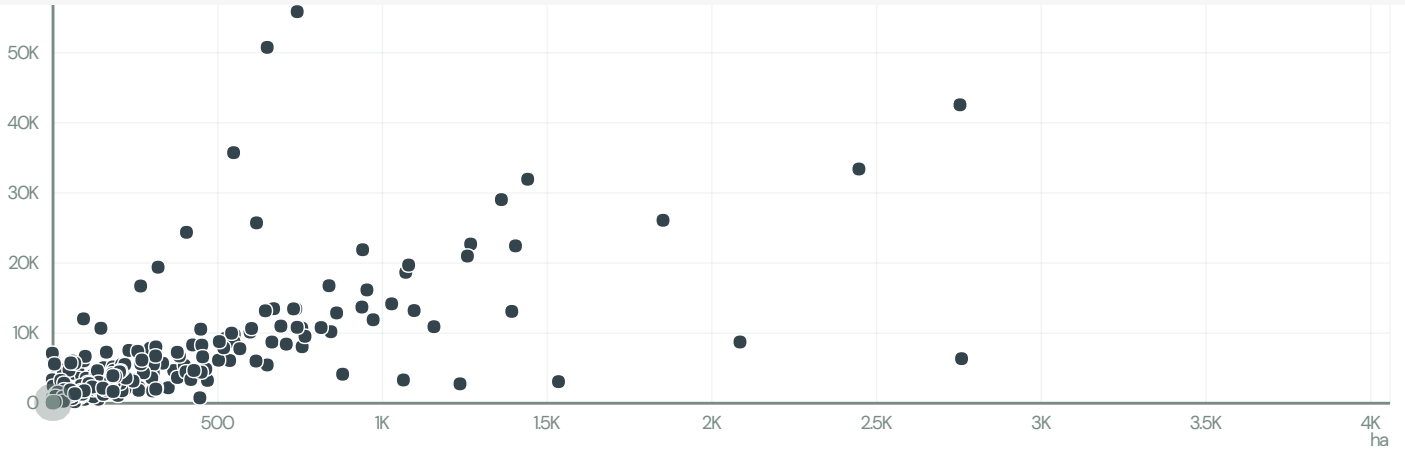

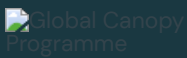
ULANTA was the 1454th largest importer of beef from BRAZIL in 2016, accounting for 32 tons. This is a 59% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, ULANTA sources from 43 municipalities, or 2% of the beef production municipalities.
