S&m international commodities was the 669th largest importer of beef from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 281 tons. This is a 255% increase vs the previous year. As an importer, S&m international commodities sources from 160 municipalities, or 6% of the beef production municipalities. The main destination of the beef imported by S&m international commodities is China (hong kong), accounting for 100% of the total.
