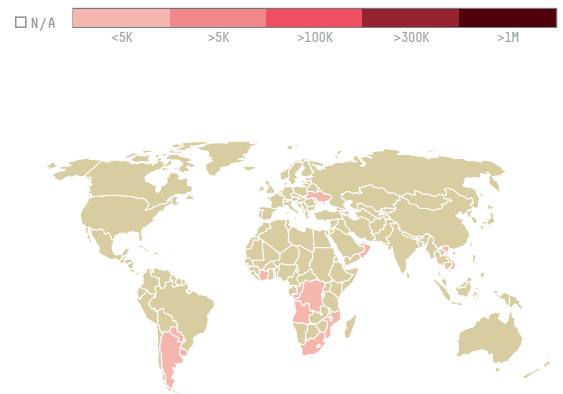
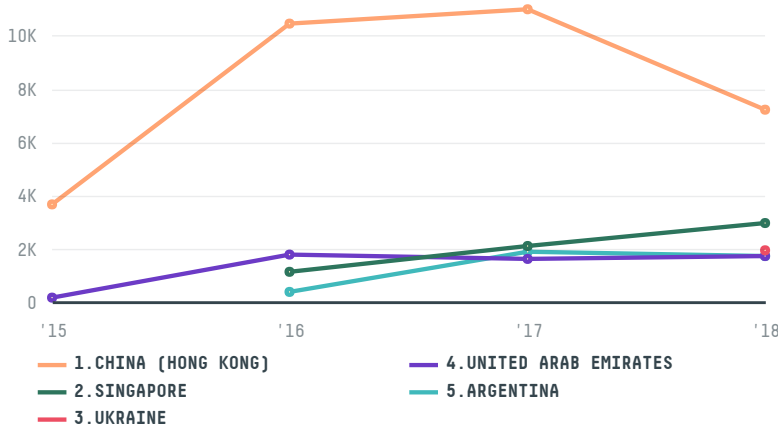


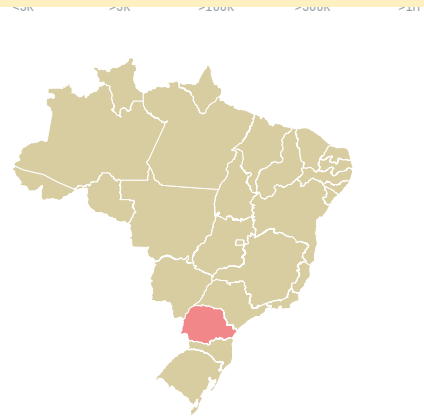
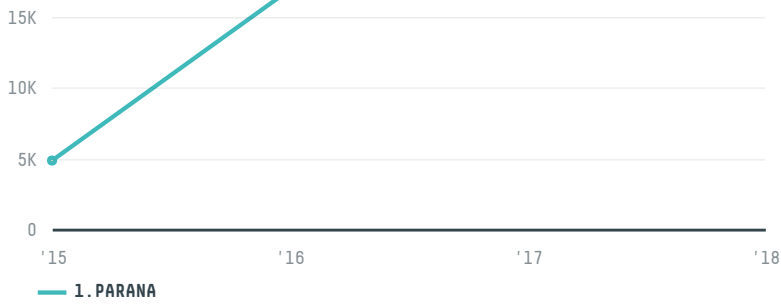
# CASTROLANDA - COOPERATIVA AGROINDUSTRIAL

The main destination of the pork exported by CASTROLANDA - COOPERATIVA AGROINDUSTRIAL is CHINA (HONG KONG), accounting for 35% of the total.

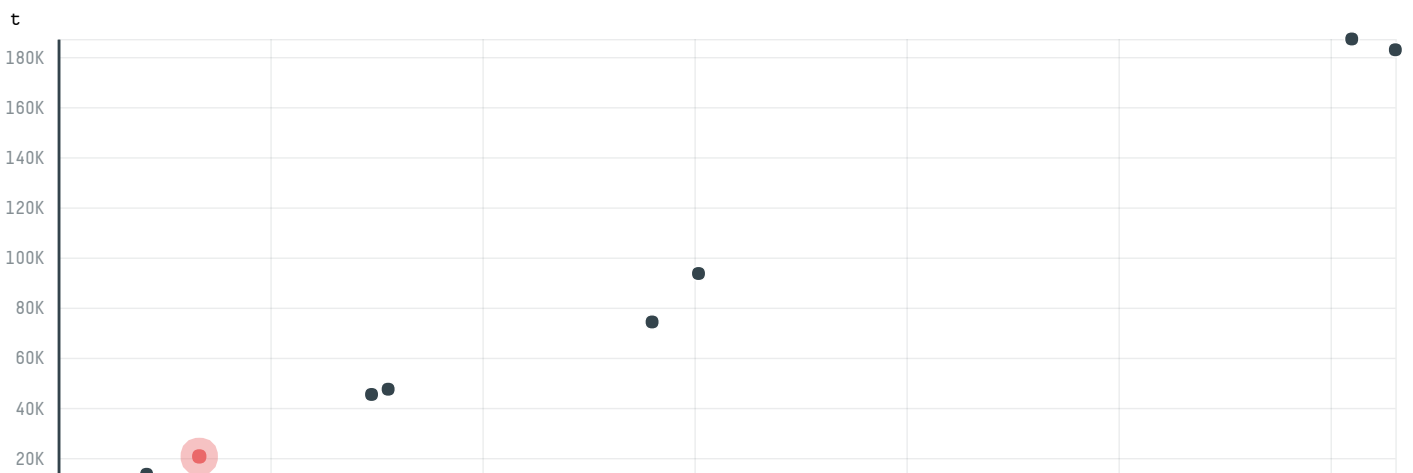
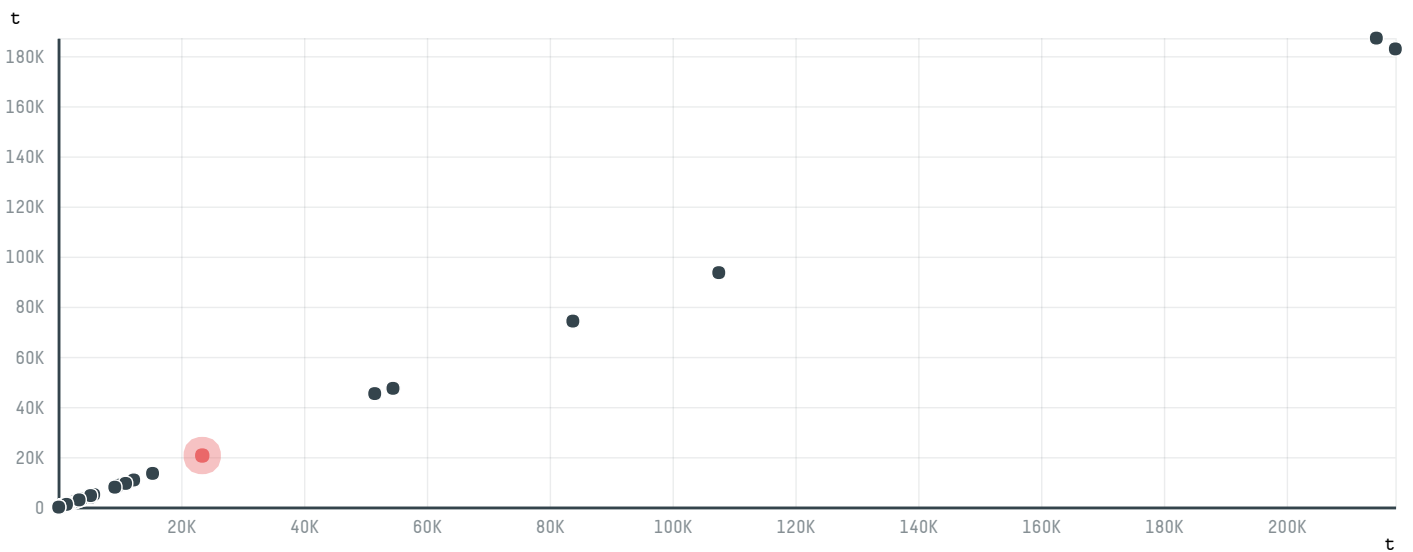
