EVIA FOODS was the 165th largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 106 tons. This is a 293% increase vs the previous year. As an importer, EVIA FOODS sources from 7 municipalities, or 2% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by EVIA FOODS is ANGOLA, accounting for 75% of the total.

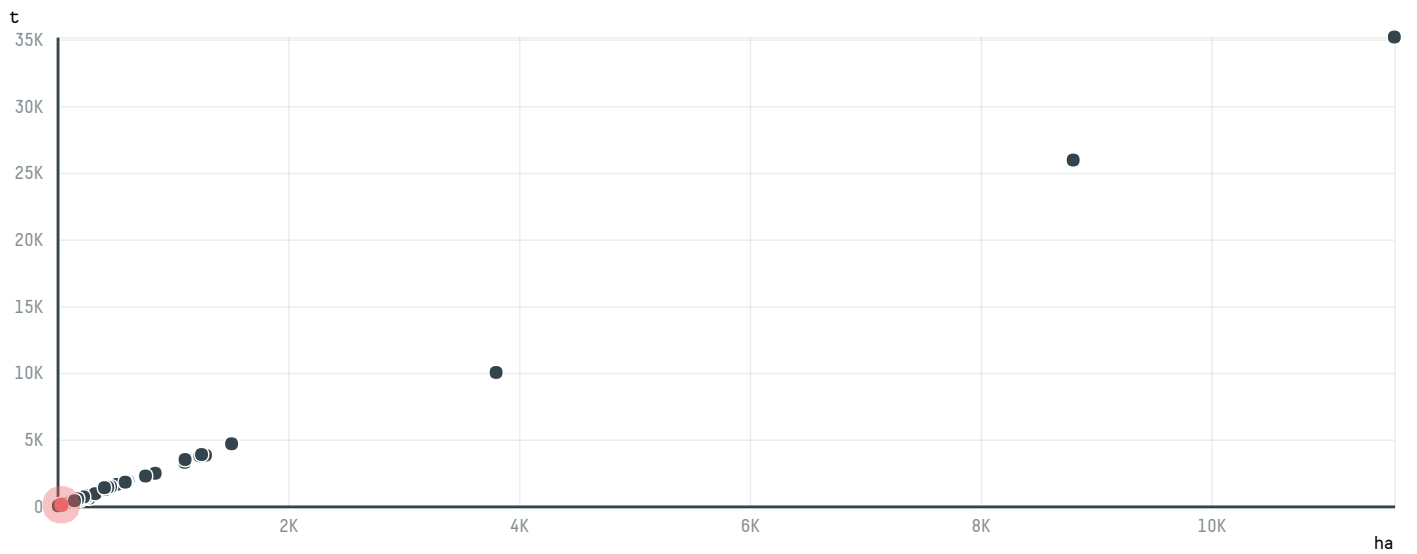
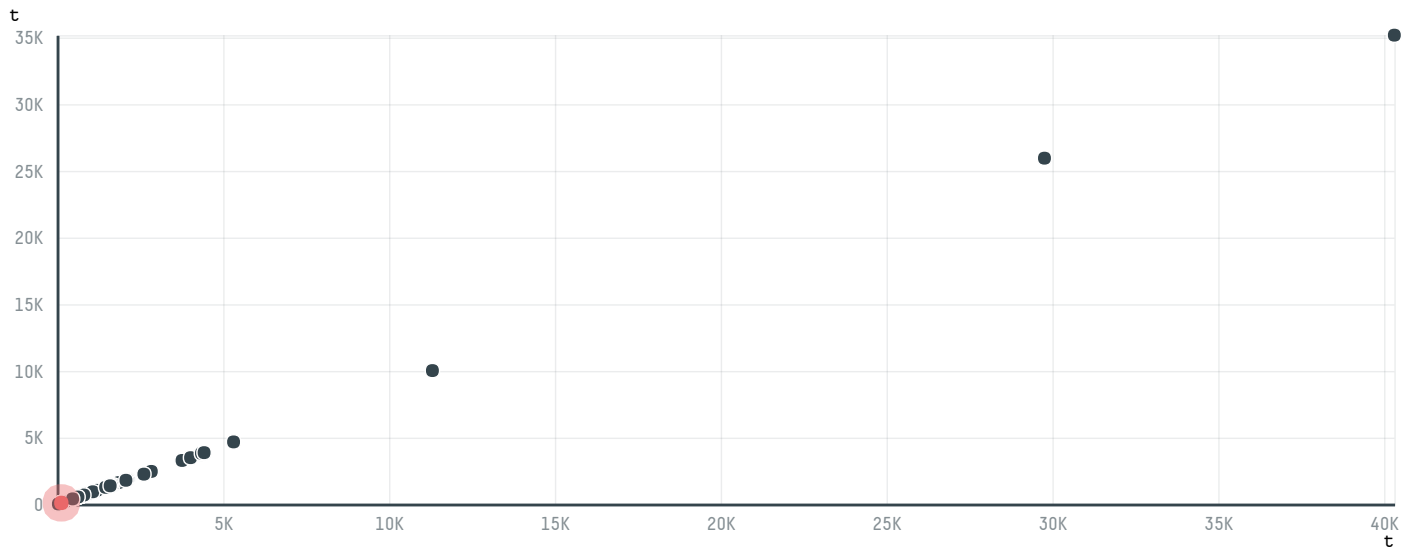
