



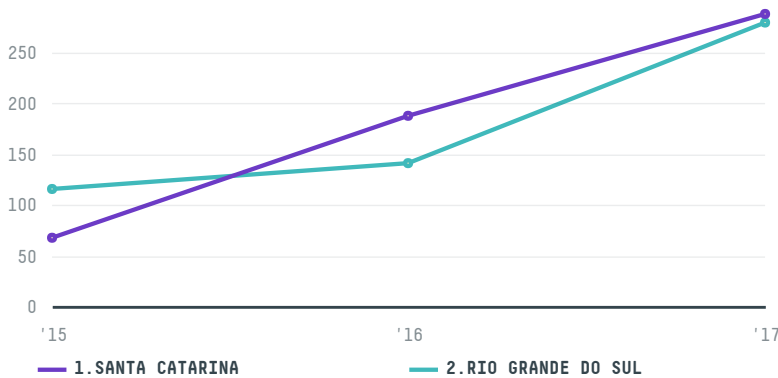
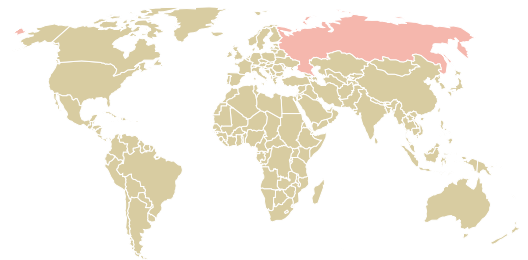
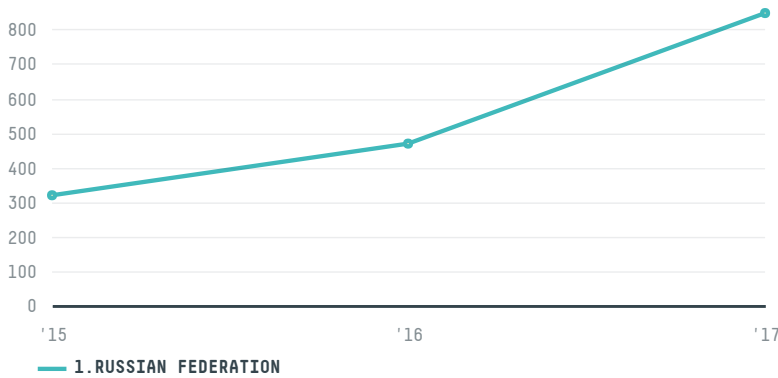

CITYGRAND was the 110th largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 847 tons. This is a 80% increase vs the previous year. As an importer, CITYGRAND sources from 10 municipalities, or 4% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by CITYGRAND is RUSSIAN FEDERATION, accounting for 100% of the total.

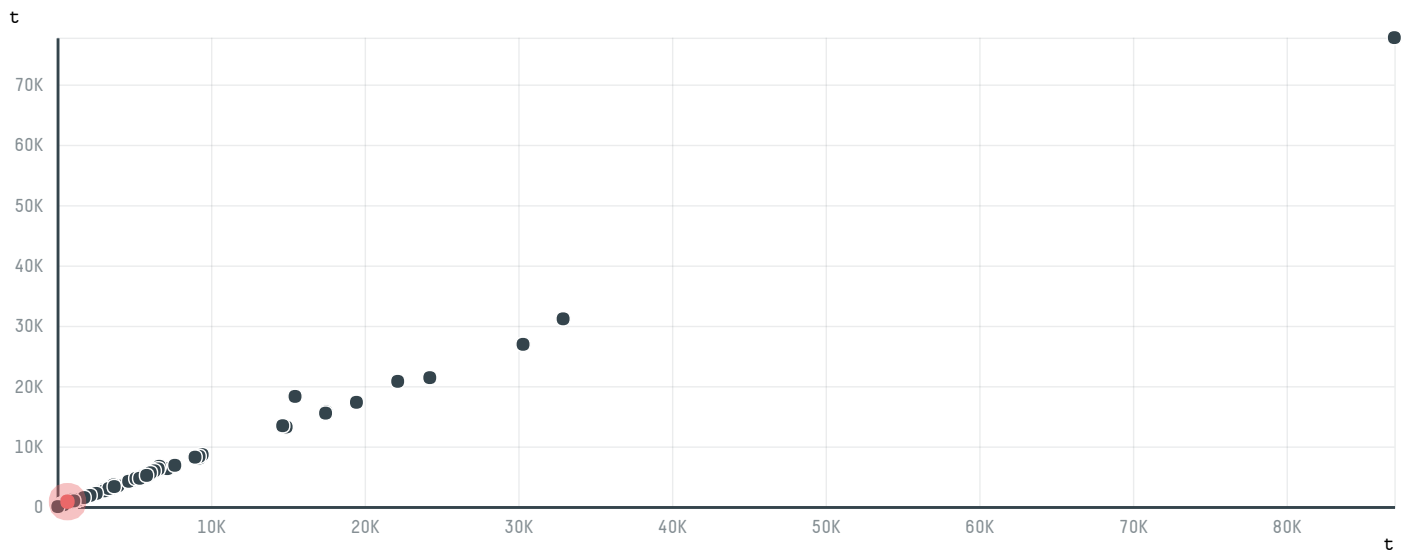
