



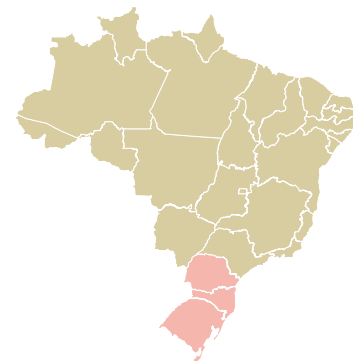
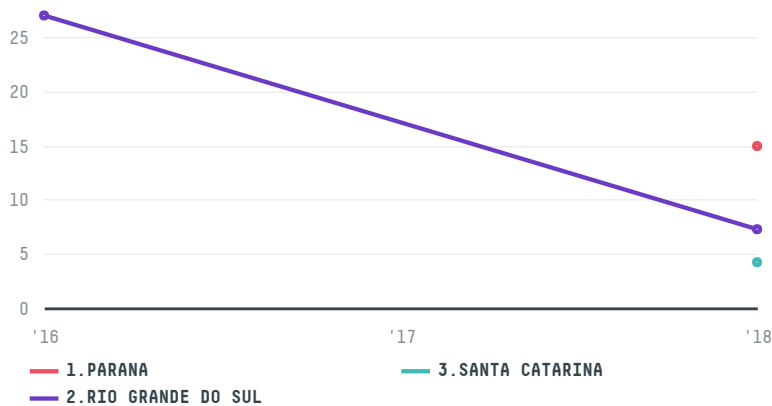
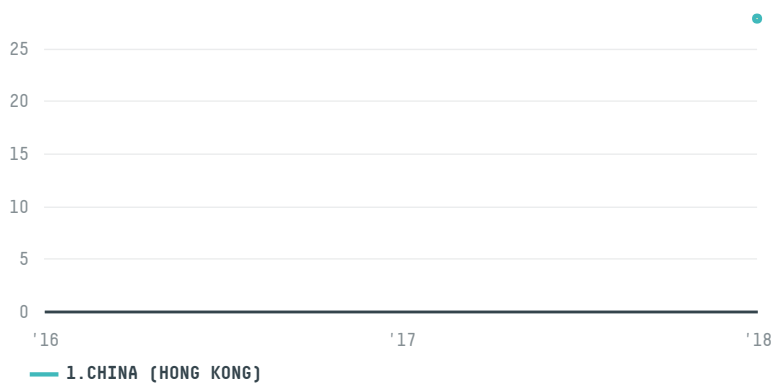

GPS FOOD GROUP was the 259th largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 28 tons. As an importer, GPS FOOD GROUP sources from 12 municipalities, or 3% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by GPS FOOD GROUP is CHINA (HONG KONG), accounting for 100% of the total.

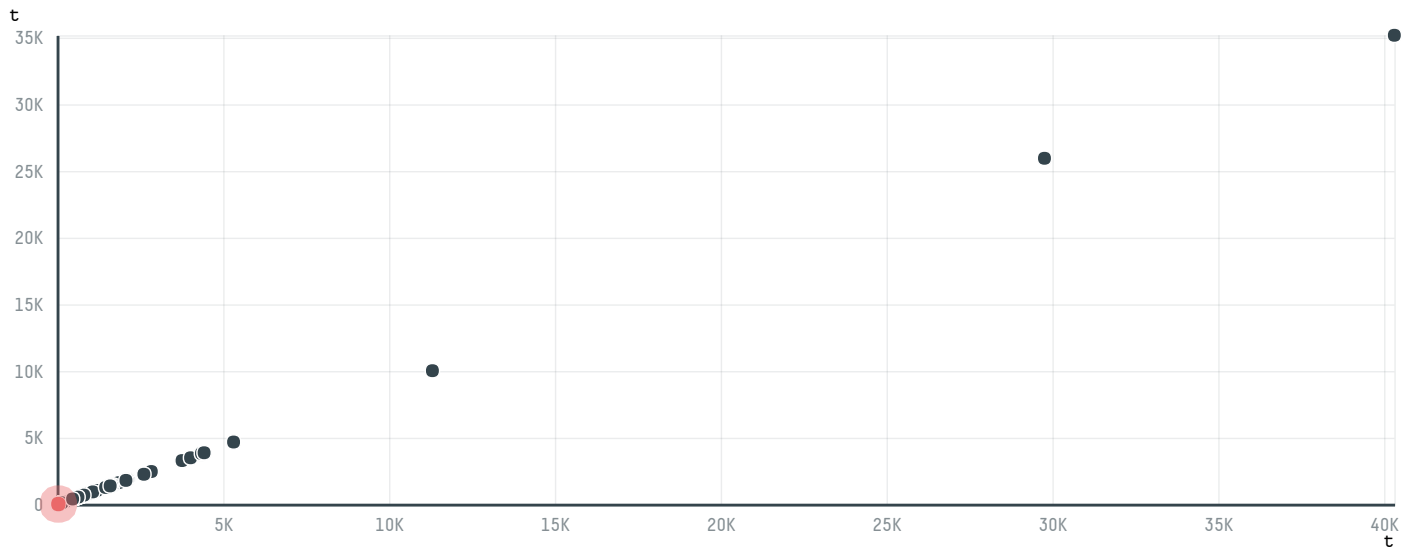

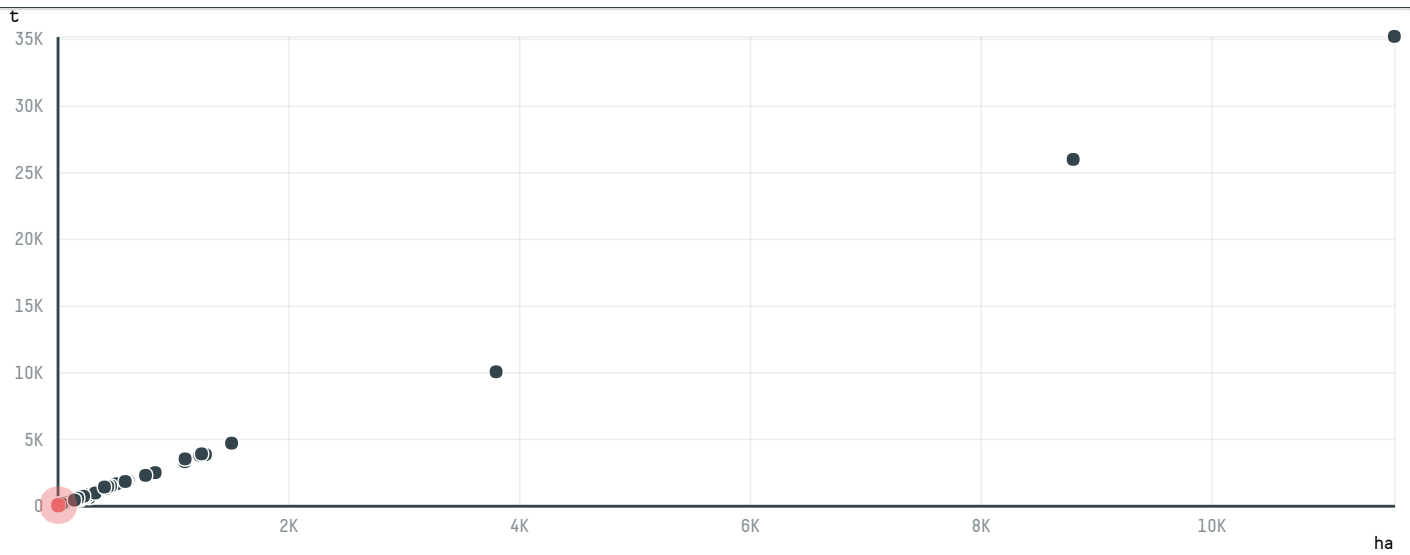
