



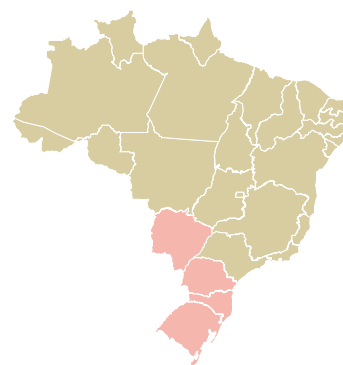
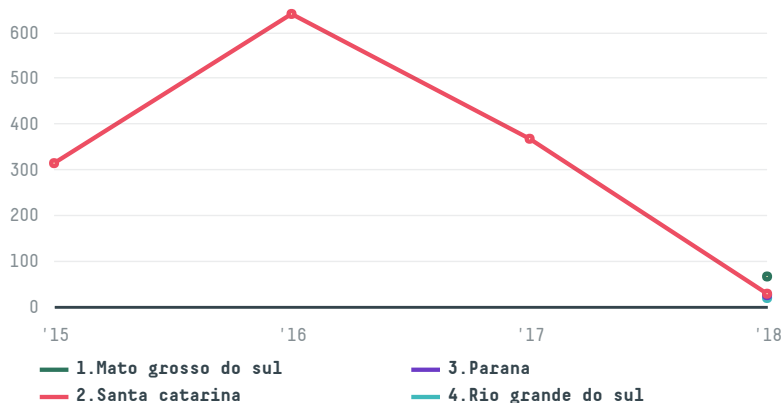

GANADERA ABAROA was the 136th largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 137 tons. This is a 63% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, GANADERA ABAROA sources from 11 municipalities, or 3% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by GANADERA ABAROA is Chile, accounting for 100% of the total.

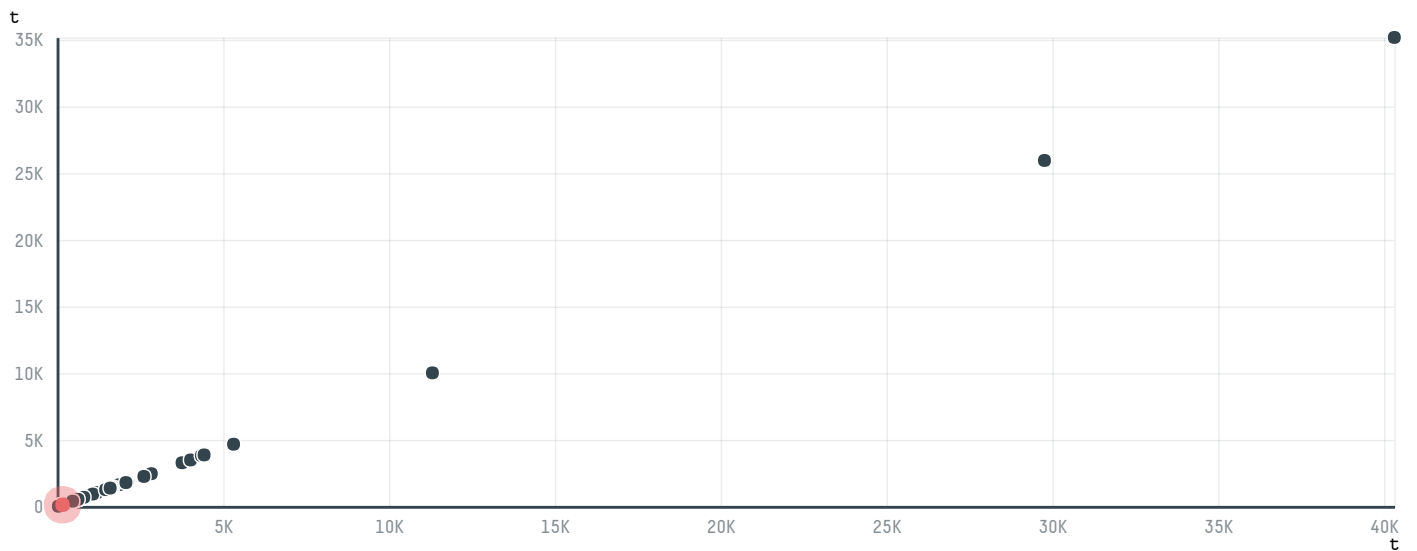

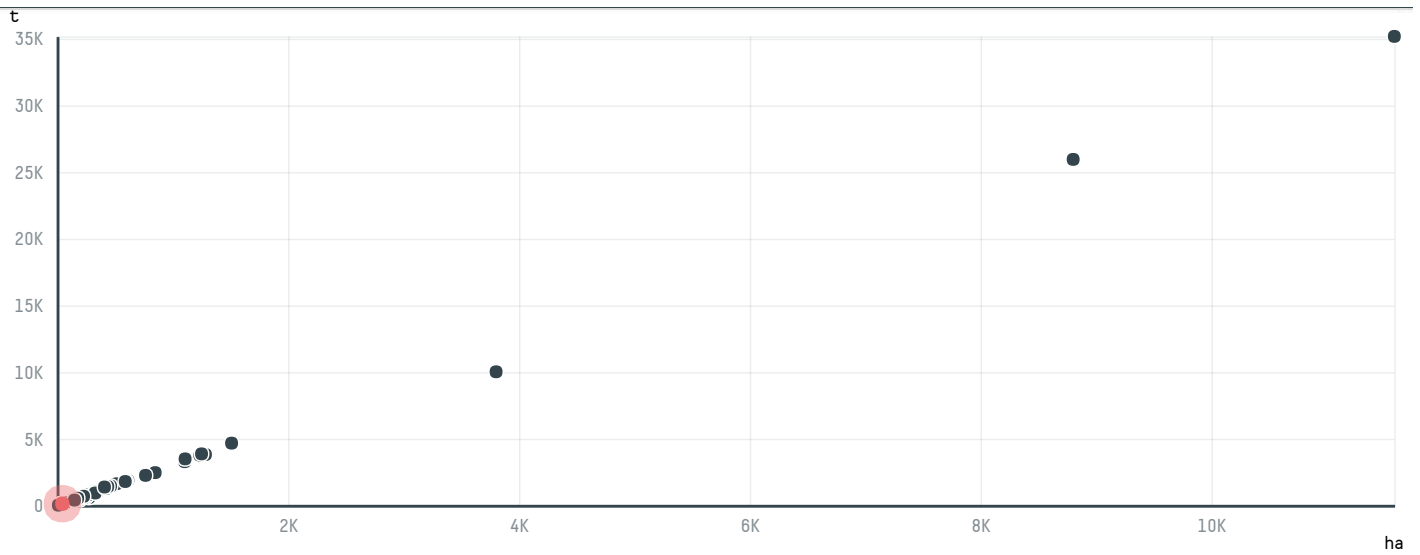
