ERESUR S.A was the 48th largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 550 tons. This is a 49% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, ERESUR S.A sources from 11 municipalities, or 3% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by ERESUR S.A is URUGUAY, accounting for 100% of the total.

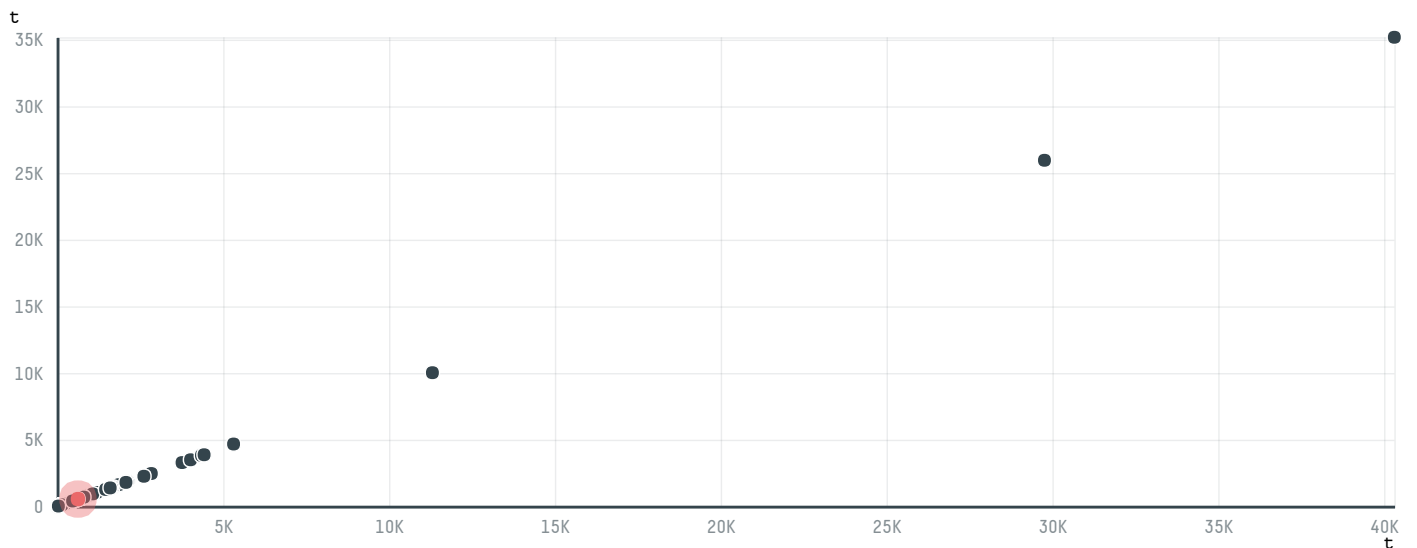

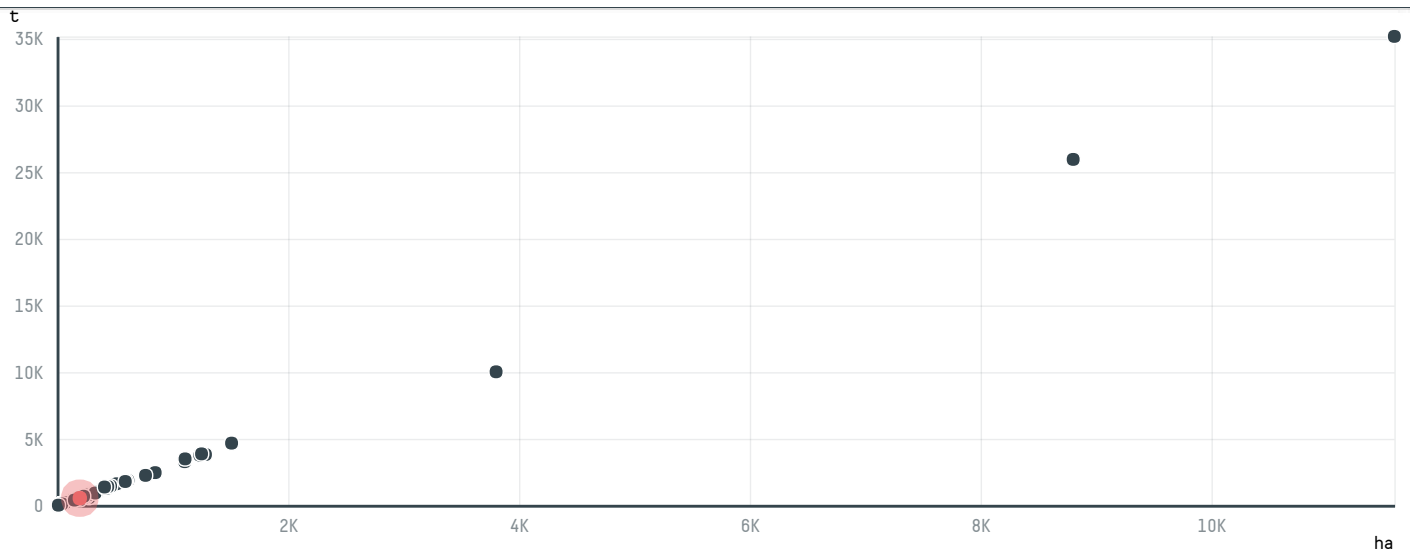
