AJC INTERNATIONAL was the 5th largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 4 thousand tons. This is a 71% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, AJC INTERNATIONAL sources from 63 municipalities, or 18% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by AJC INTERNATIONAL is SINGAPORE, accounting for 22% of the total.

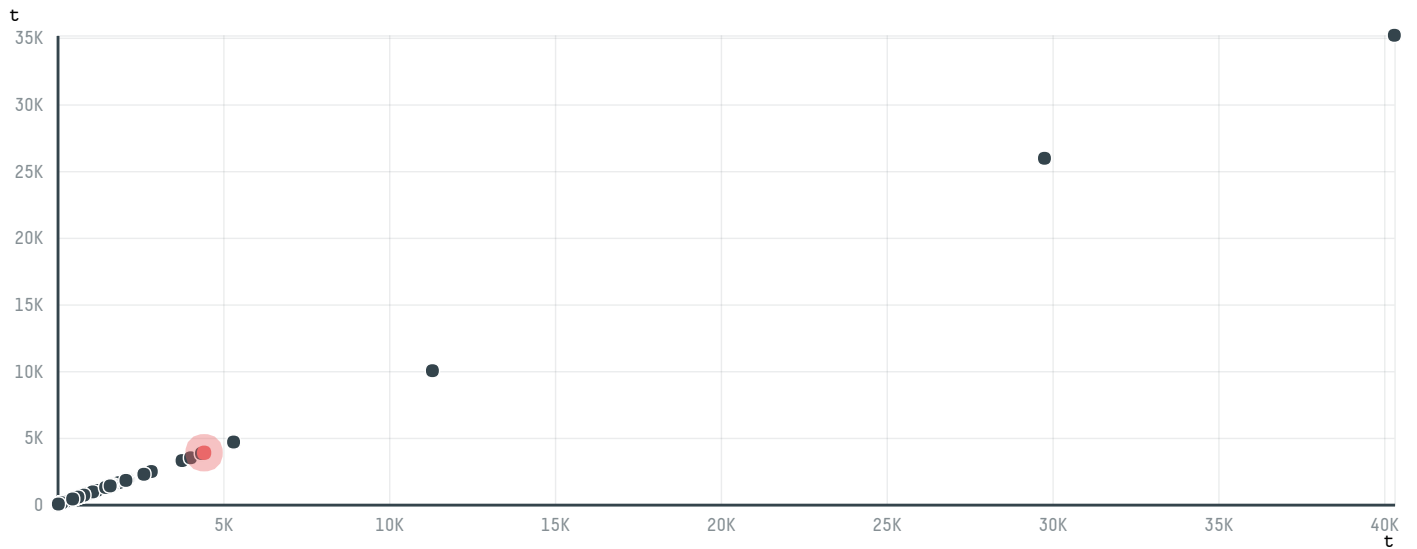

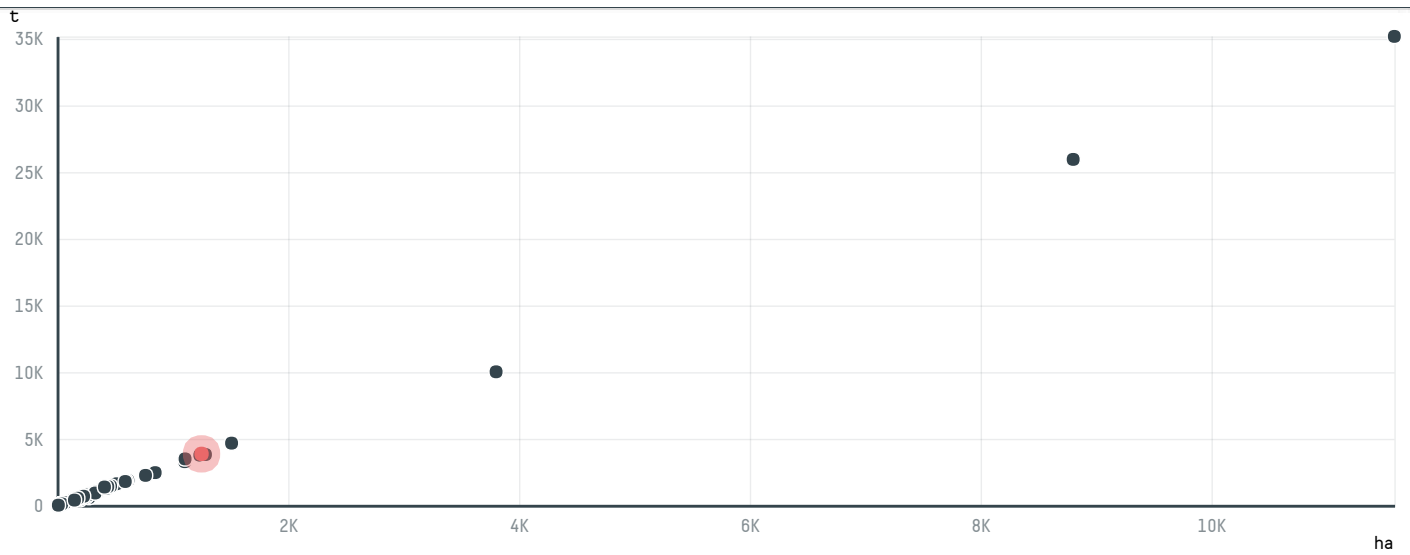
