OLAM was the 576th largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2016, accounting for 27 tons. This is a 75% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, OLAM sources from 1 municipalities, or 0% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by OLAM is ARMENIA, accounting for 100% of the total.

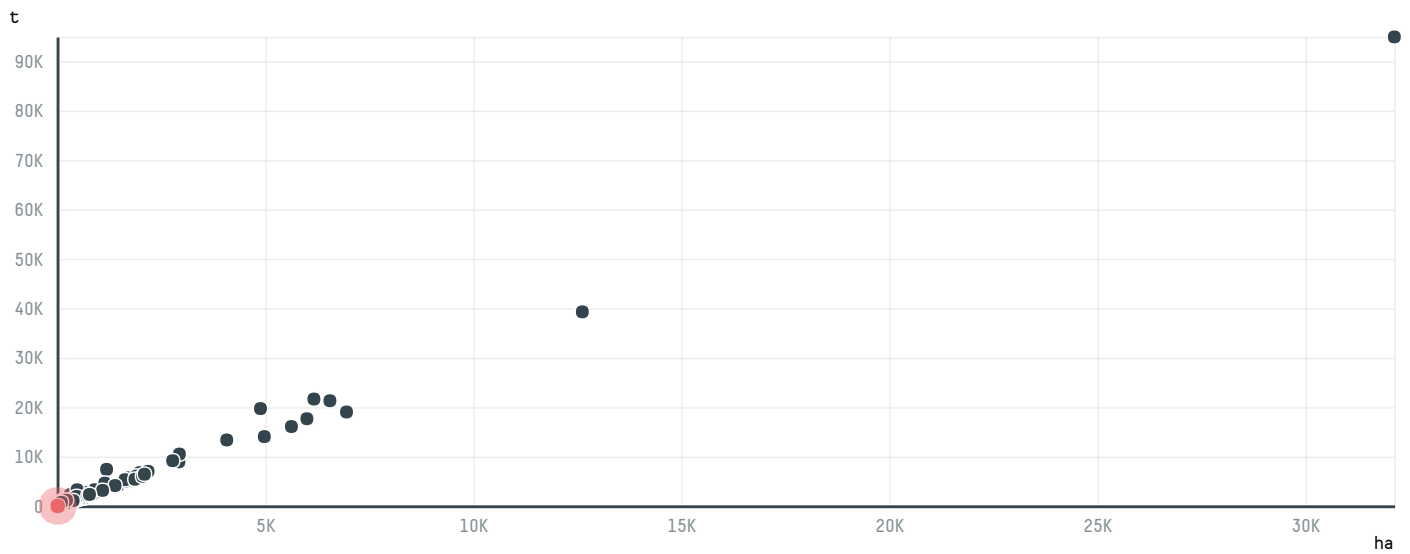
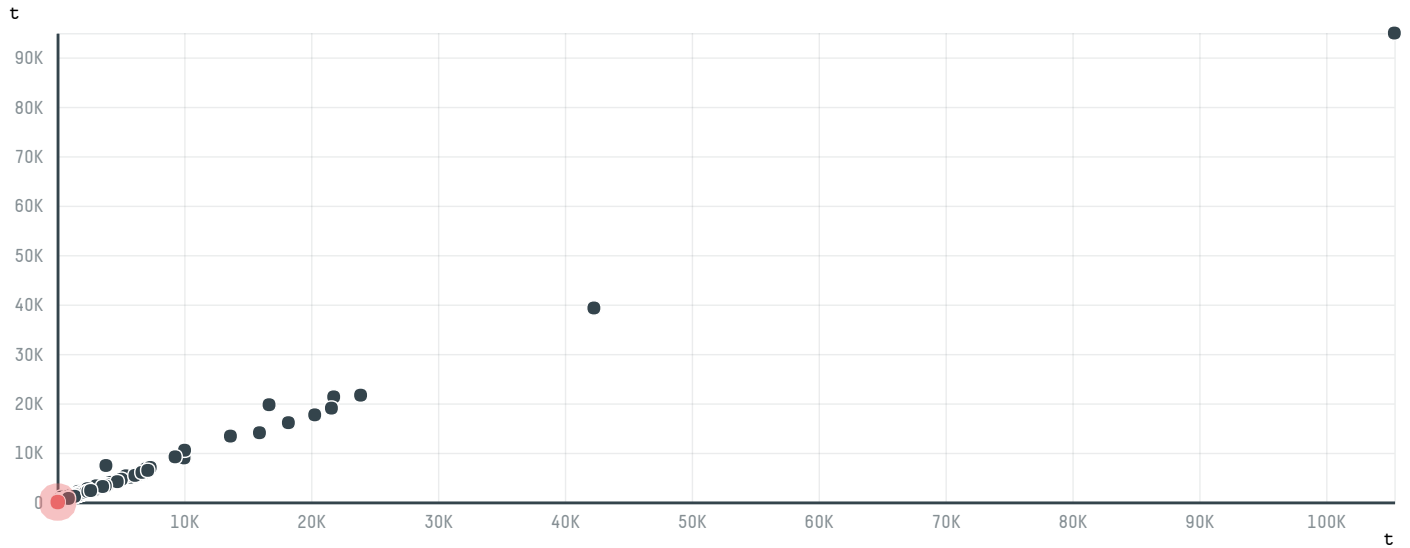

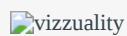
COMPARING COMPANIES IMPORTING PORK FROM BRAZIL IN 2016
