PARKER MIGLIORINI INTL GMBH was the 34th largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 729 tons. This is a 83% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, PARKER MIGLIORINI INTL GMBH sources from 40 municipalities, or 11% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by PARKER MIGLIORINI INTL GMBH is CHINA (HONG KONG), accounting for 70% of the total.

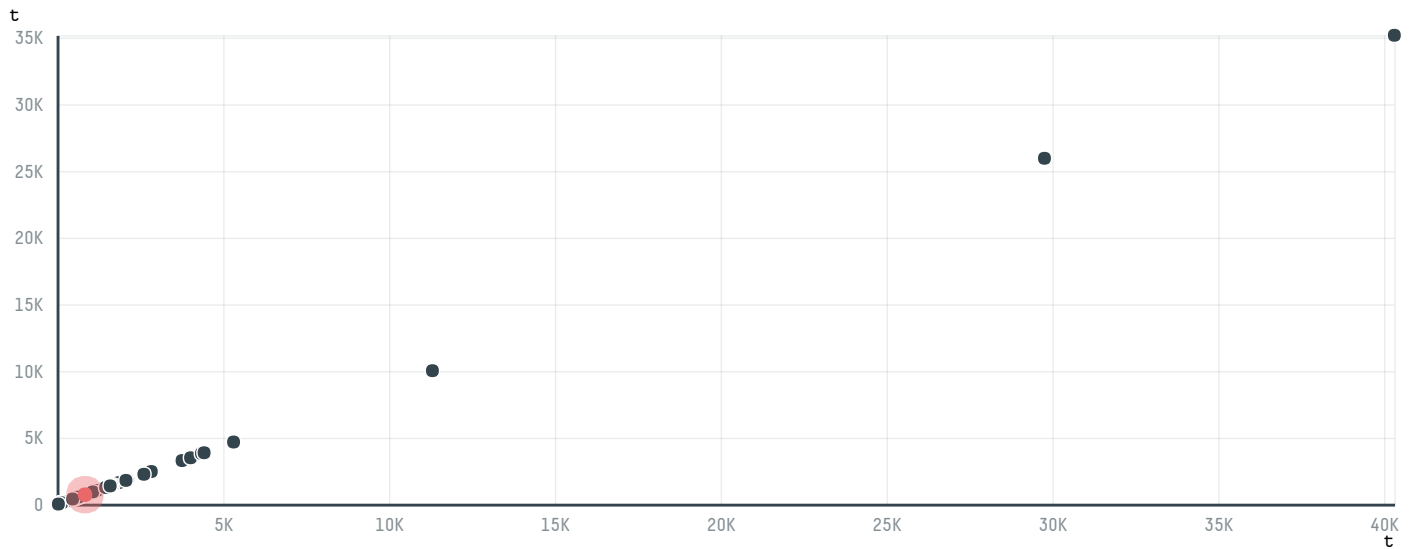

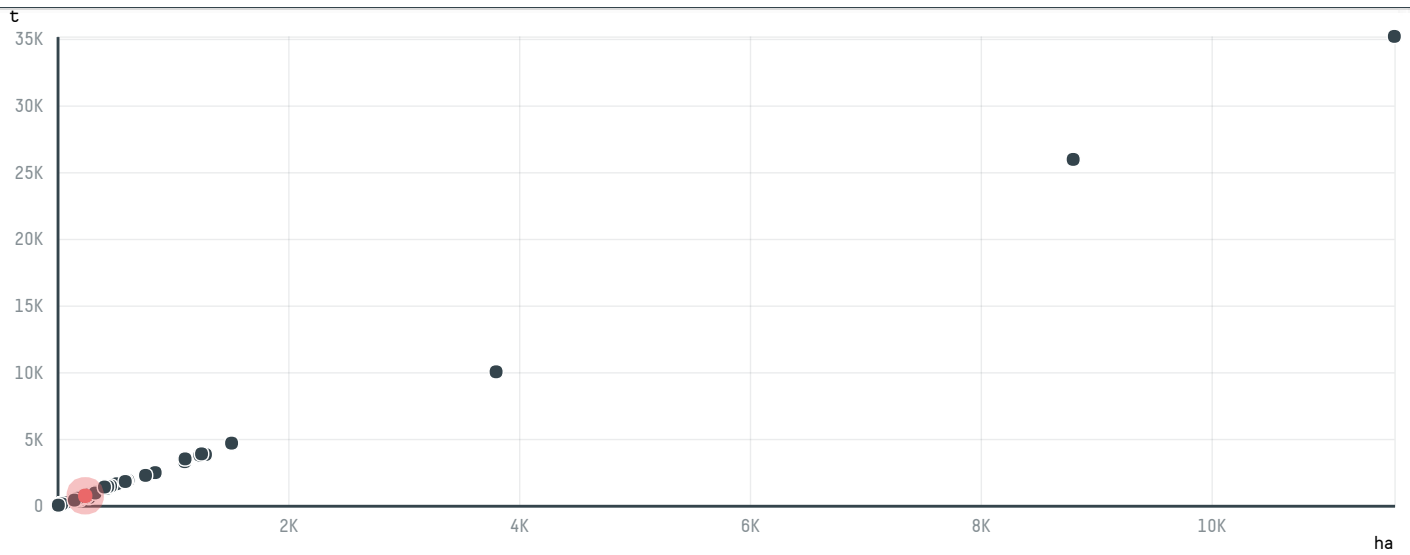
