WILISOL S/A was the 39th largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 638 tons. This is a 75% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, WILISOL S/A sources from 9 municipalities, or 3% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by WILISOL S/A is URUGUAY, accounting for 100% of the total.

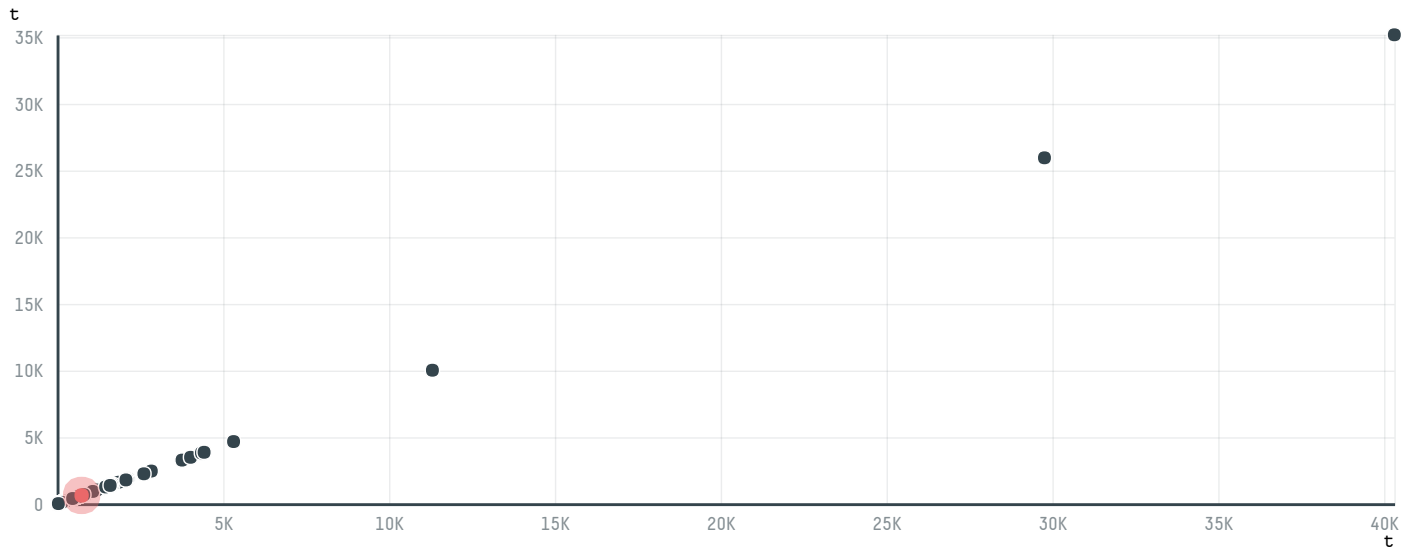
