The main destination of the pork imported by YEZAEEL FOOD & TRADE SA is ARGENTINA, accounting for 100% of the total.

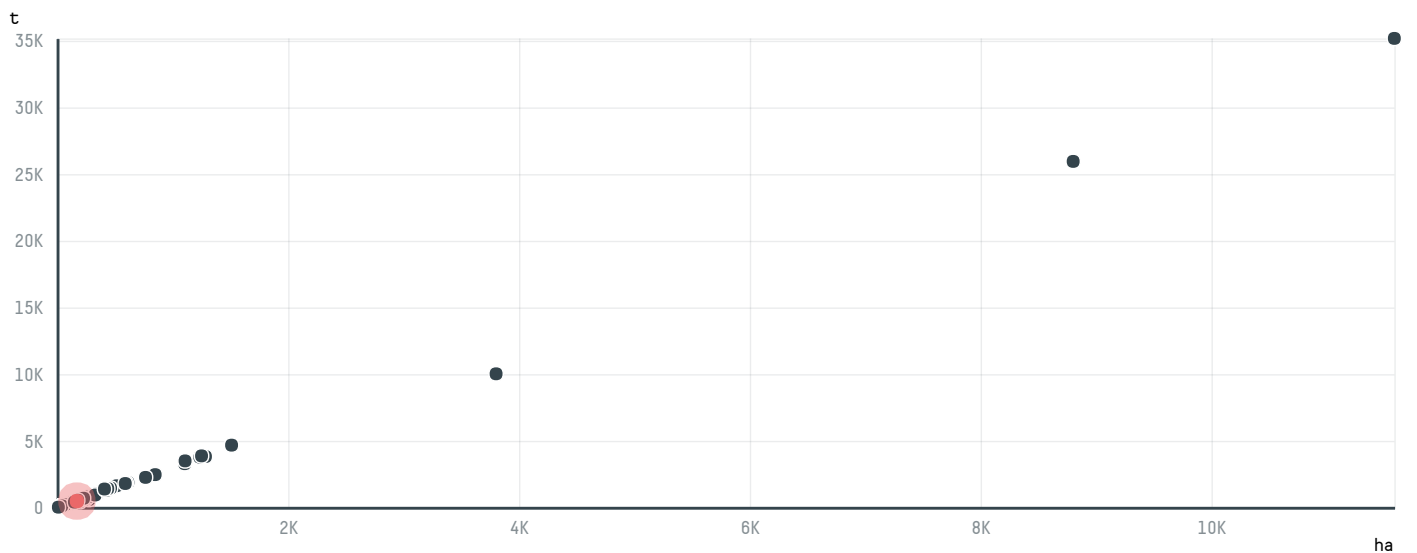
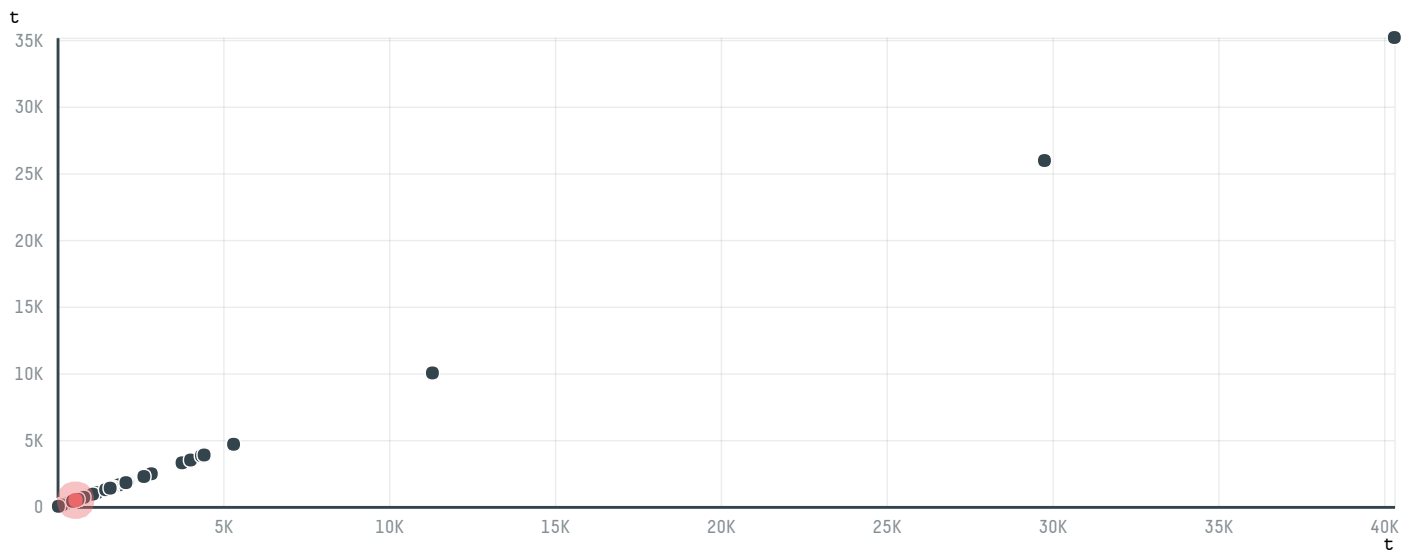
