Requinod s/a was the 60th largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 408 tons. This is a 67% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, Requinod s/a sources from 4 municipalities, or 1% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by Requinod s/a is Uruguay, accounting for 100% of the total.

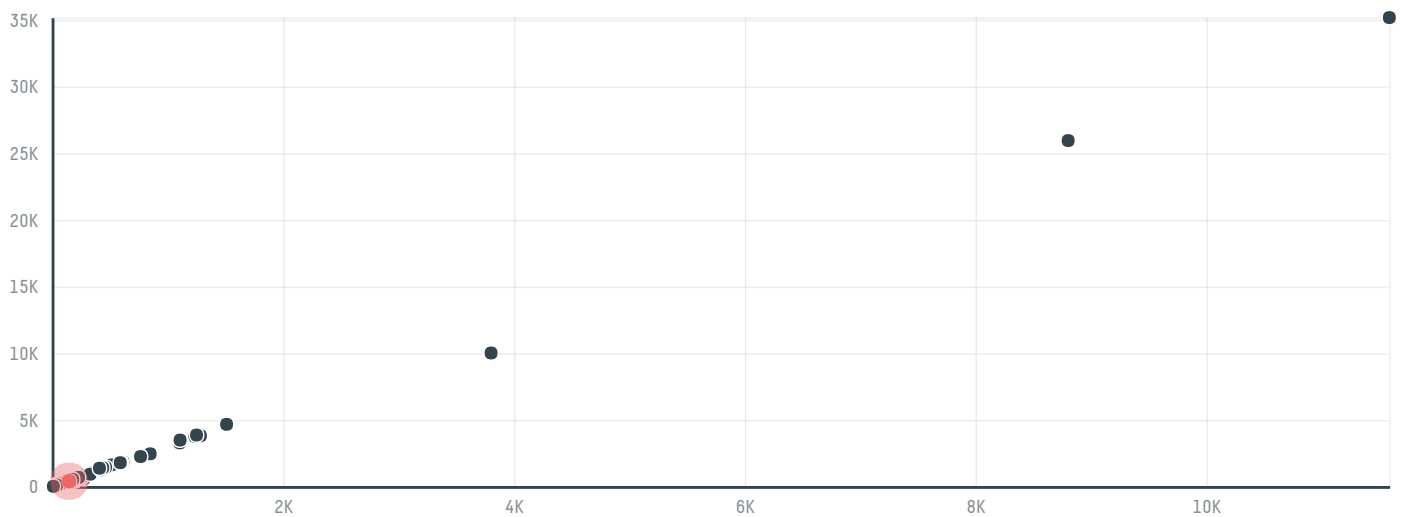
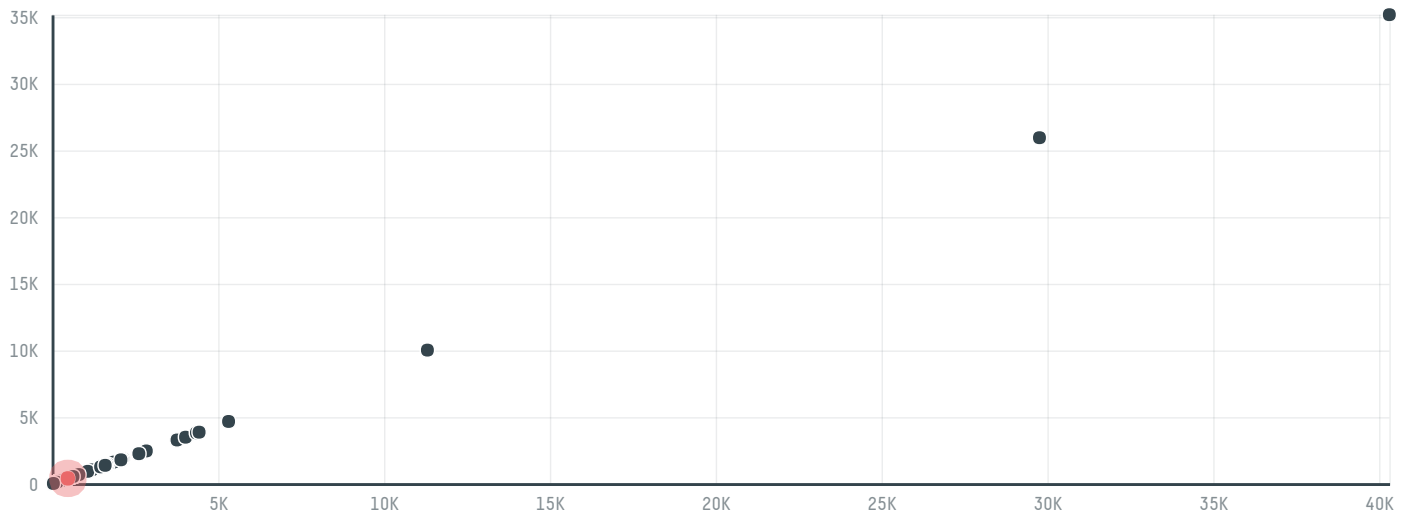
