The main destination of the pork imported by FRIGORIFICO PALADINI S.A is ARGENTINA, accounting for 100% of the total.

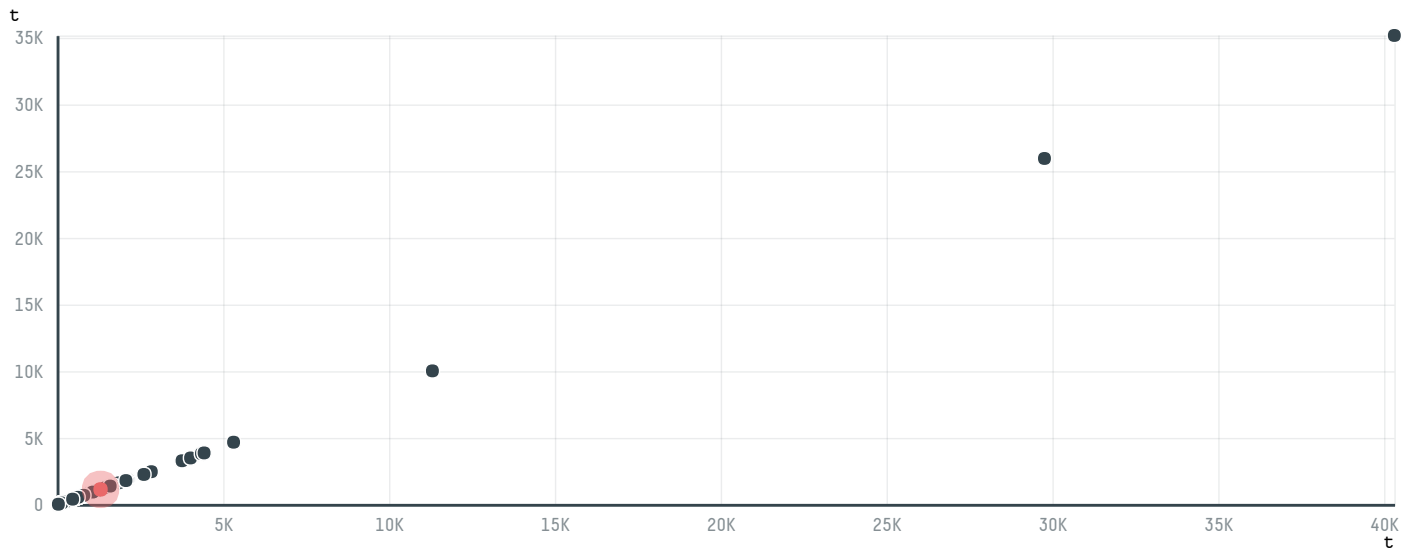


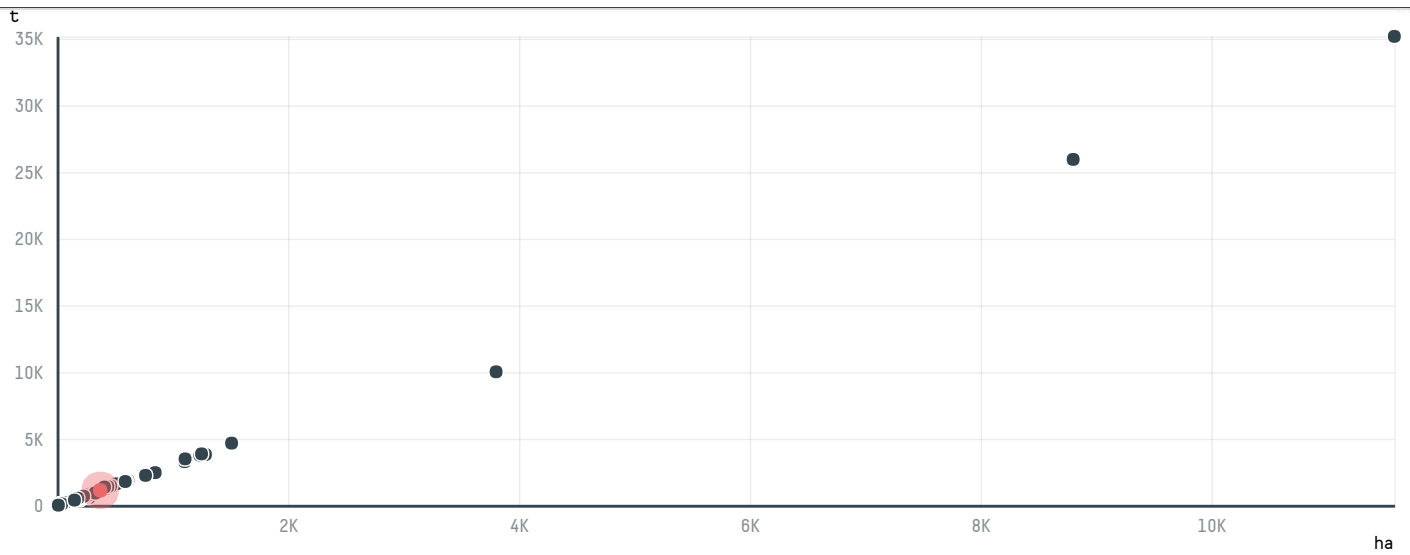
