



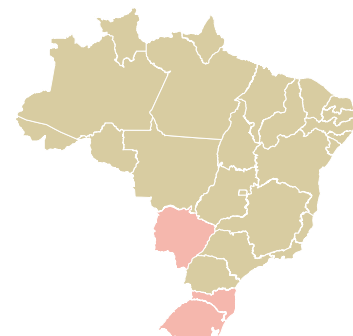
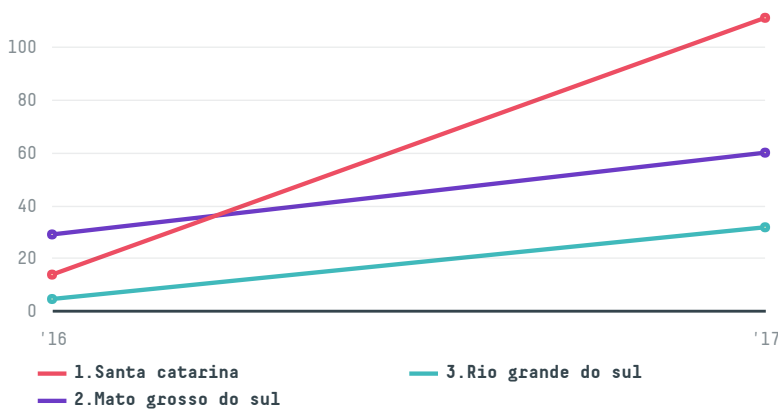
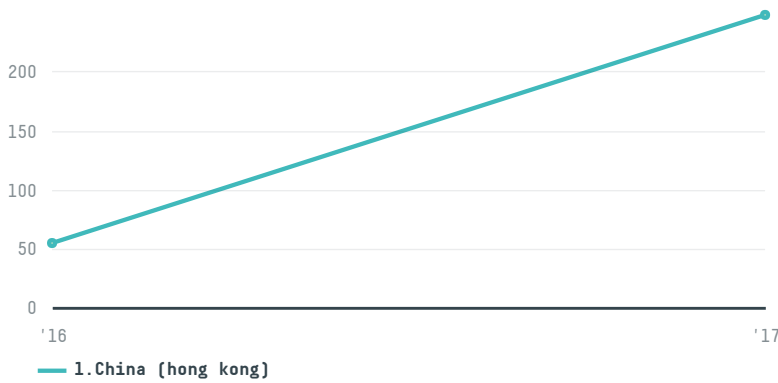

KAI BO FOOD SUPERMARKET was the 269th largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 248 tons. This is a 351% increase vs the previous year. As an importer, KAI BO FOOD SUPERMARKET sources from 9 municipalities, or 3% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by KAI BO FOOD SUPERMARKET is China (hong kong), accounting for 100% of the total.

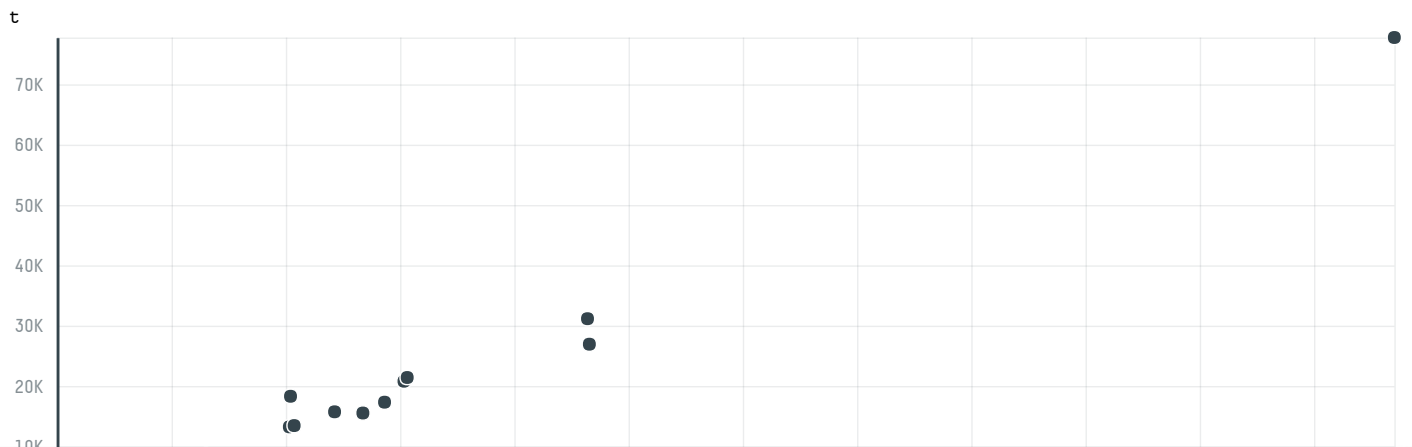
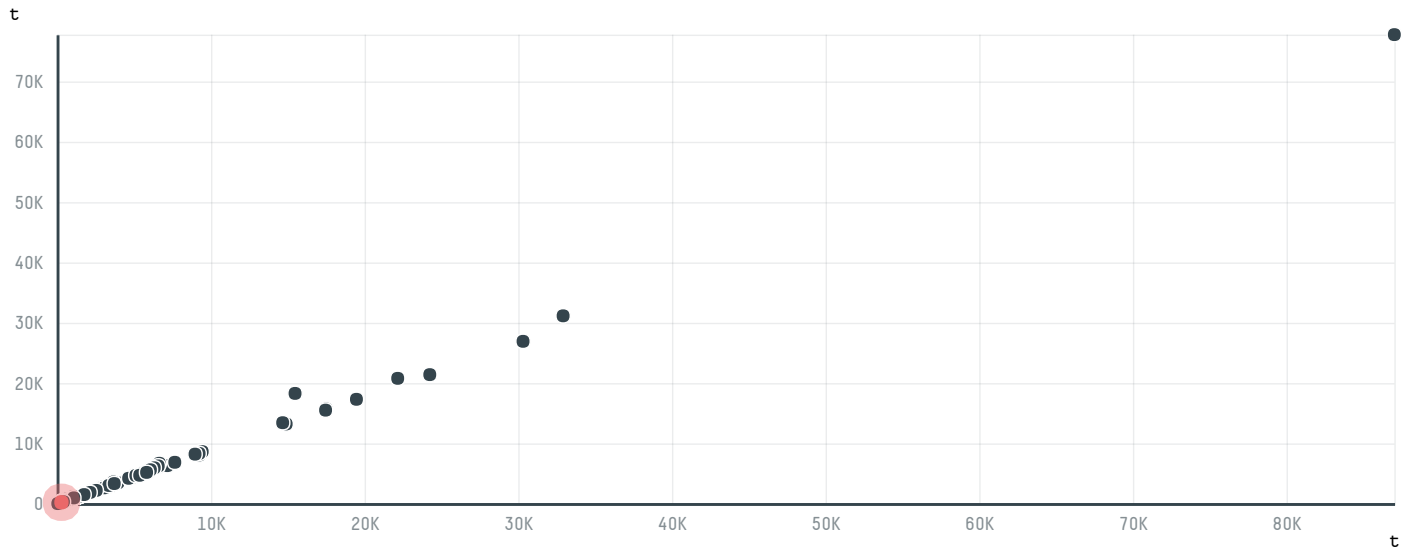
