YAMBI S.A. was the 101st largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 935 tons. This is a 1099% increase vs the previous year. As an importer, YAMBI S.A. sources from 4 municipalities, or 1% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by YAMBI S.A. is ANGOLA, accounting for 100% of the total.

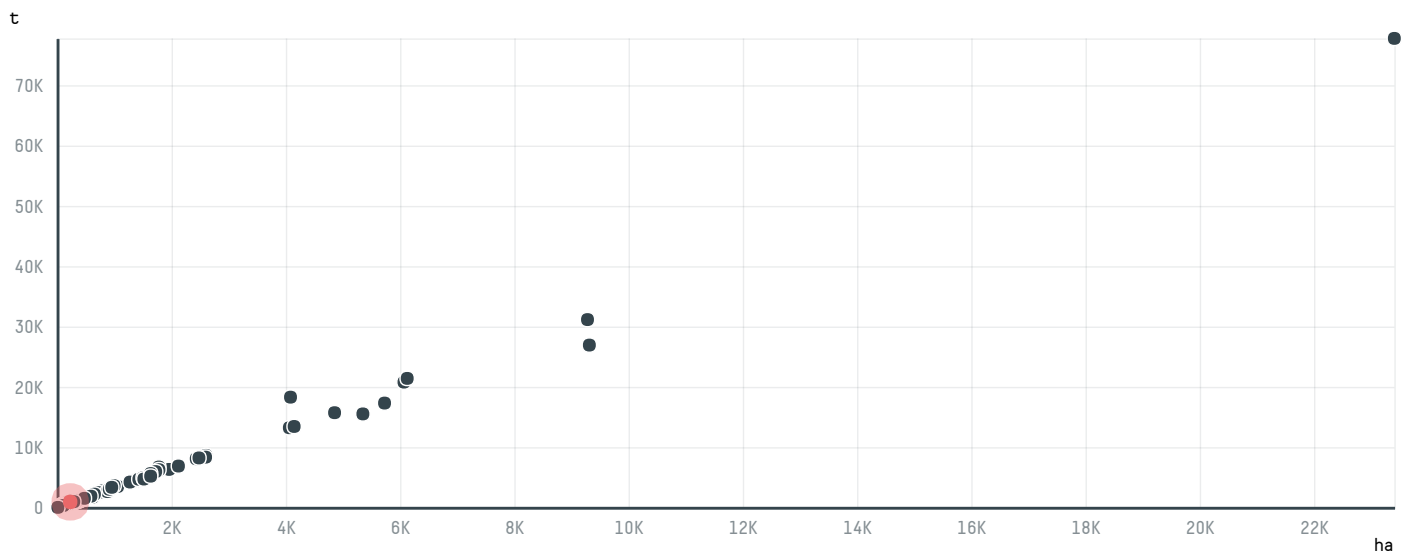
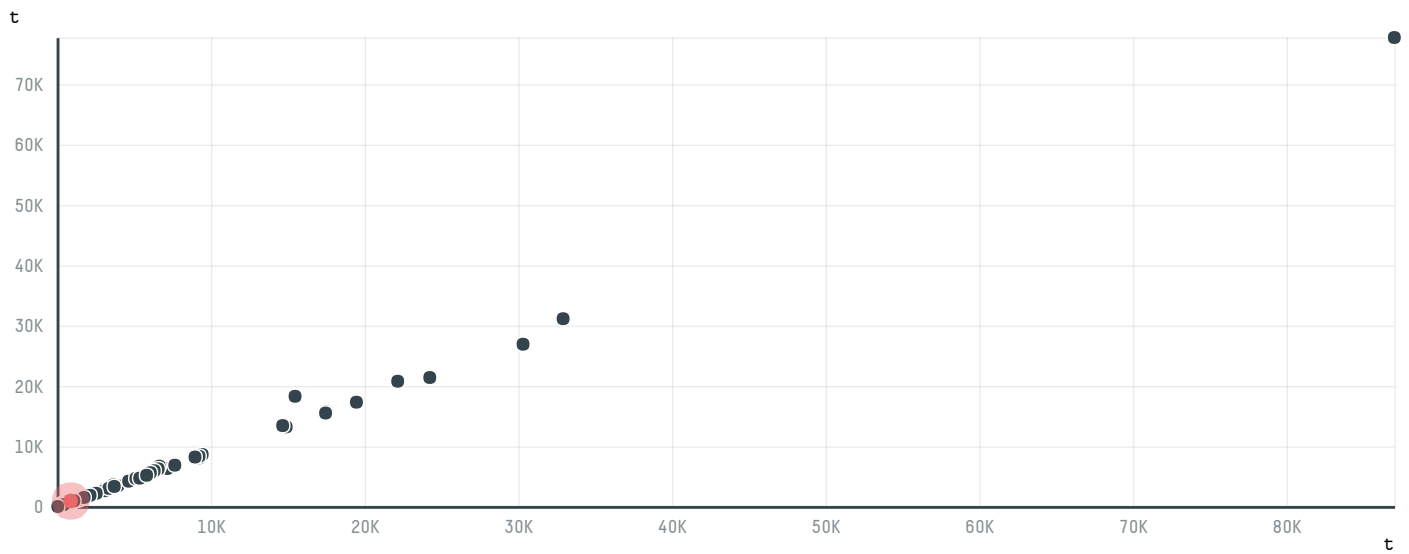
