AVICOLA FRANGO S A was the 75th largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 294 tons. This is a 42% increase vs the previous year. As an importer, AVICOLA FRANGO S A sources from 10 municipalities, or 3% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by AVICOLA FRANGO S A is ARGENTINA, accounting for 100% of the total.

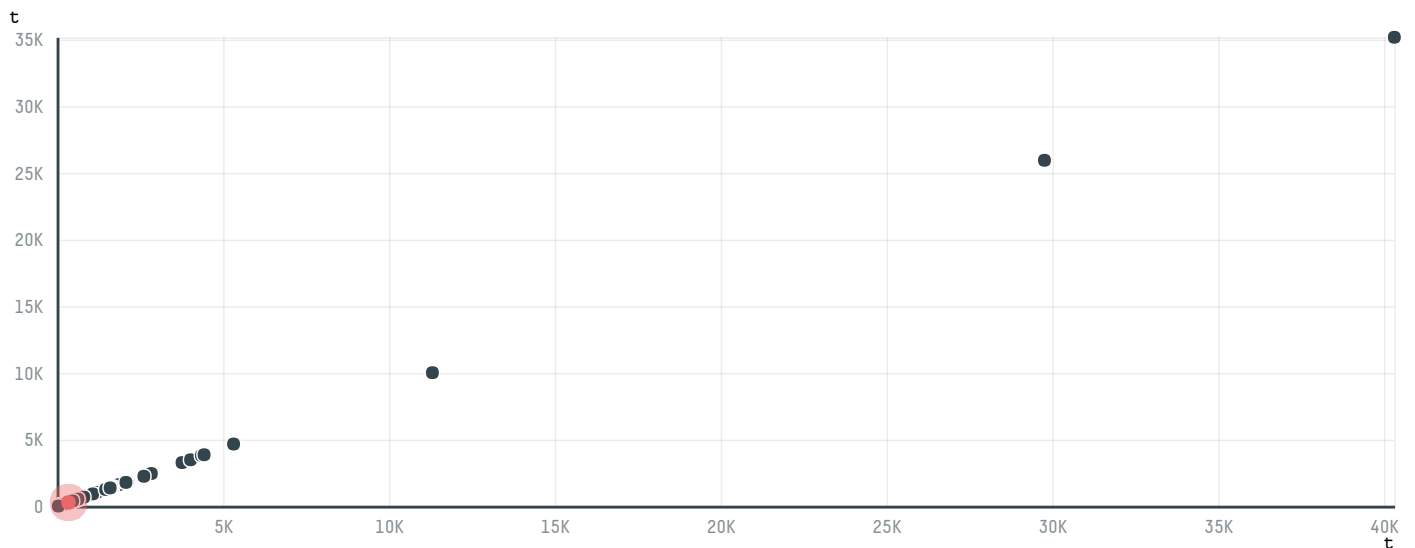

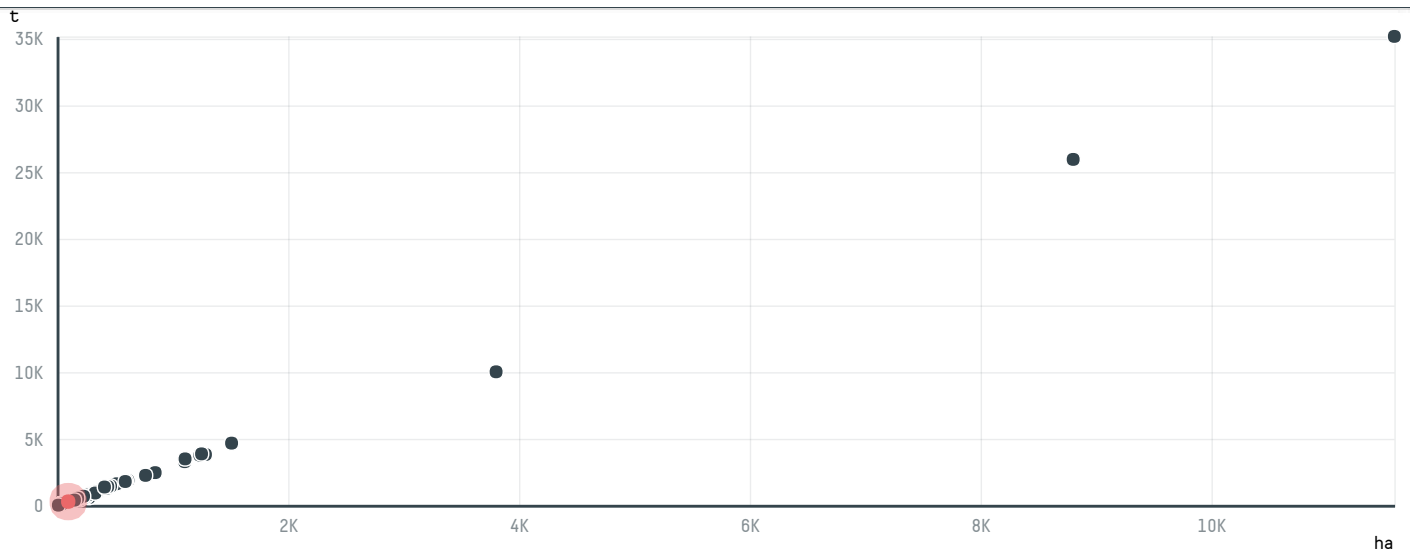
