



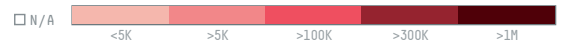
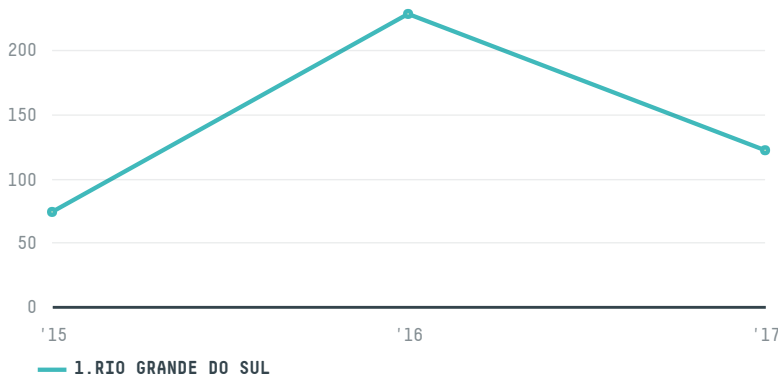
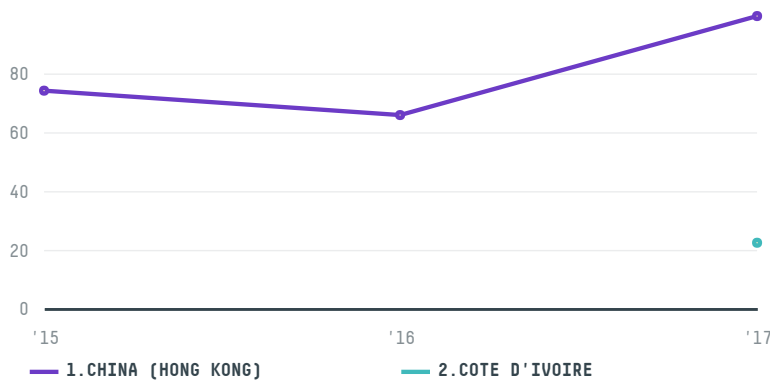

GSI SWITZERLAND was the 378th largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 122 tons. This is a 52% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, GSI SWITZERLAND sources from 8 municipalities, or 3% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by GSI SWITZERLAND is CHINA (HONG KONG), accounting for 82% of the total.

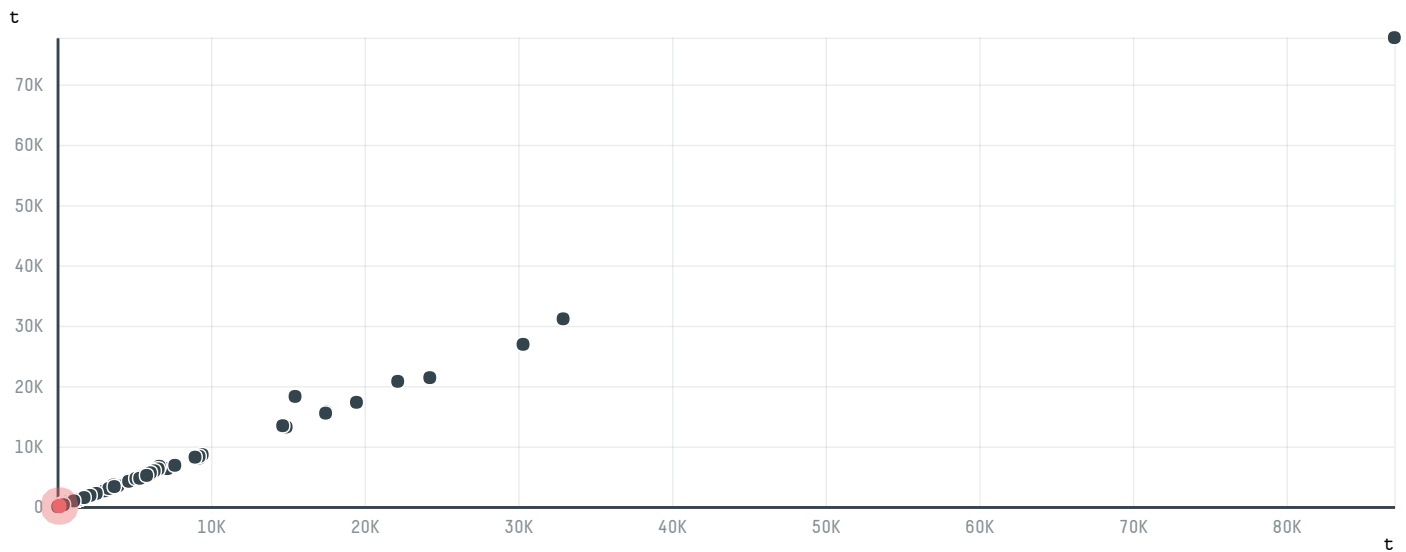
