



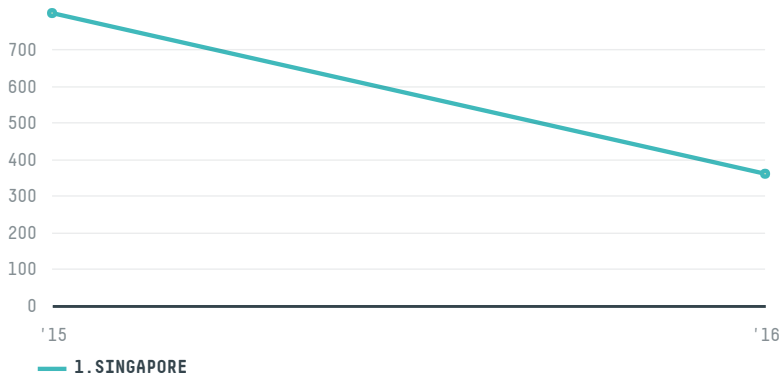

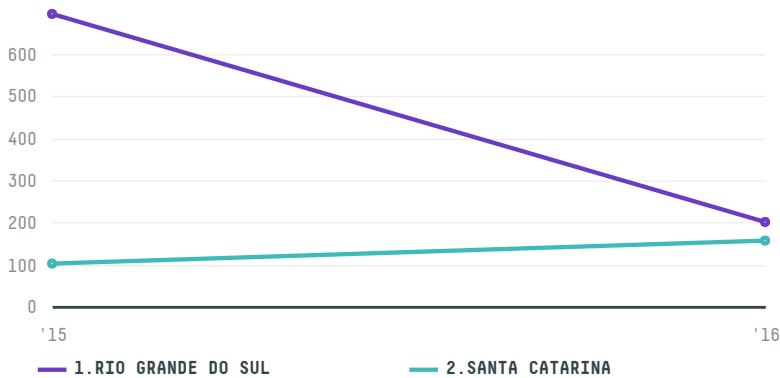

GOODCROP PTE was the 220th largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2016, accounting for 360 tons. This is a 55% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, GOODCROP PTE sources from 4 municipalities, or 1% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by GOODCROP PTE is SINGAPORE, accounting for 100% of the total.

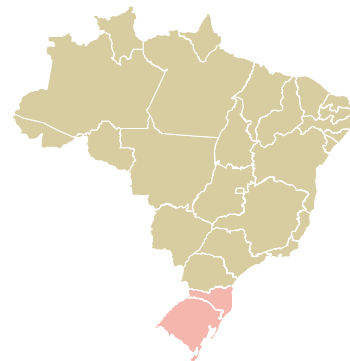
TOP DESTINATION COUNTRIES OF PORK IMPORTED BY GOODCROP PTE:

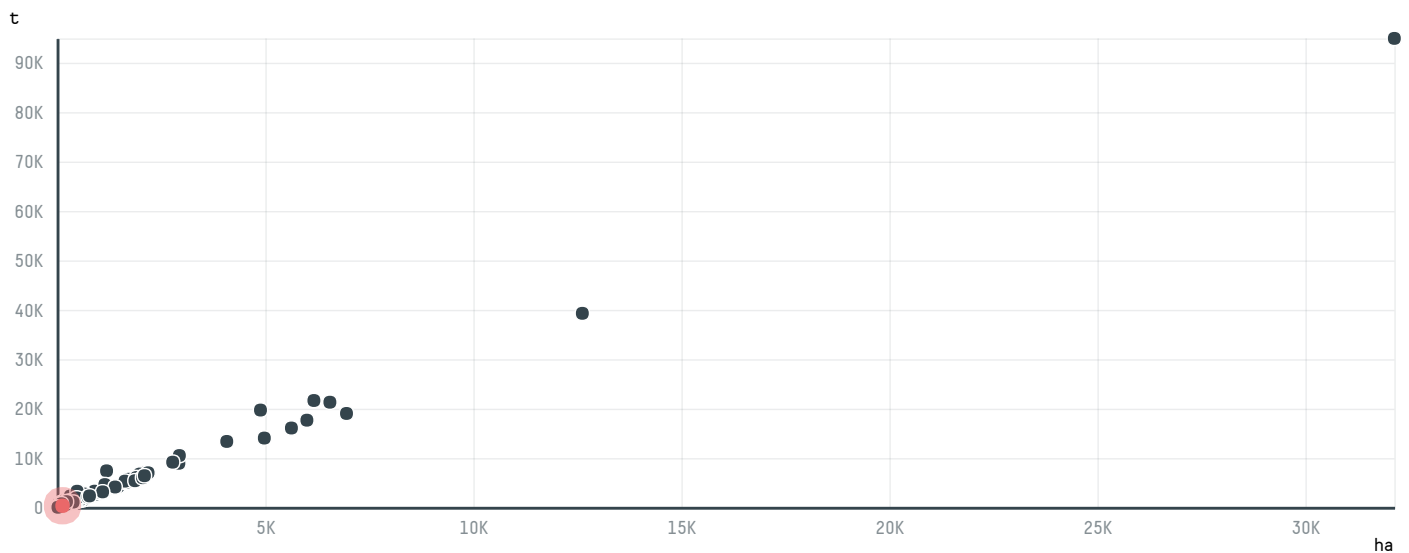
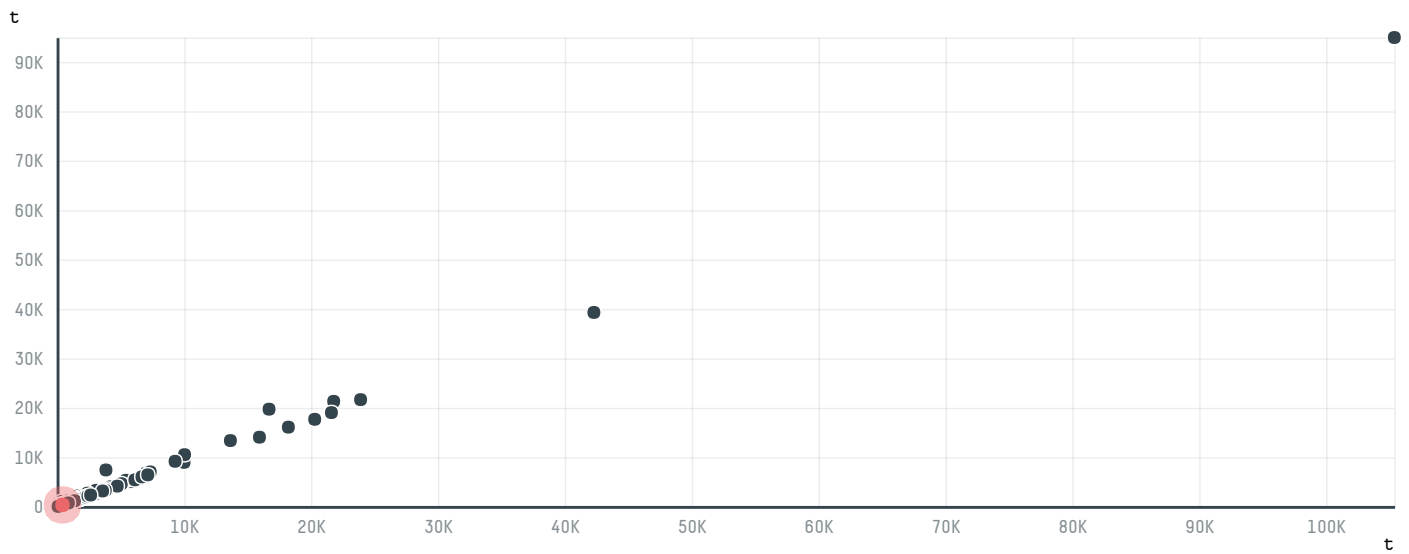
