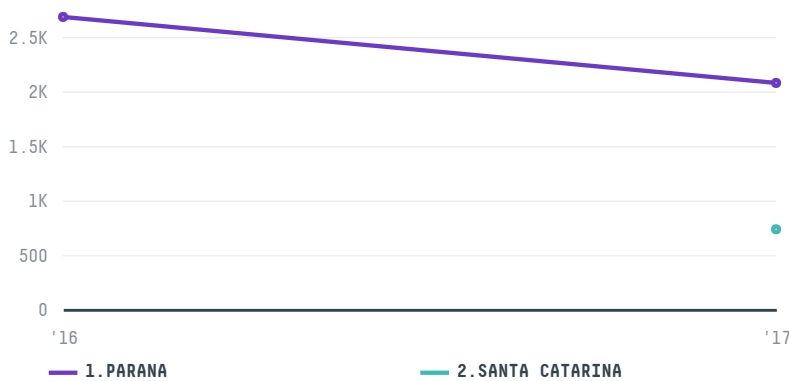
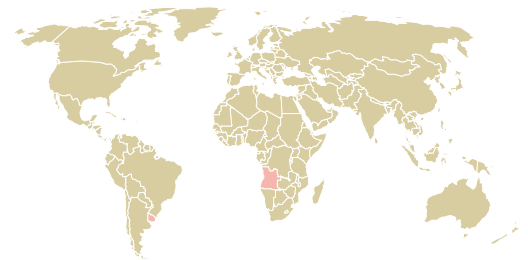
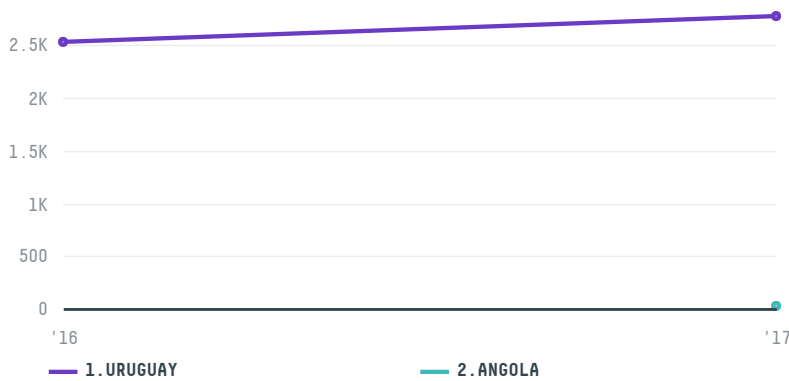


PRIMAL TRADE

PRIMAL TRADE was the 40th largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 3 thousand tons. This is a 5% increase vs the previous year. As an importer, PRIMAL TRADE sources from 8 municipalities, or 3% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by PRIMAL TRADE is URUGUAY, accounting for 99% of the total.

TOP DESTINATION COUNTRIES OF PORK IMPORTED BY PRIMAL TRADE:



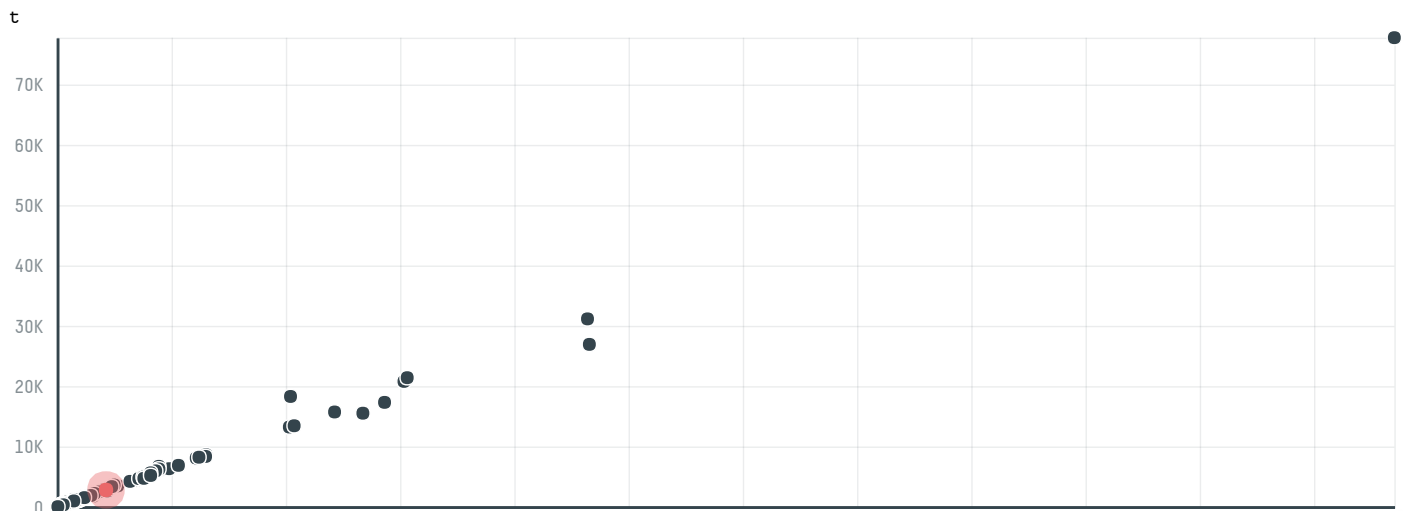
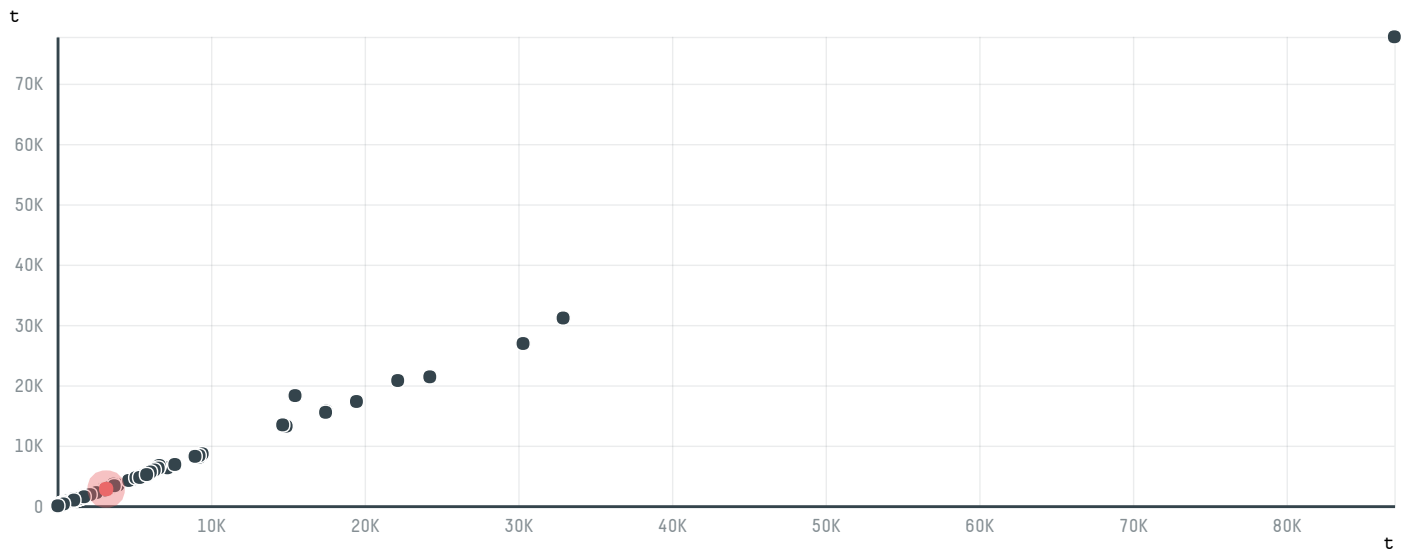
