FFT was the 240th largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 53 tons. This is a 30% increase vs the previous year. As an importer, FFT sources from 2 municipalities, or 1% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by FFT is GABON, accounting for 100% of the total.

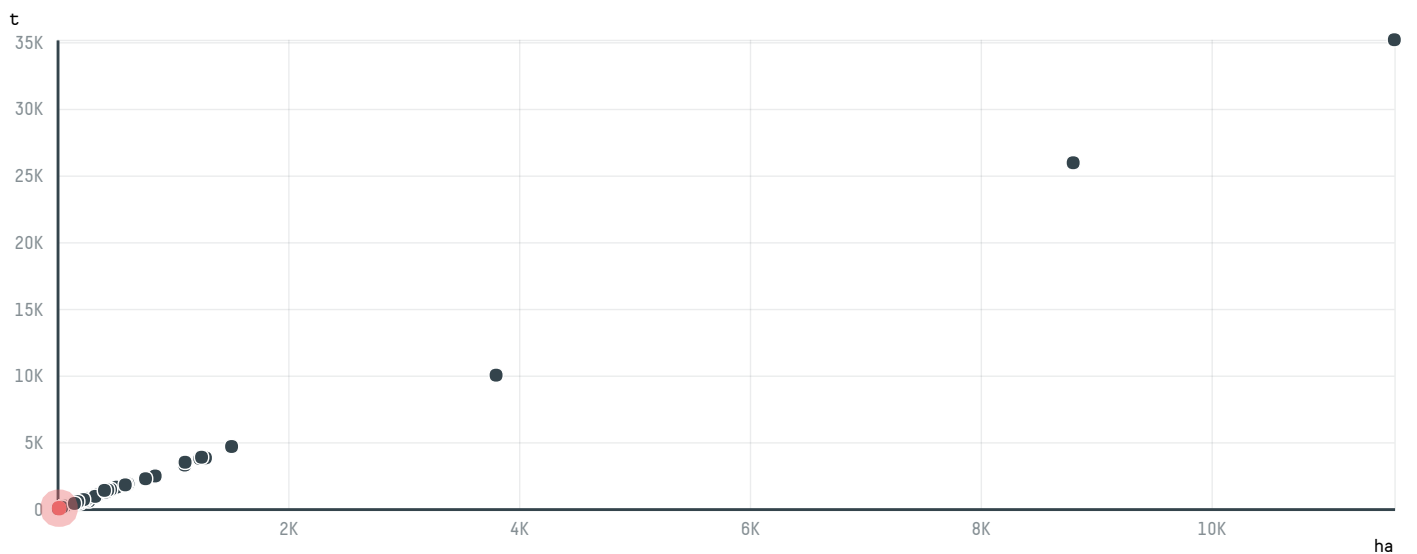
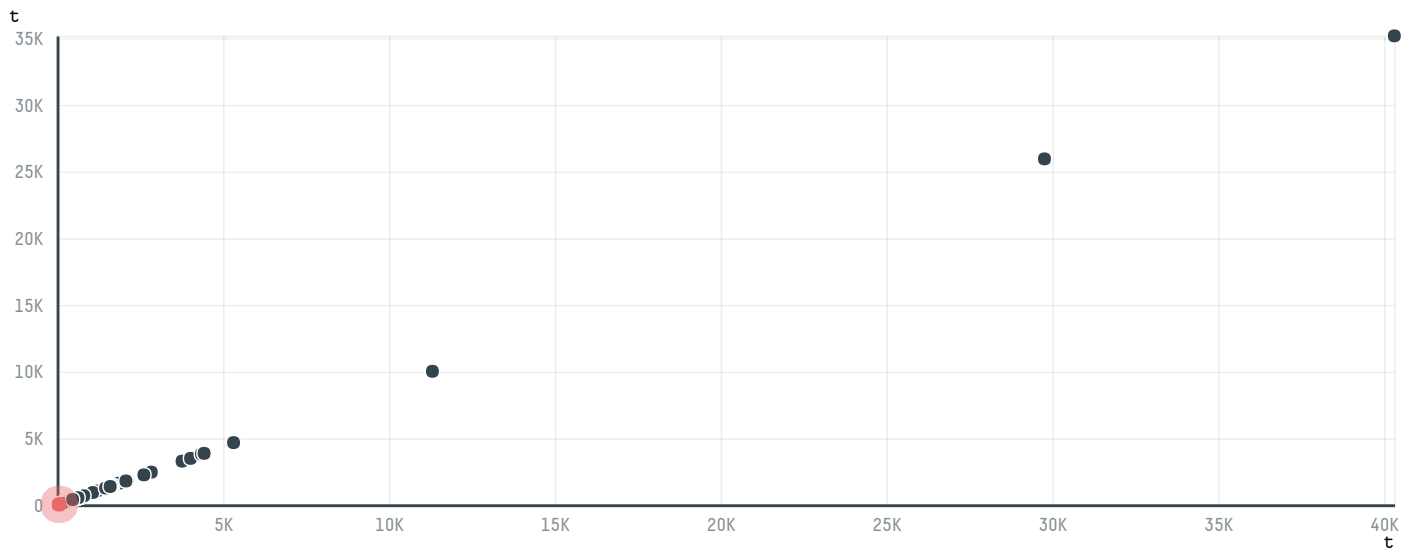
