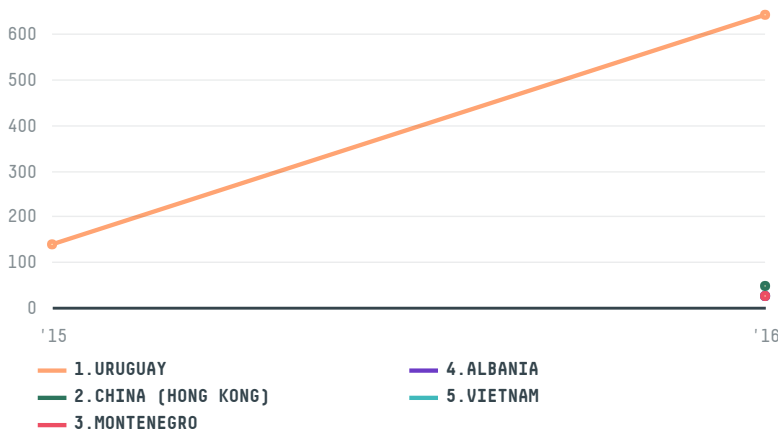


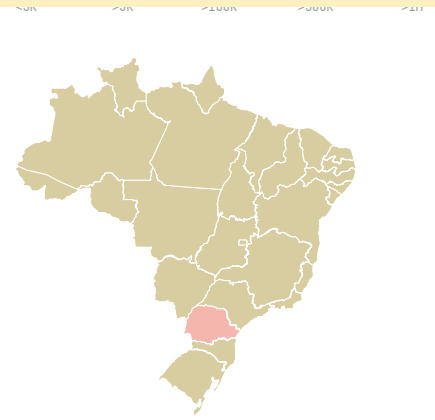
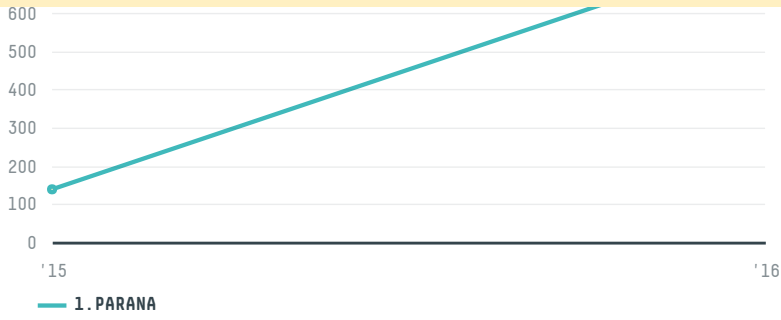
SUPERFRIGO INDUSTRY AND COMMERCE

SUPERFRIGO INDUSTRY AND COMMERCE was the 133rd largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2016, accounting for 765 tons. This is a 453% increase vs the previous year. As an importer, SUPERFRIGO INDUSTRY AND COMMERCE sources from 7 municipalities, or 2% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by SUPERFRIGO INDUSTRY AND COMMERCE is URUGUAY, accounting for 84% of the total.

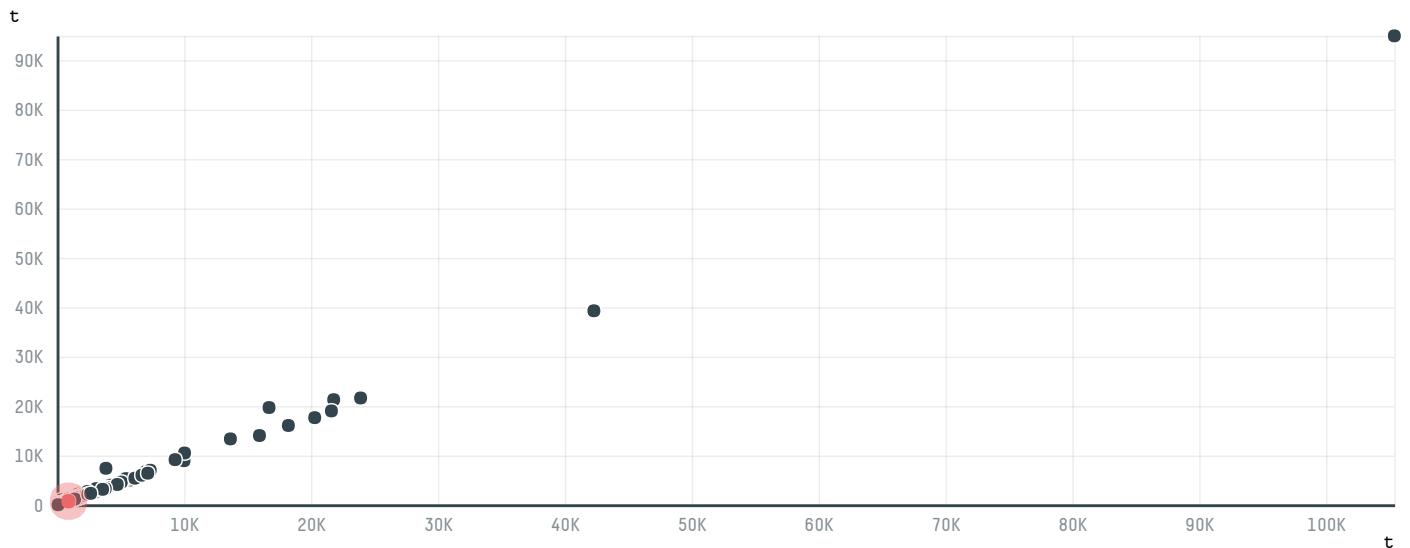


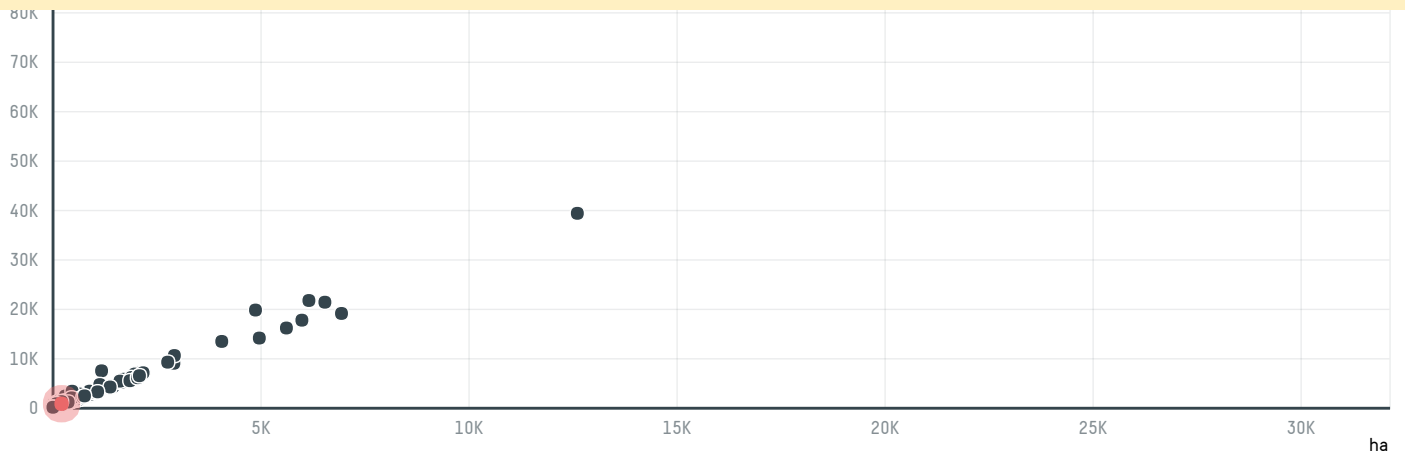
