



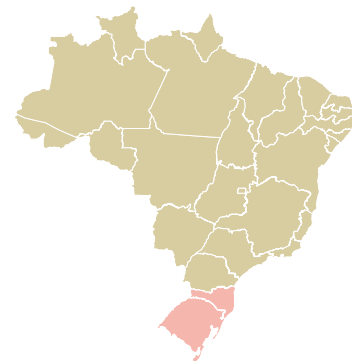
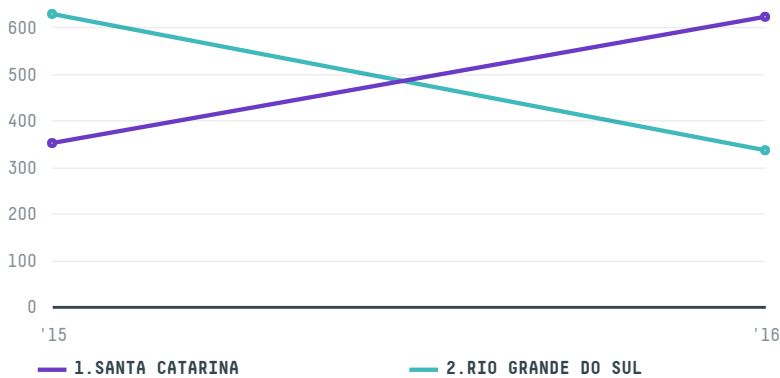
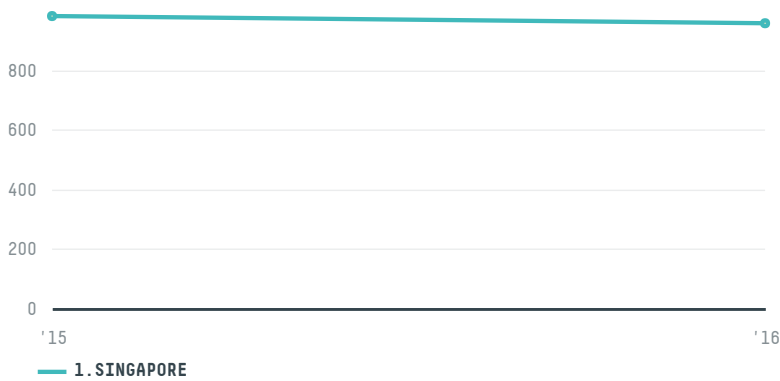

WTT TRADING PTE was the 110th largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2016, accounting for 959 tons. This is a 2% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, WTT TRADING PTE sources from 7 municipalities, or 2% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by WTT TRADING PTE is SINGAPORE, accounting for 100% of the total.

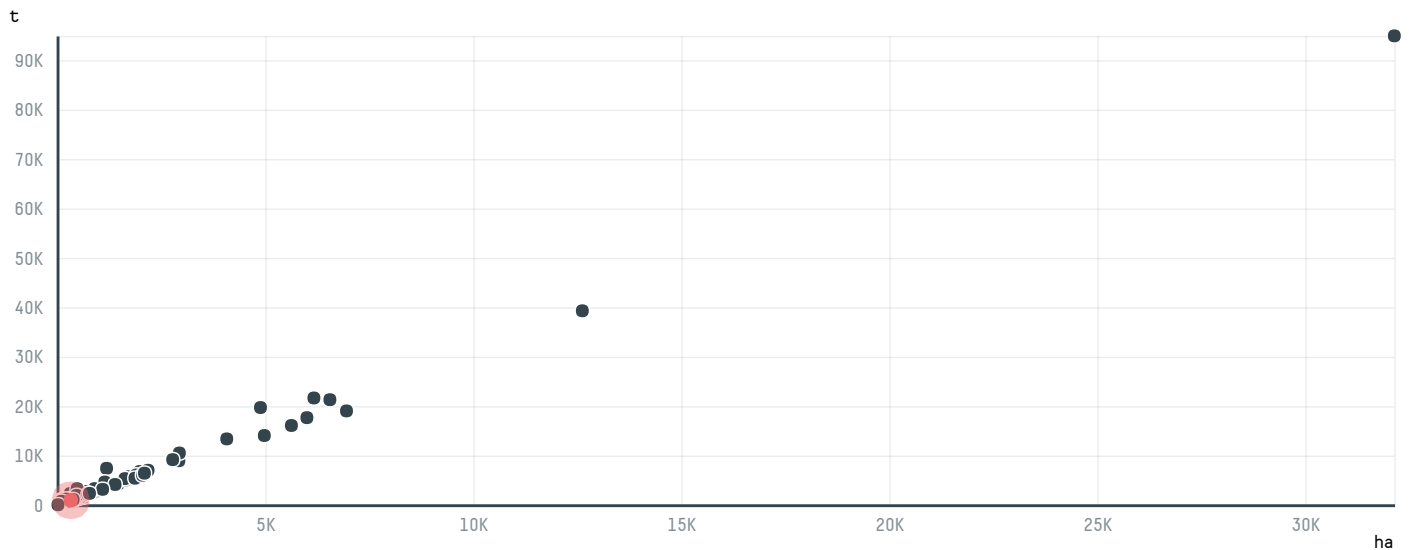
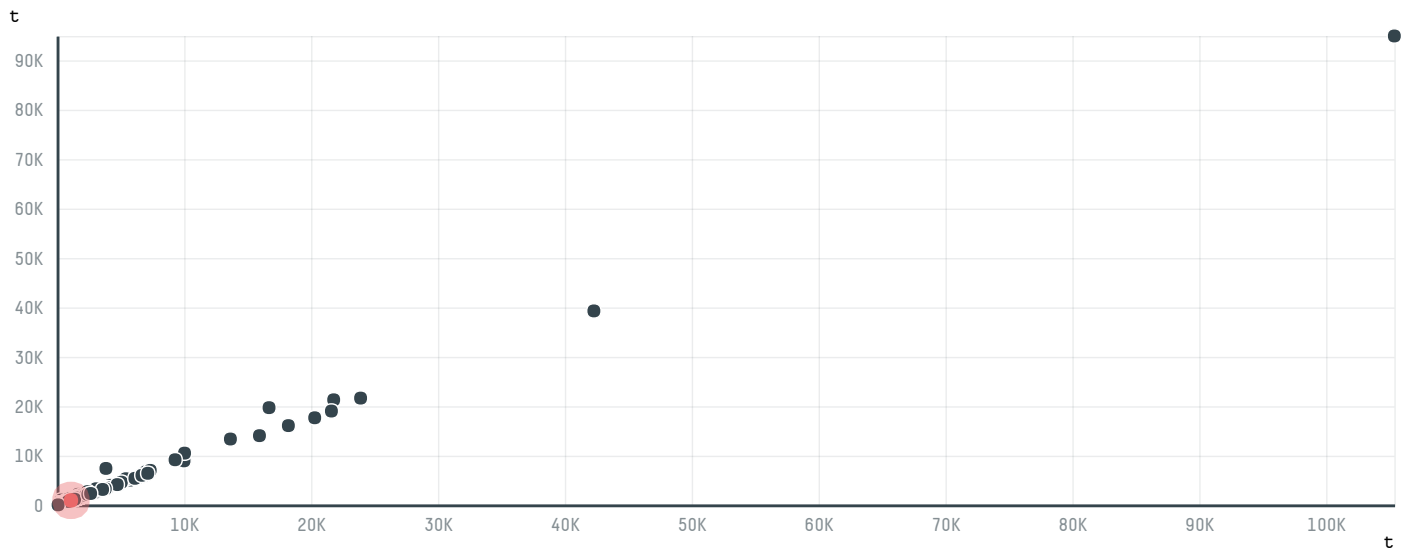
