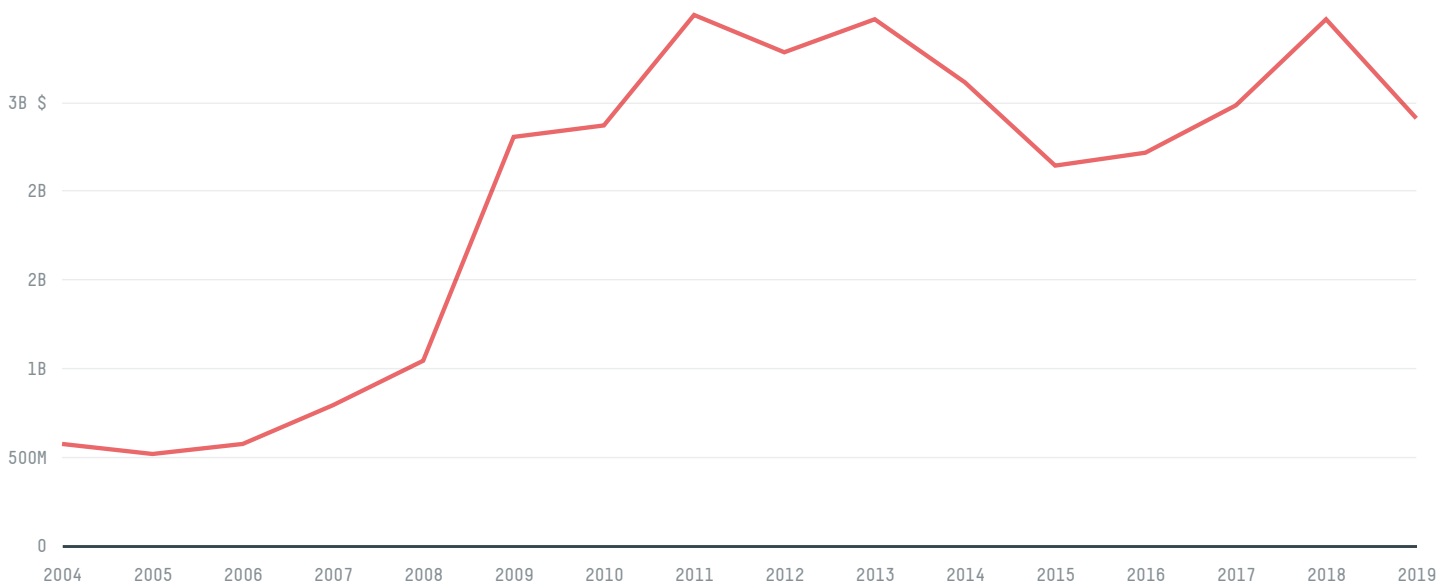

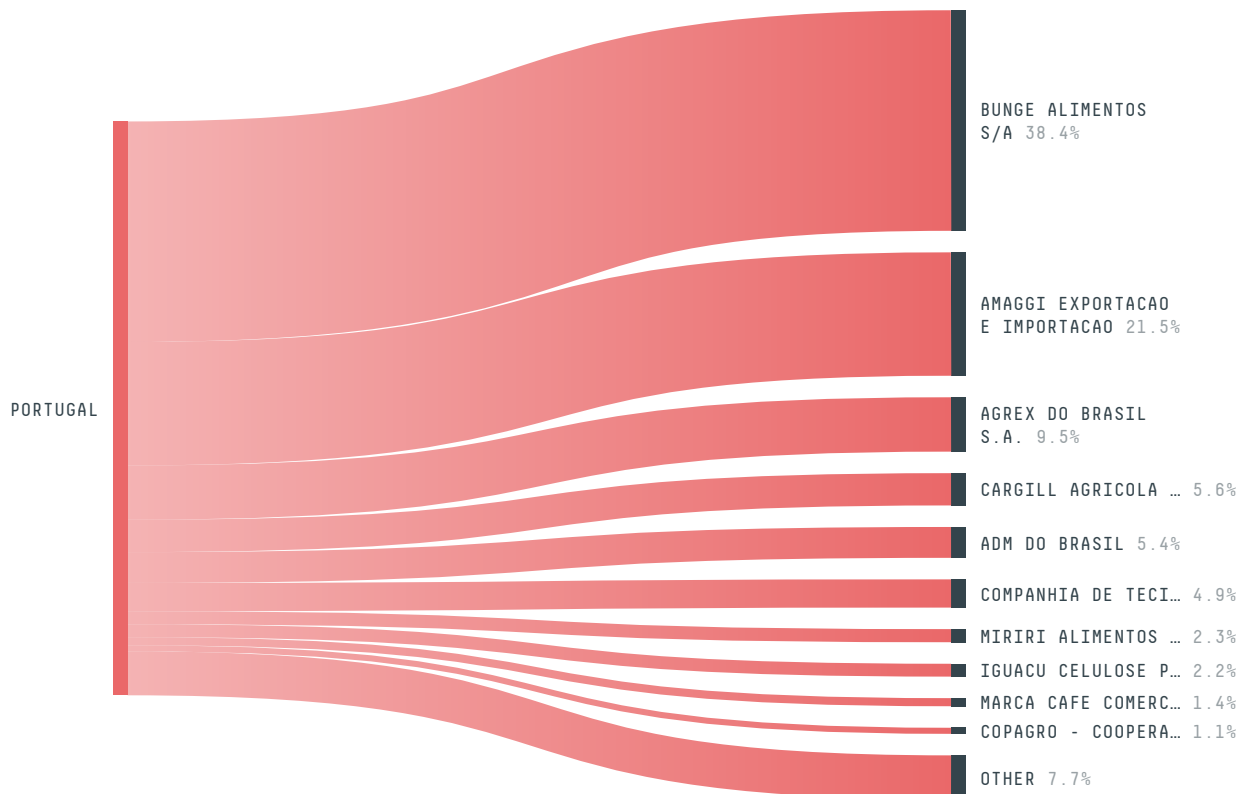

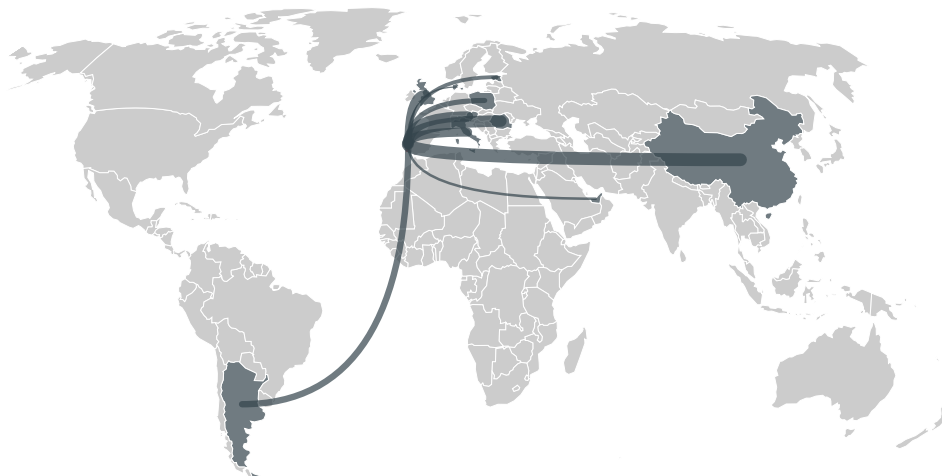
IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF PORTUGAL



TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF SOY IN PORTUGAL IN 2018



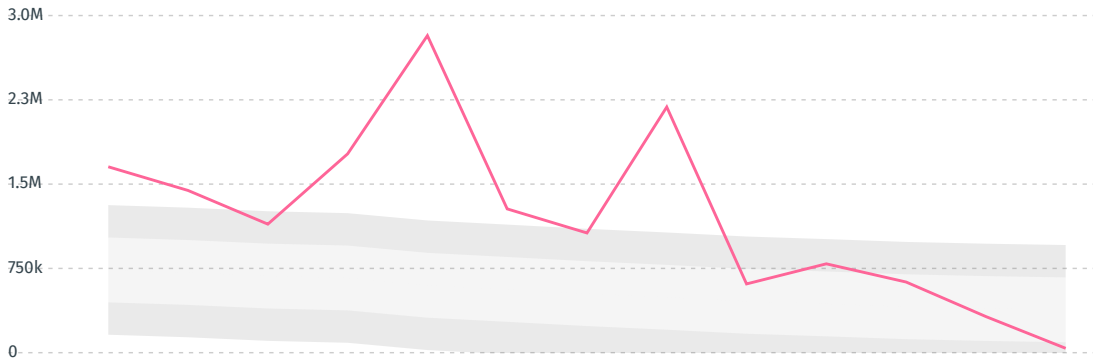
