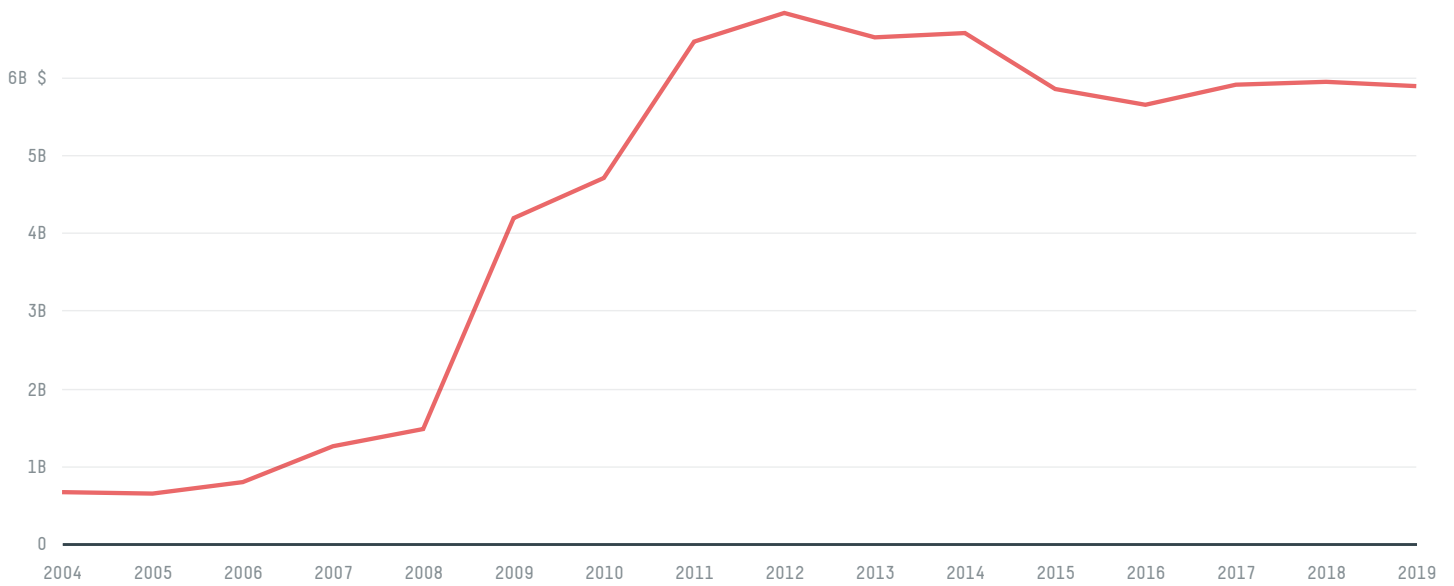

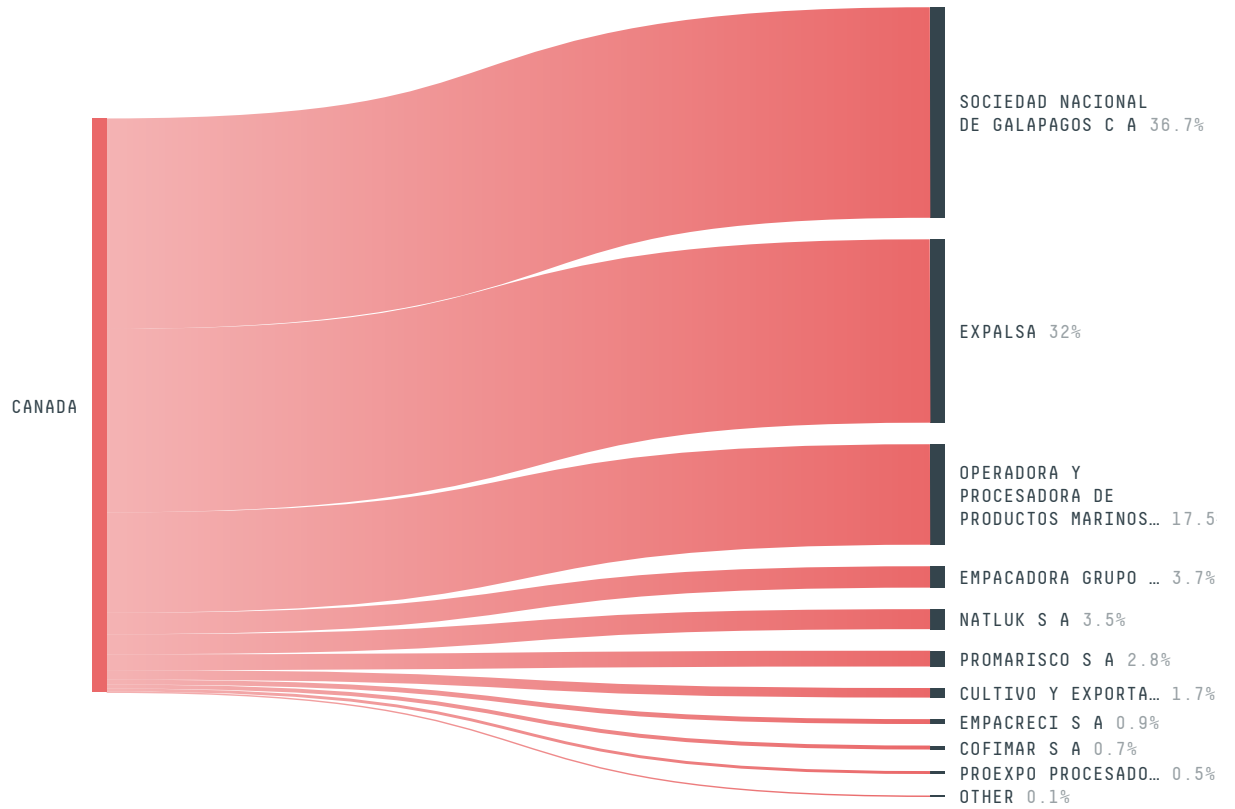

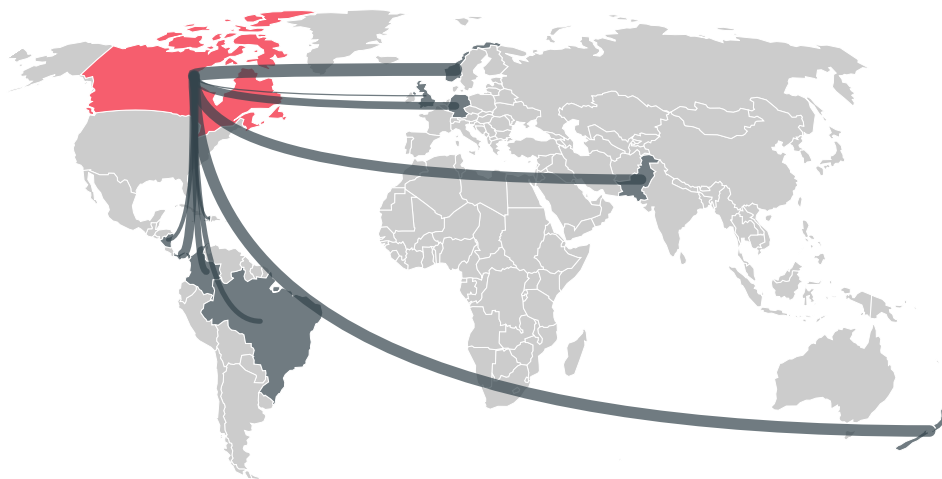
## IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF CANADA



## TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF SHRIMP IN CANADA IN 2019



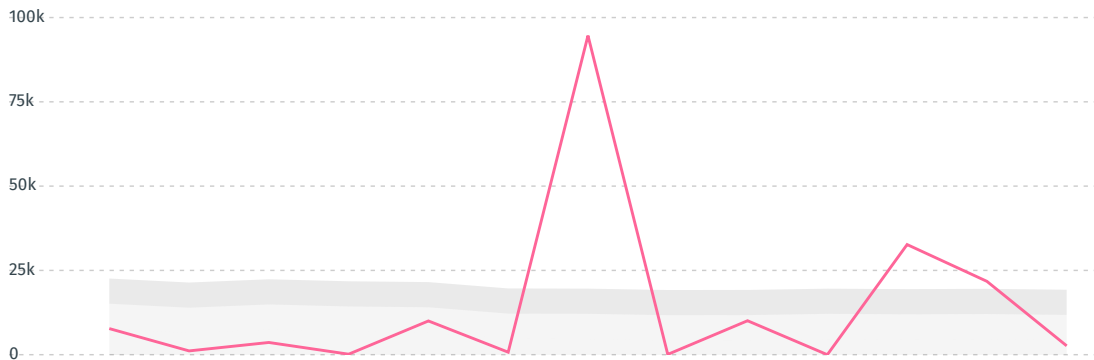
