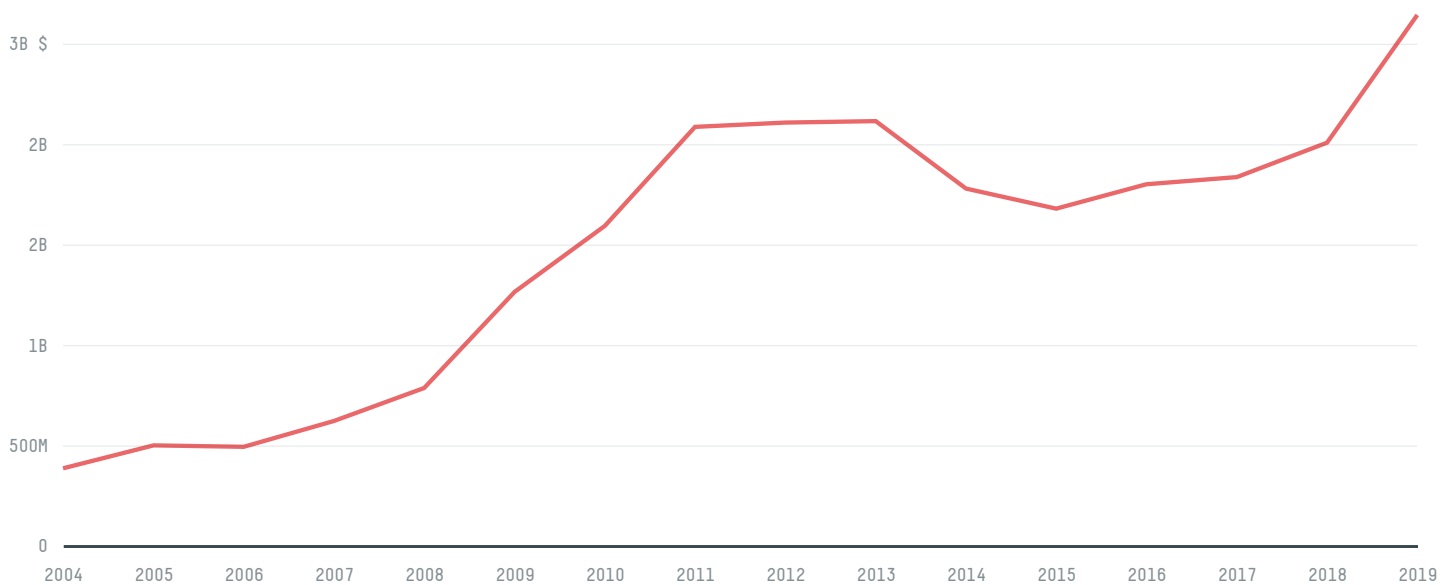

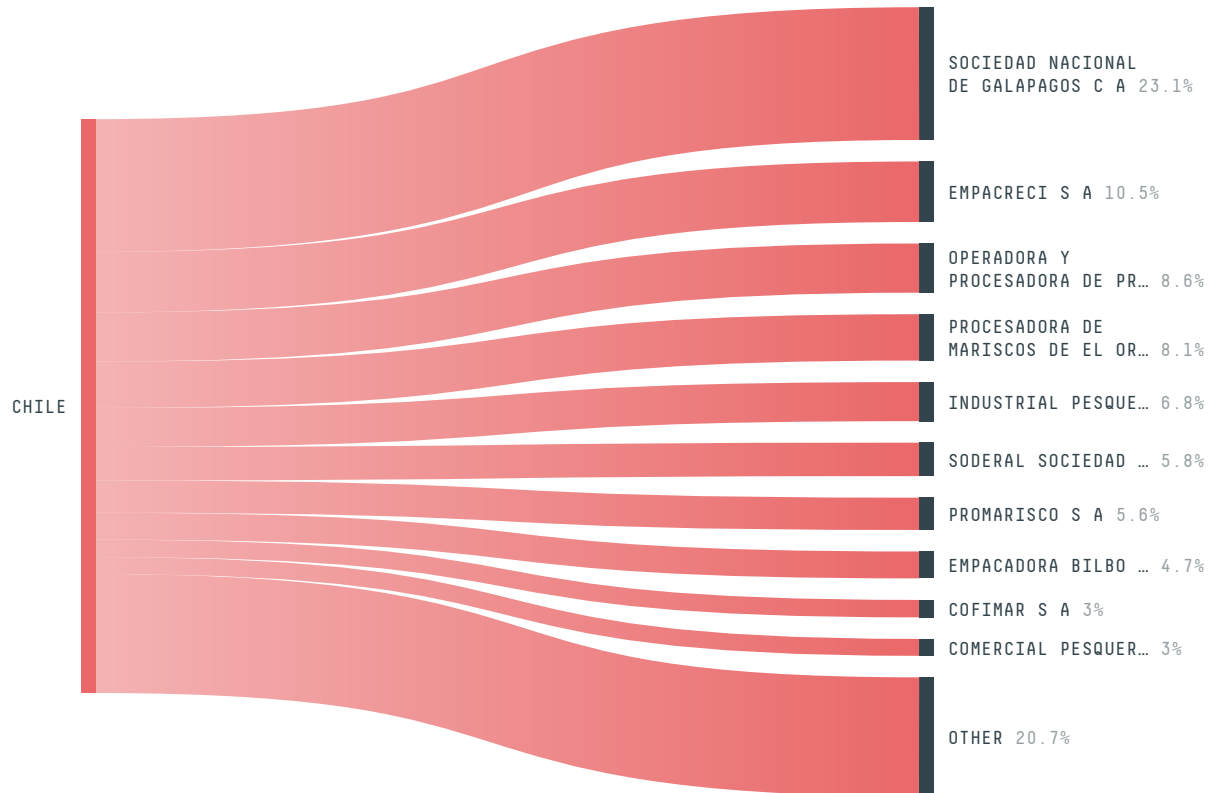

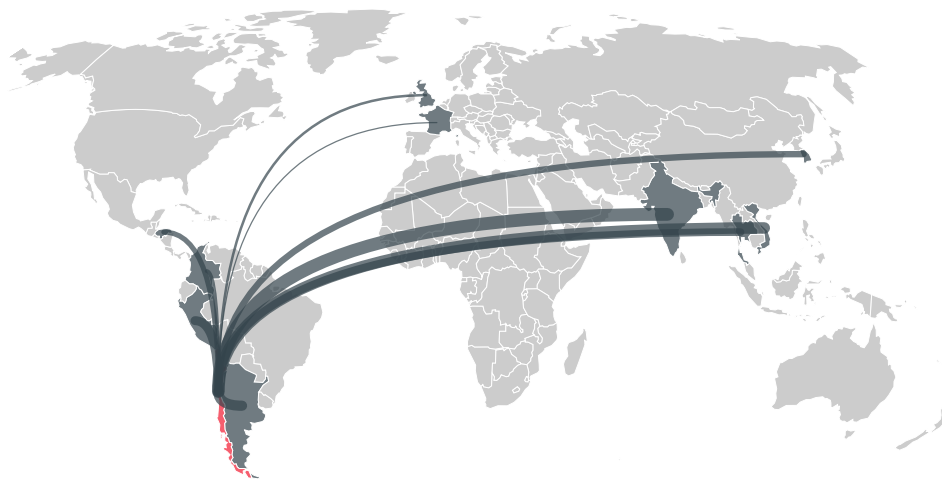
IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF CHILE
