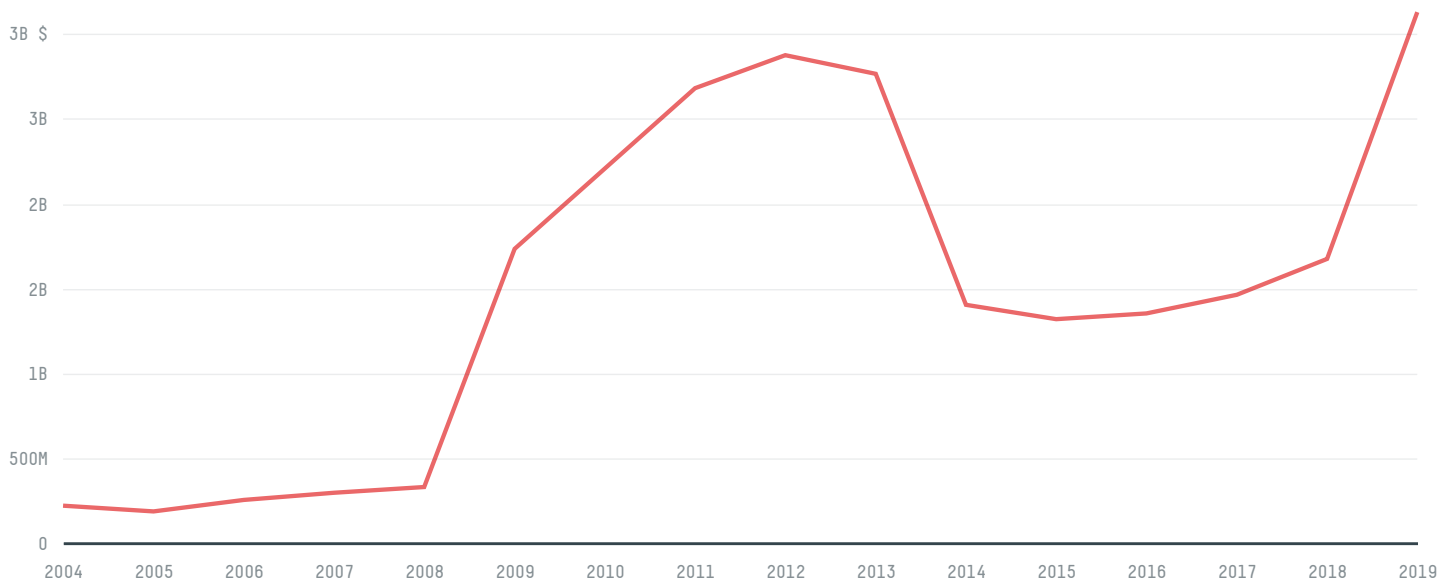

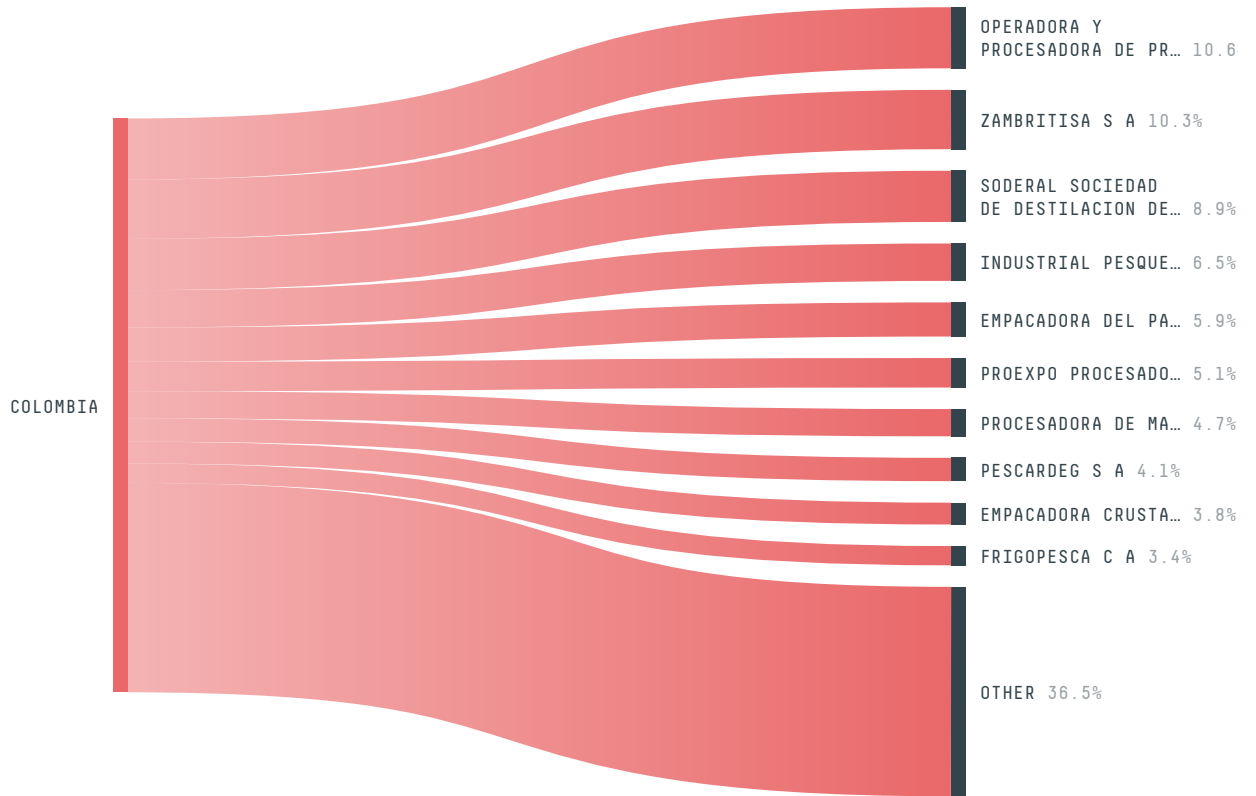

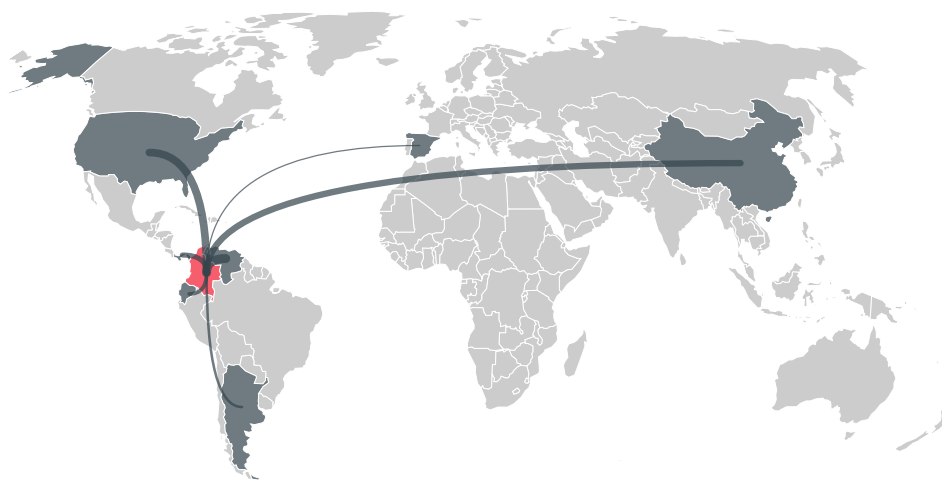
IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF COLOMBIA
