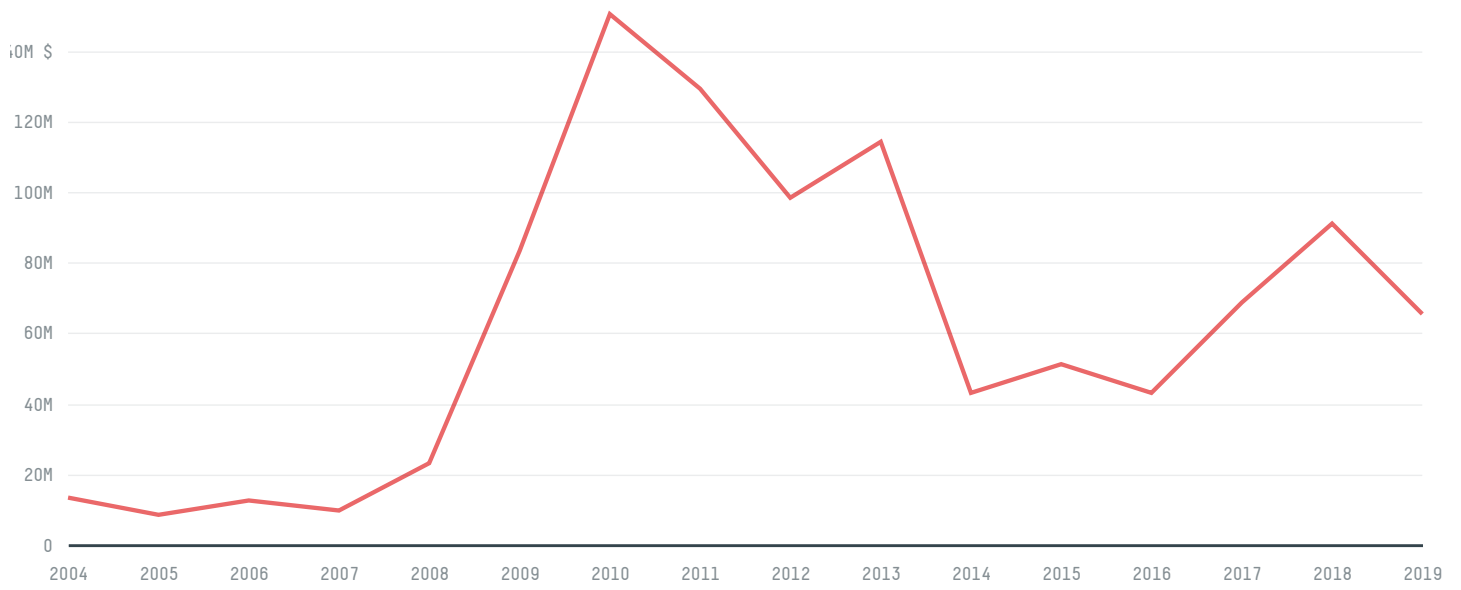

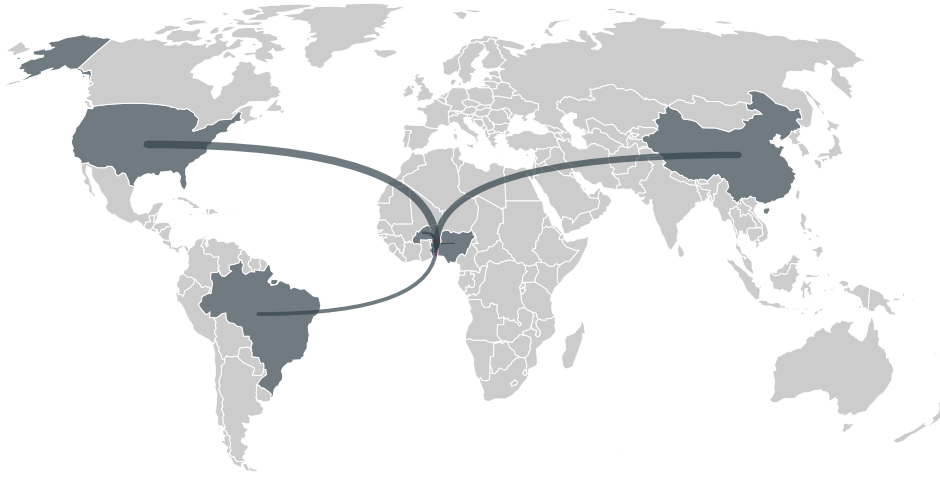
IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF BENIN

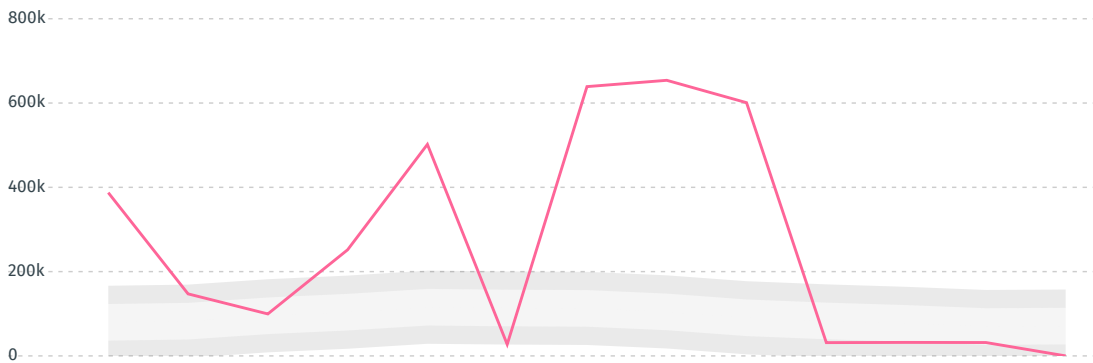
