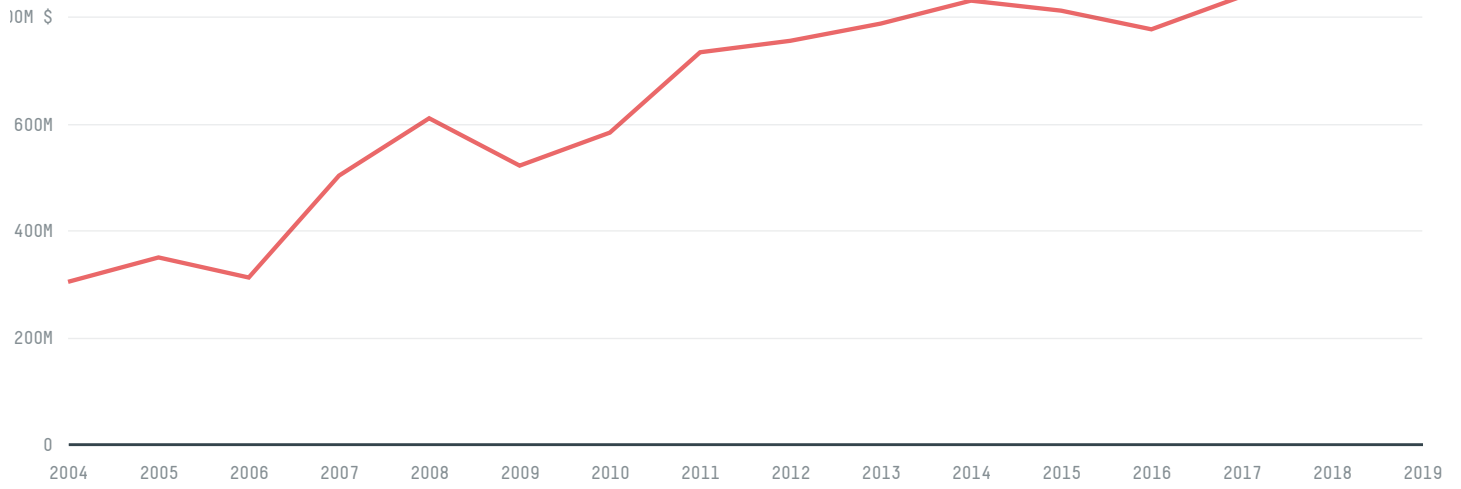

## IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF GUATEMALA

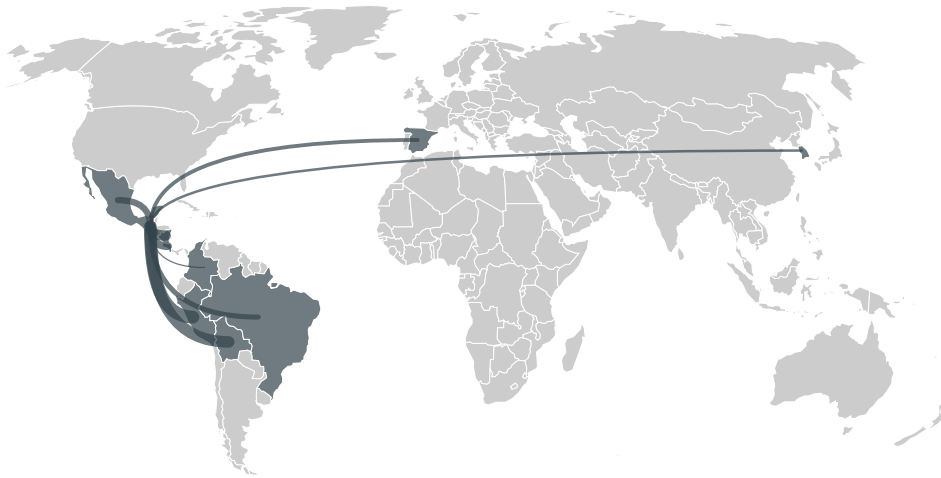


## TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF SOY IN GUATEMALA IN 2014



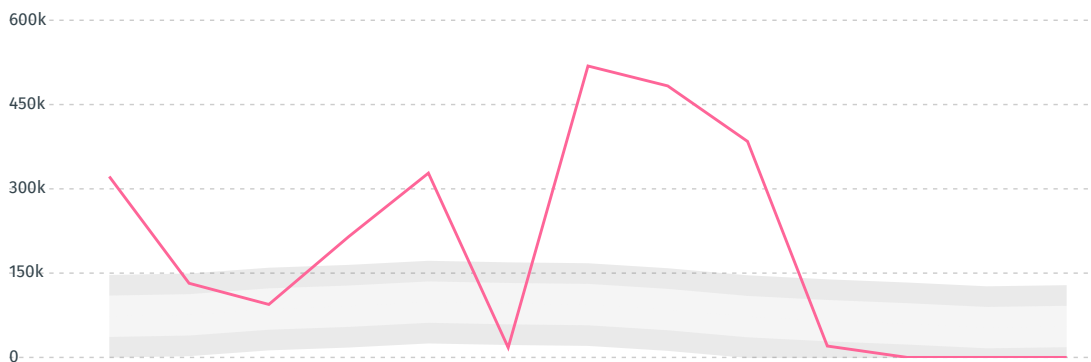

There were **1** GLAD alerts reported in the week of the **18th of January 2021**. This was **low** compared to the same week in previous years.

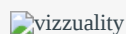
