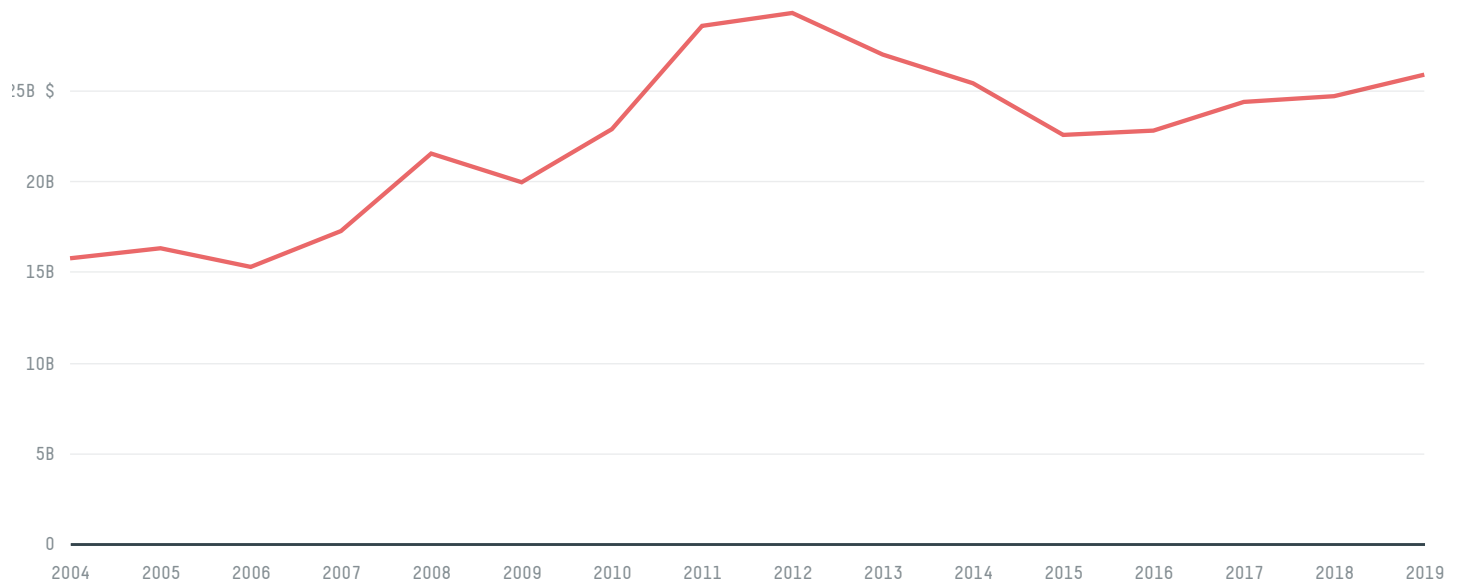

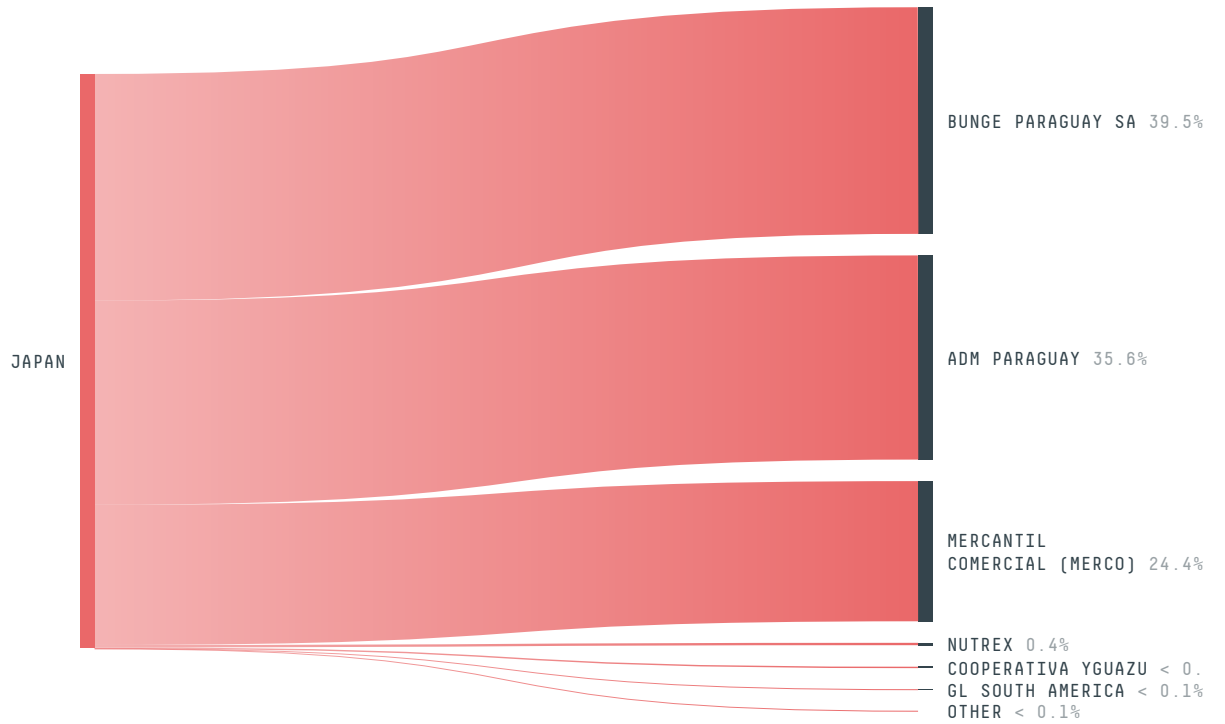

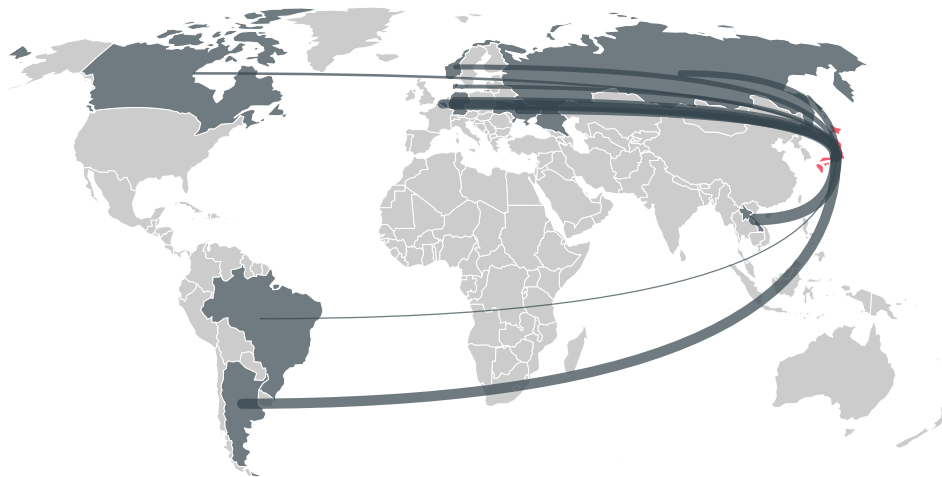
## IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF JAPAN

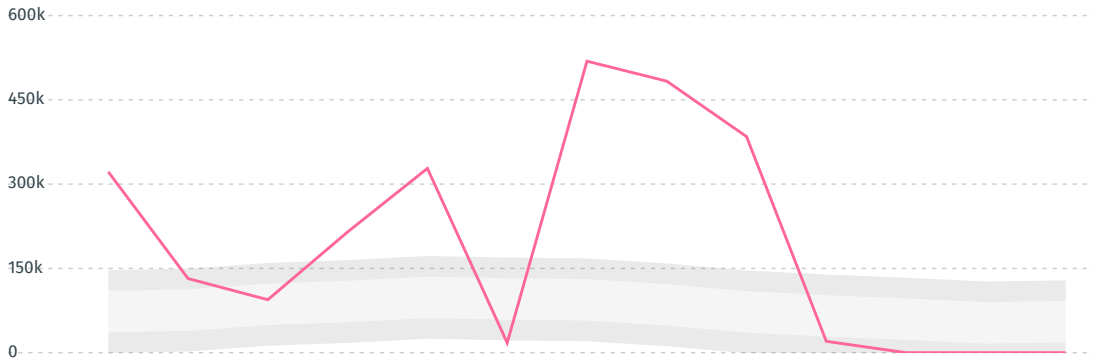
