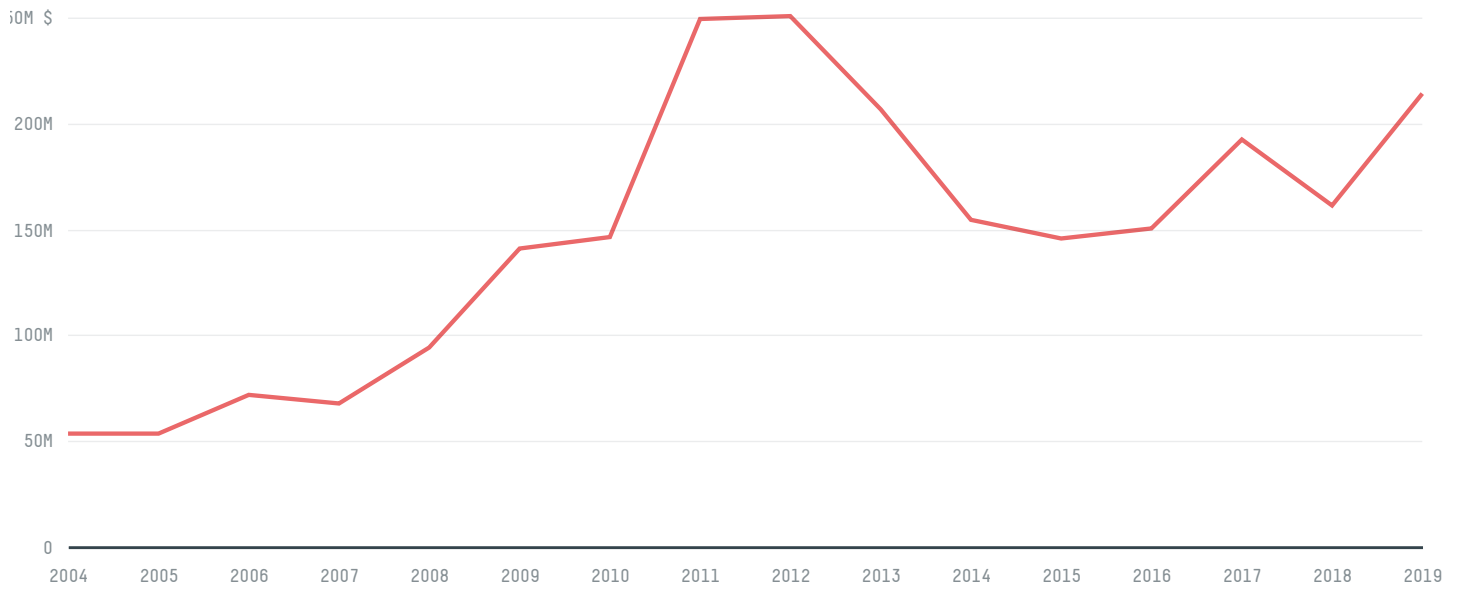

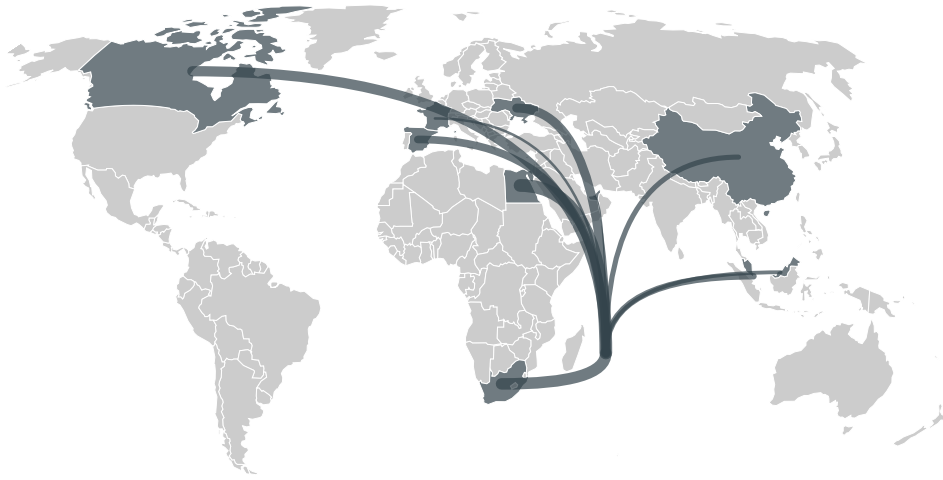


TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF SOY IN MAURITIUS IN 2018
