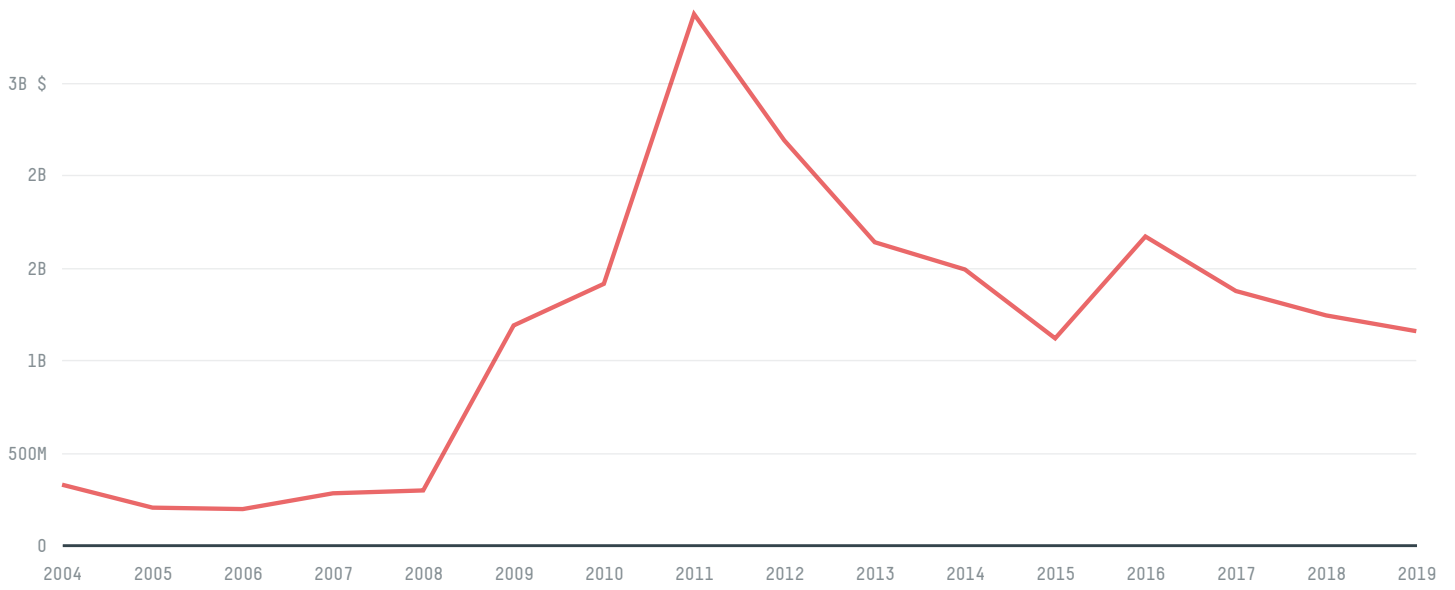

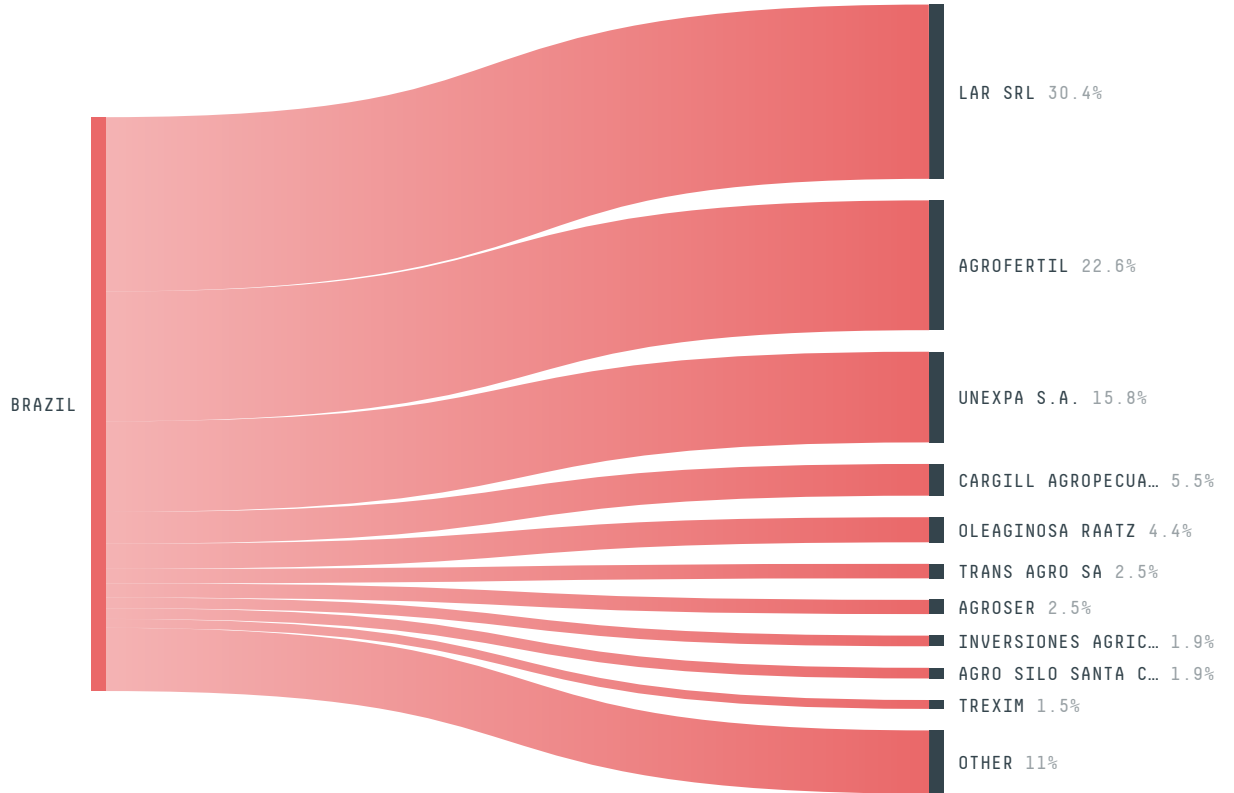

IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF BRAZIL

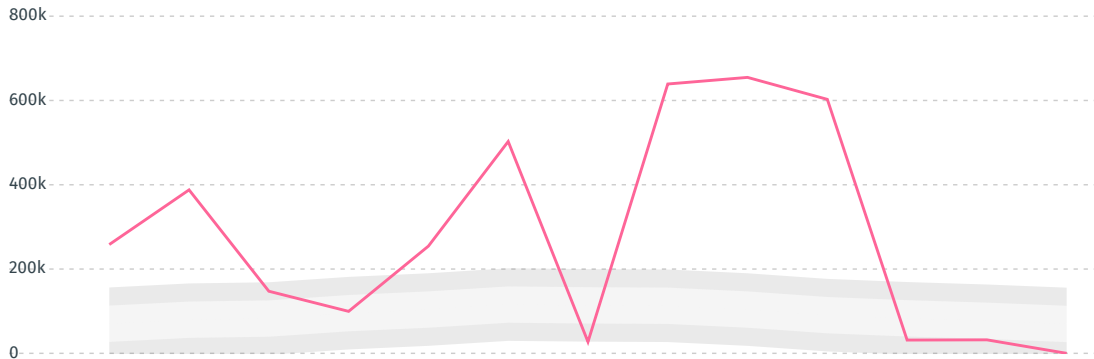


TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF SOY IN BRAZIL IN 2018
