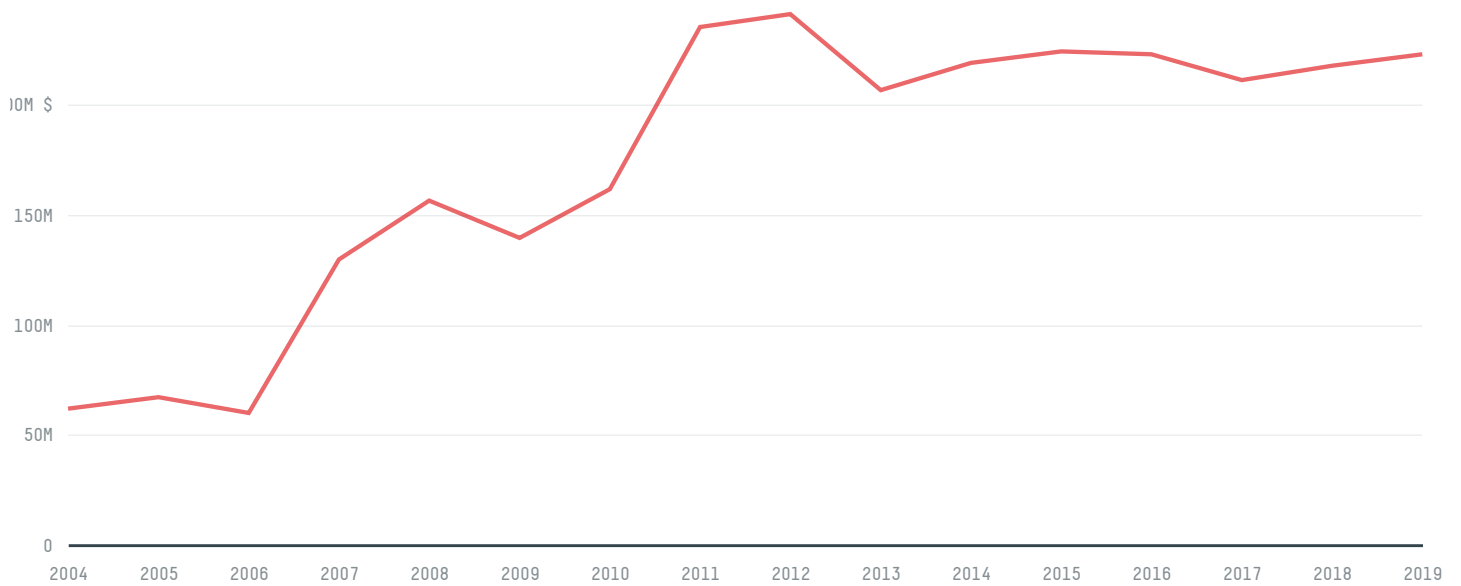

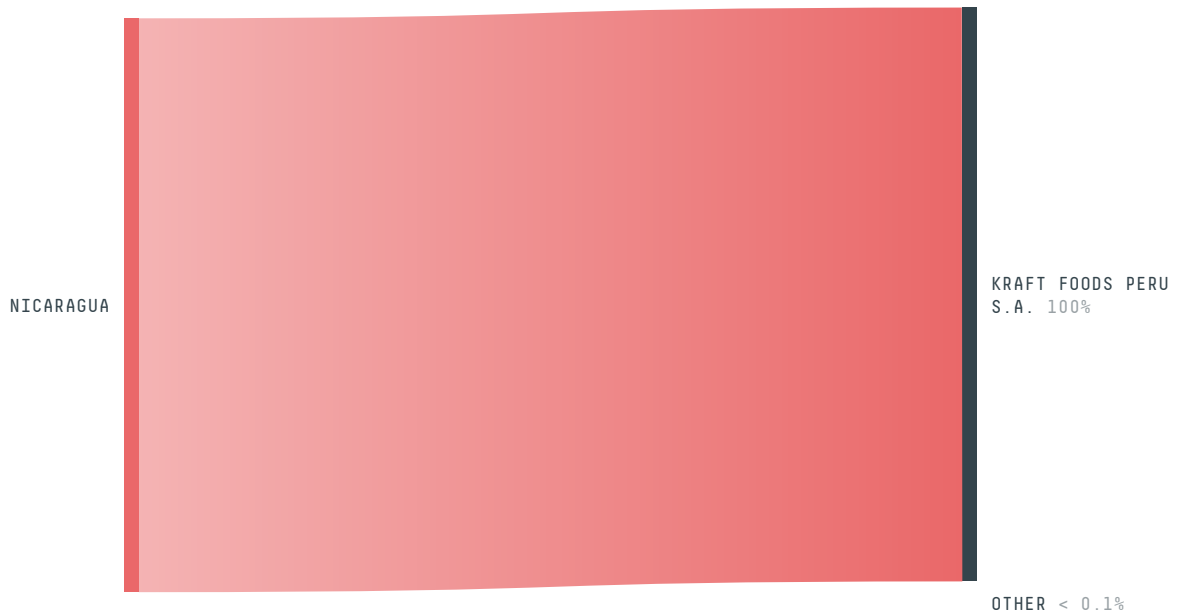

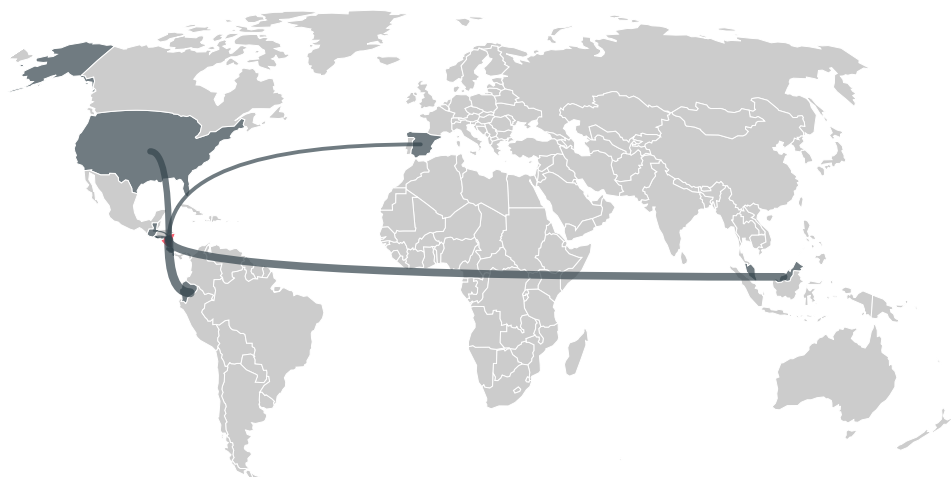
IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF NICARAGUA
