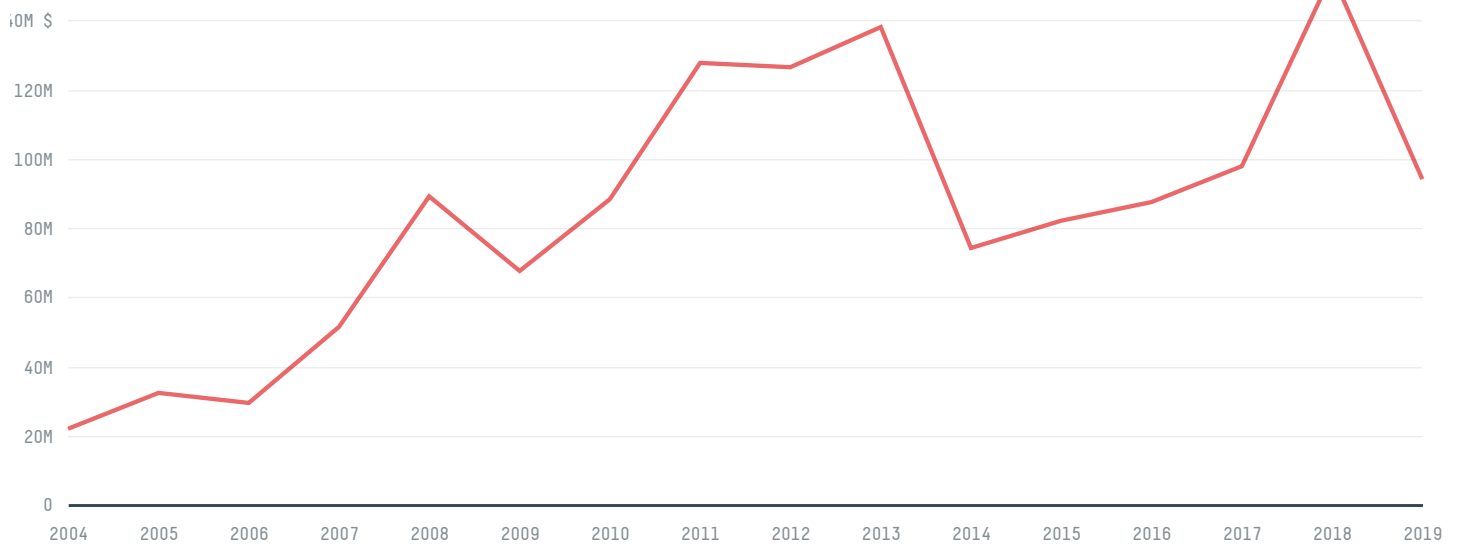

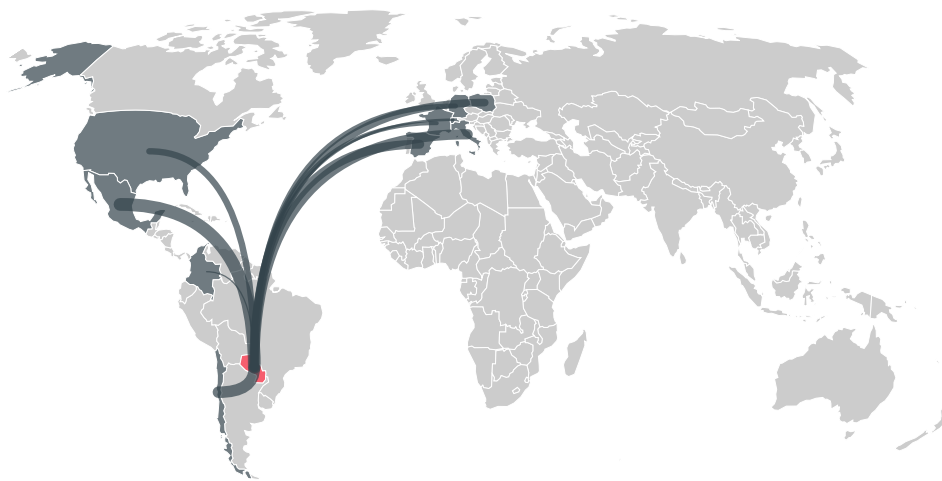
## IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF PARAGUAY

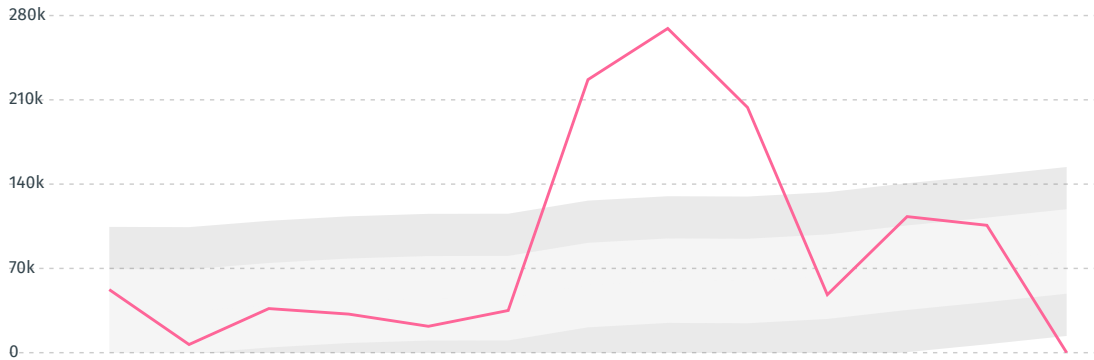
