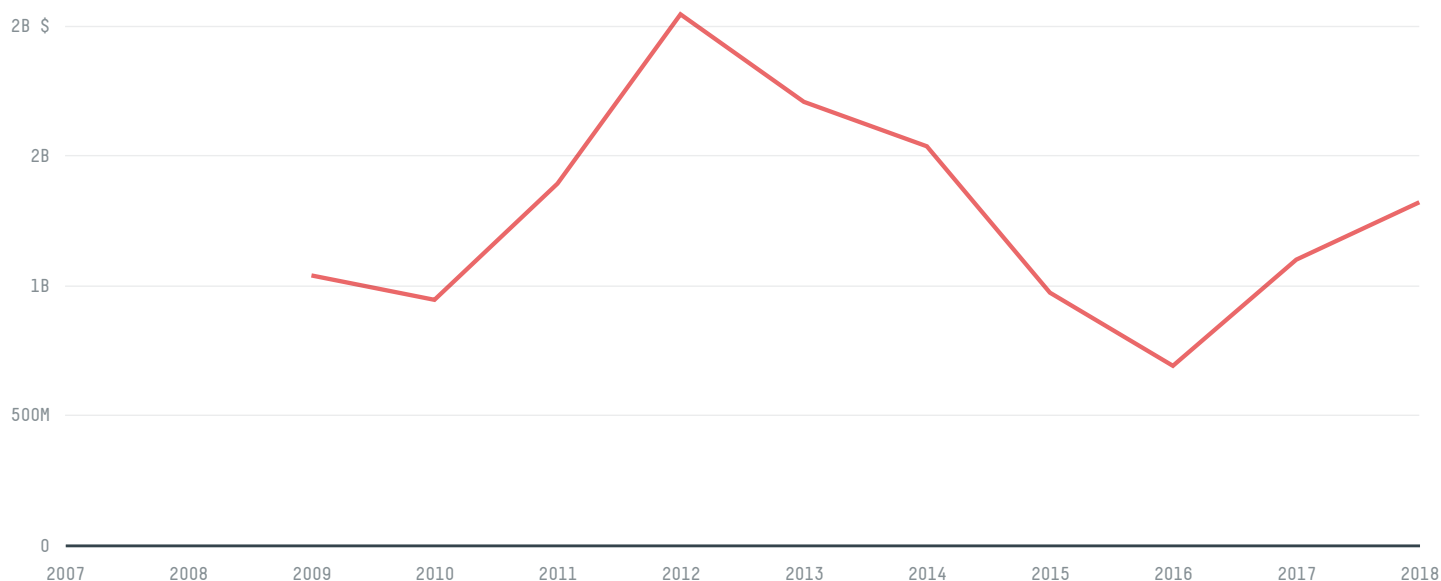

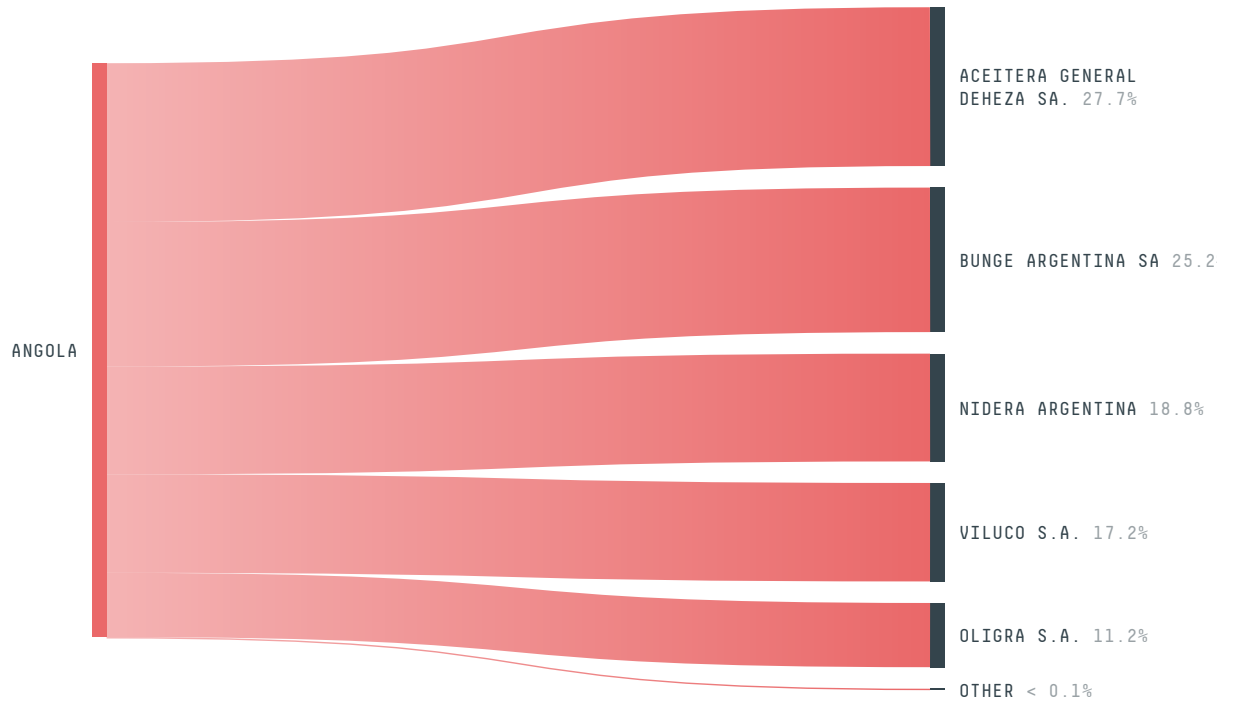

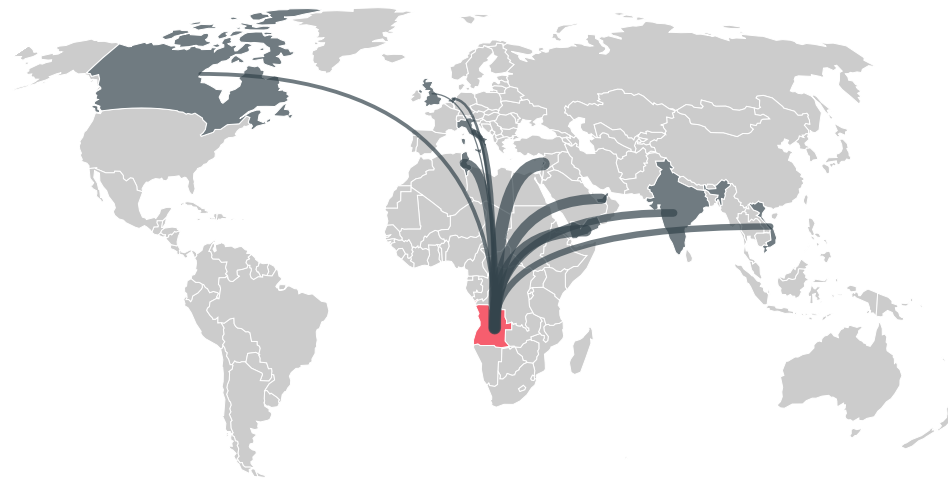
IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF ANGOLA

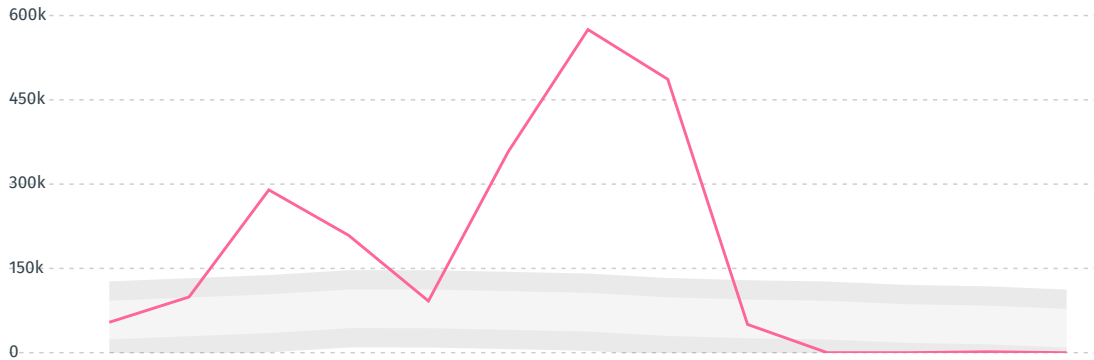
