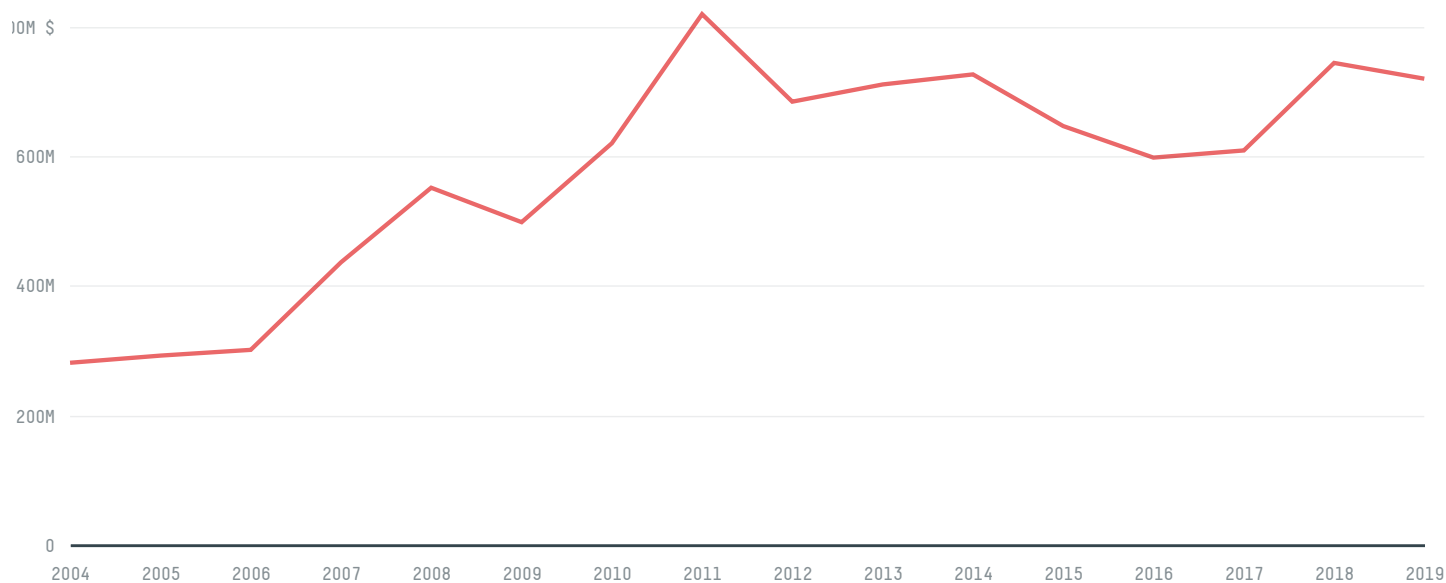

IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF ECUADOR

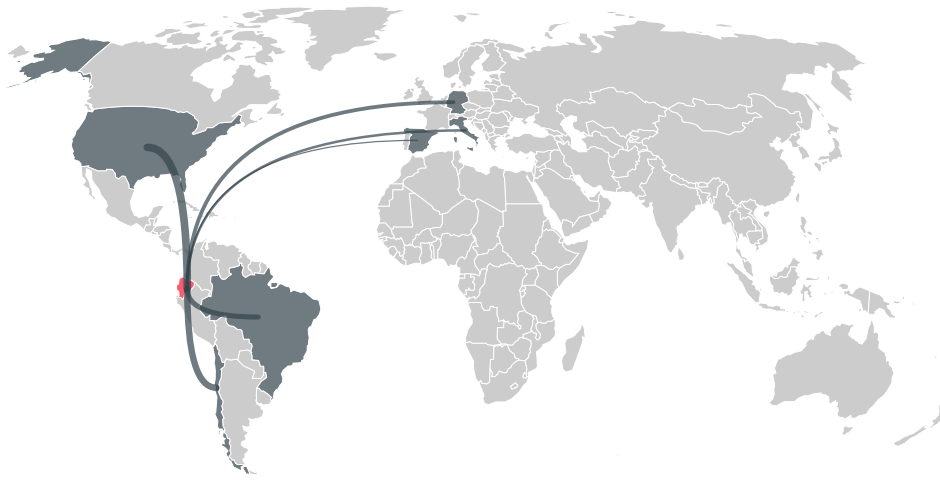

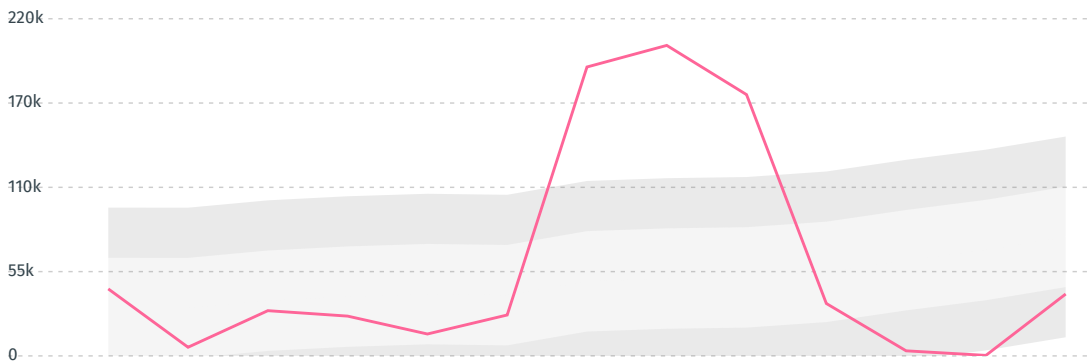
