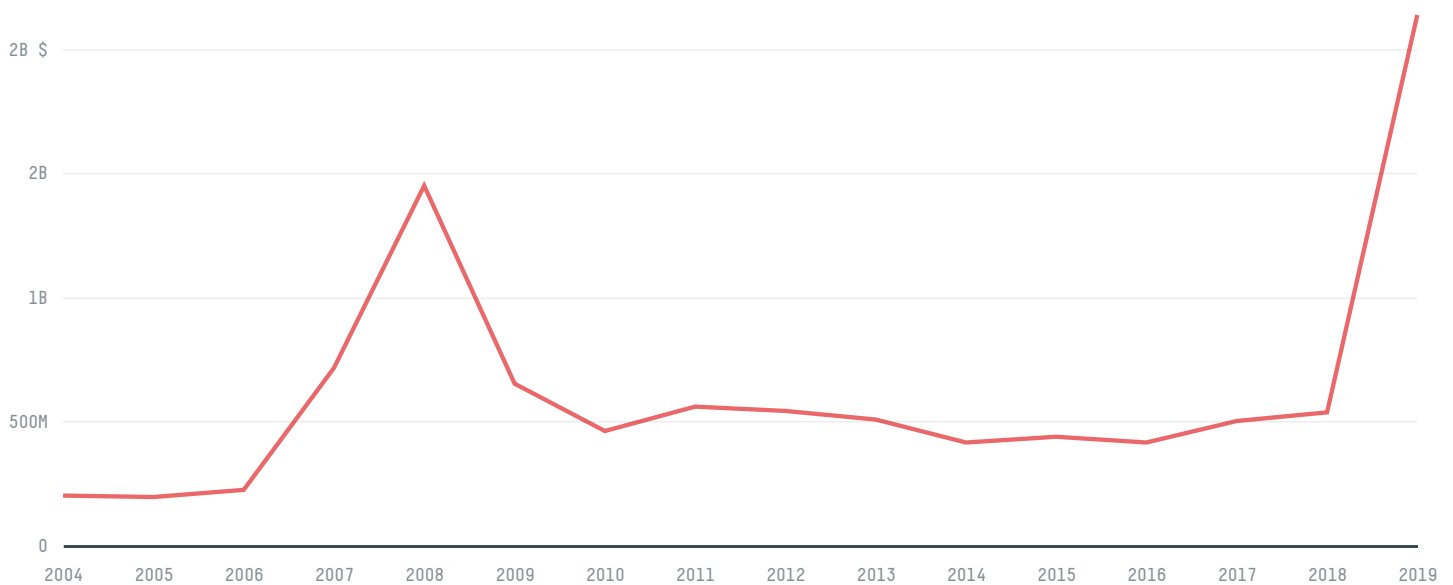

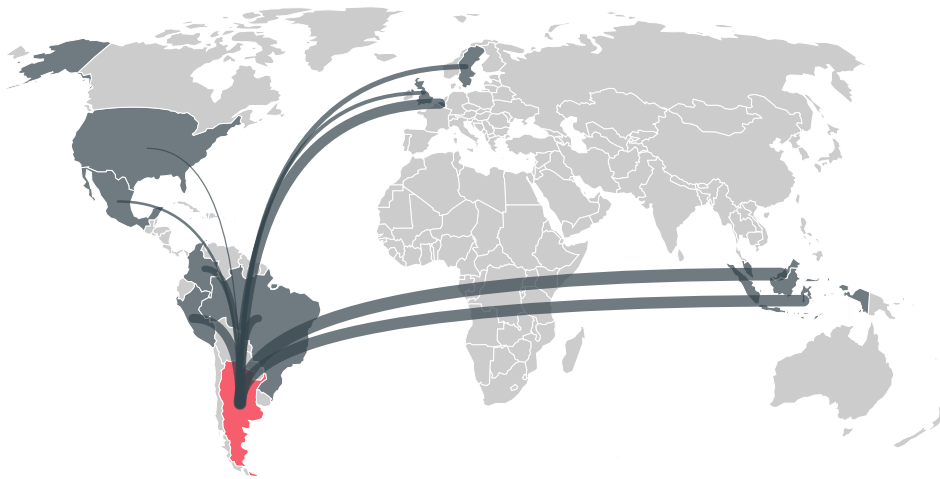
IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF ARGENTINA
