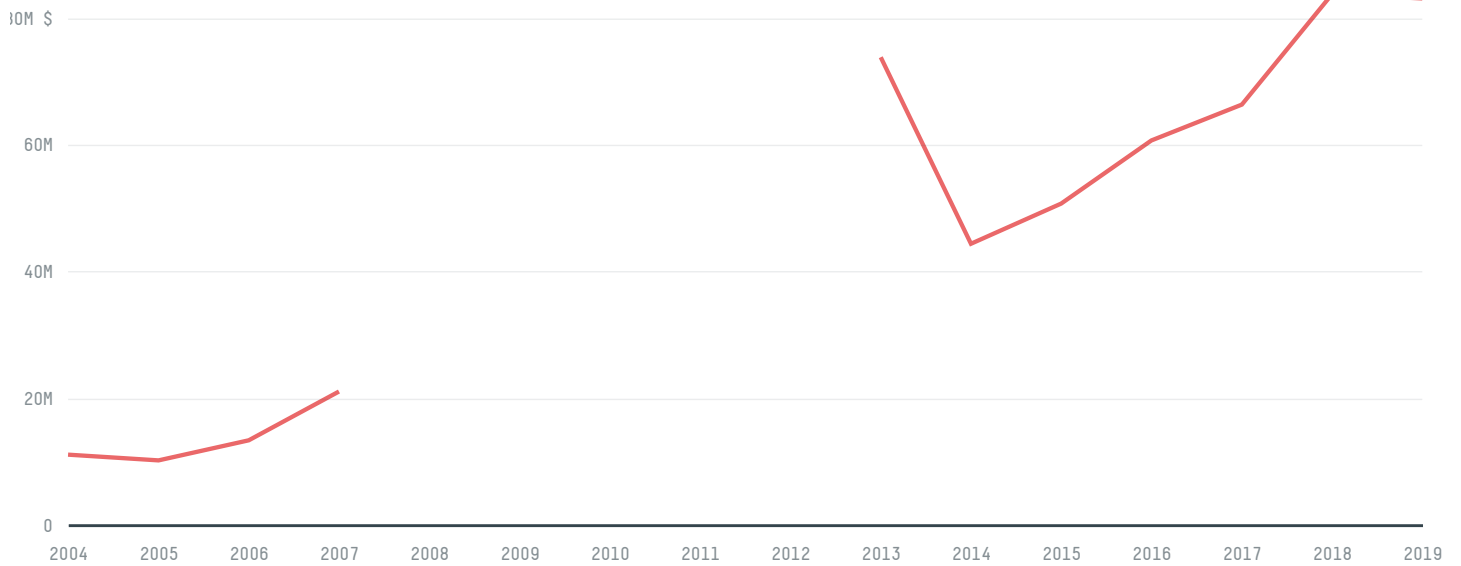

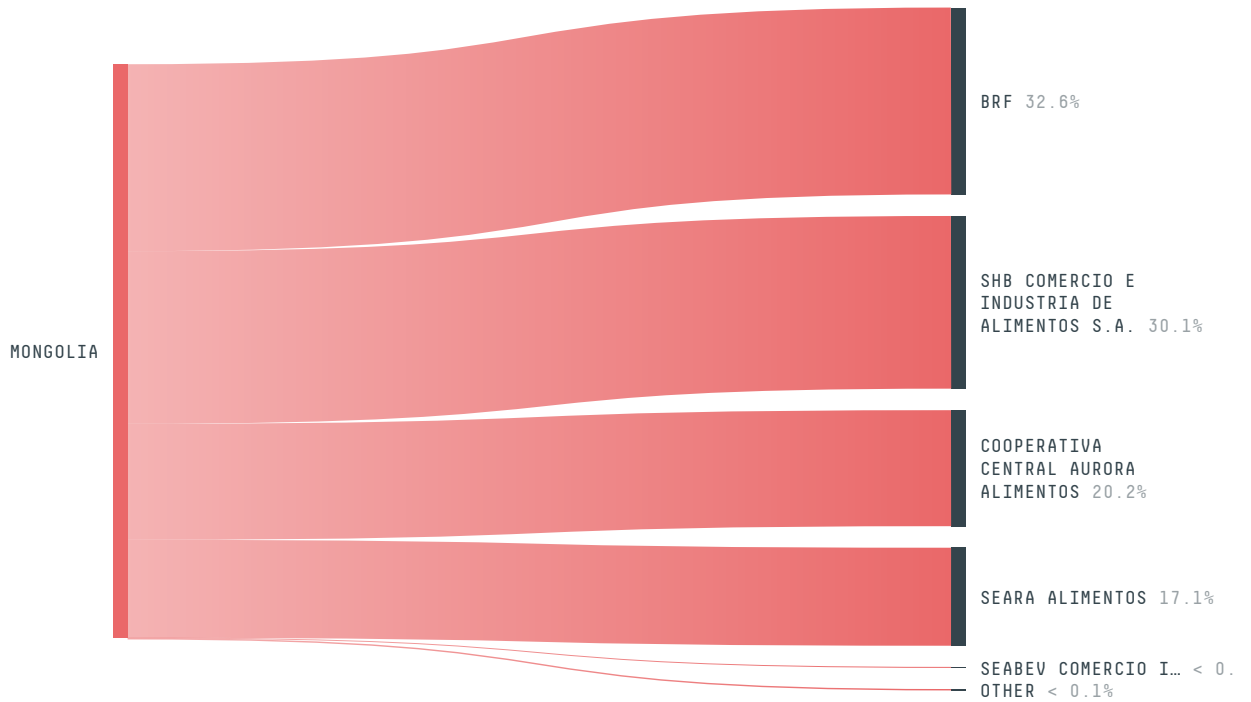

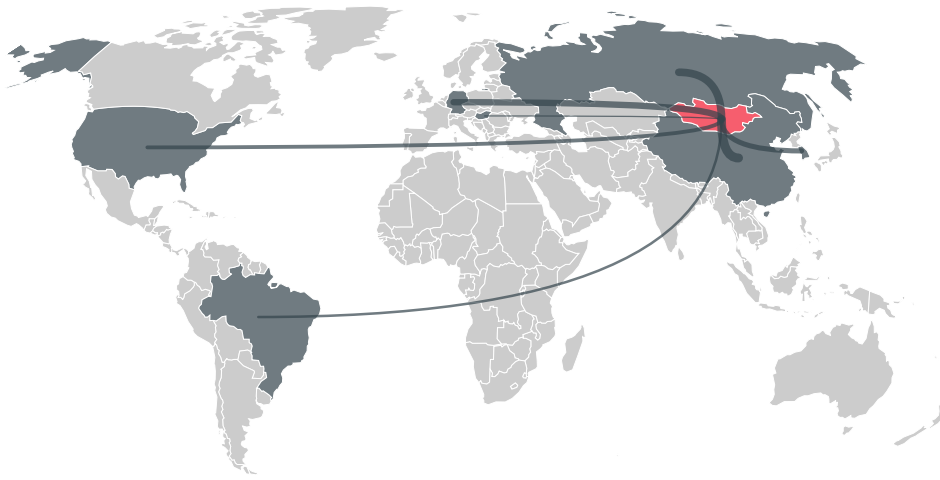
## IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF MONGOLIA



## TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF CHICKEN IN MONGOLIA IN 2018



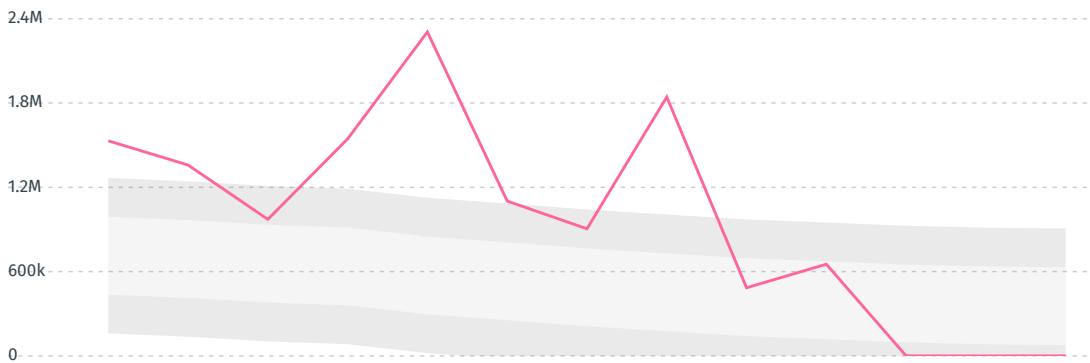
