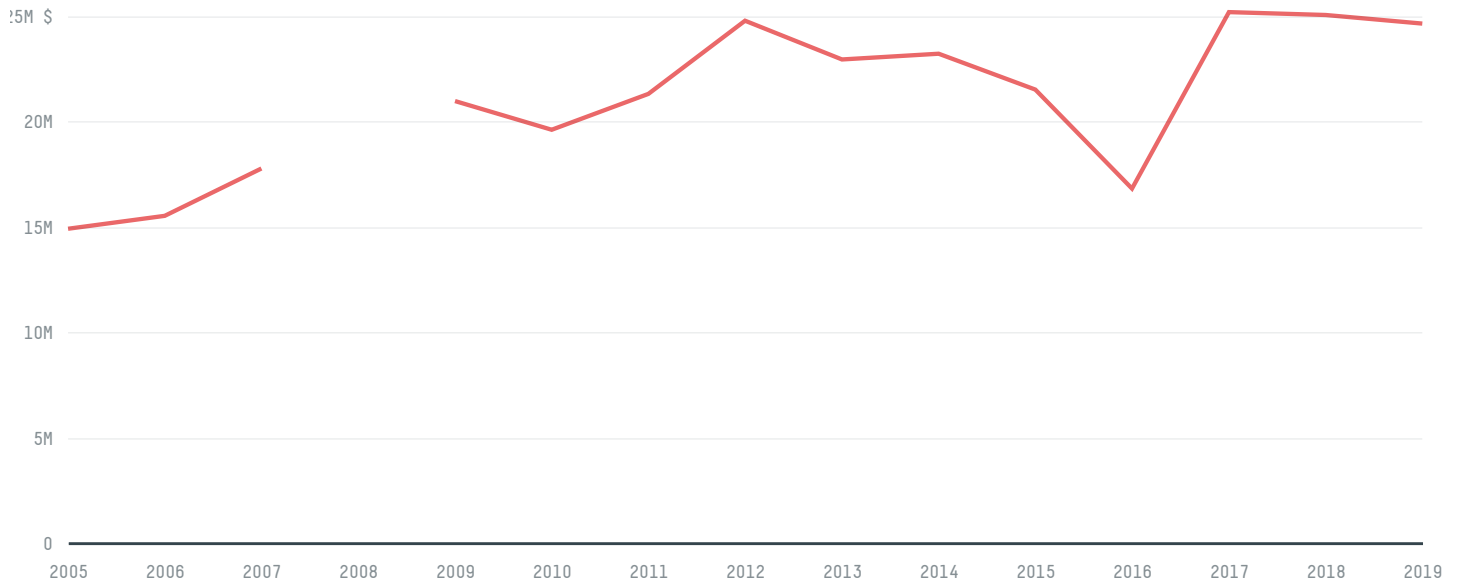

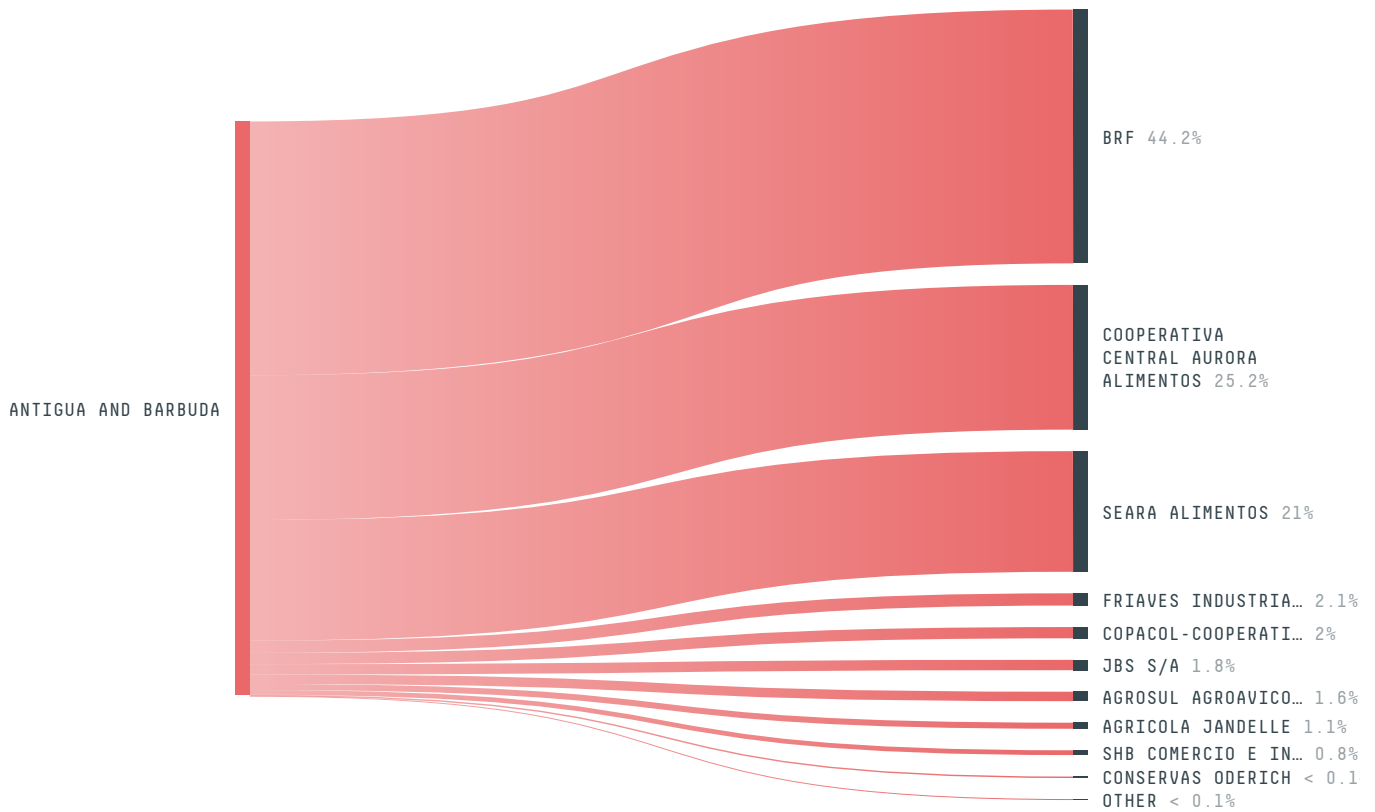

IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA

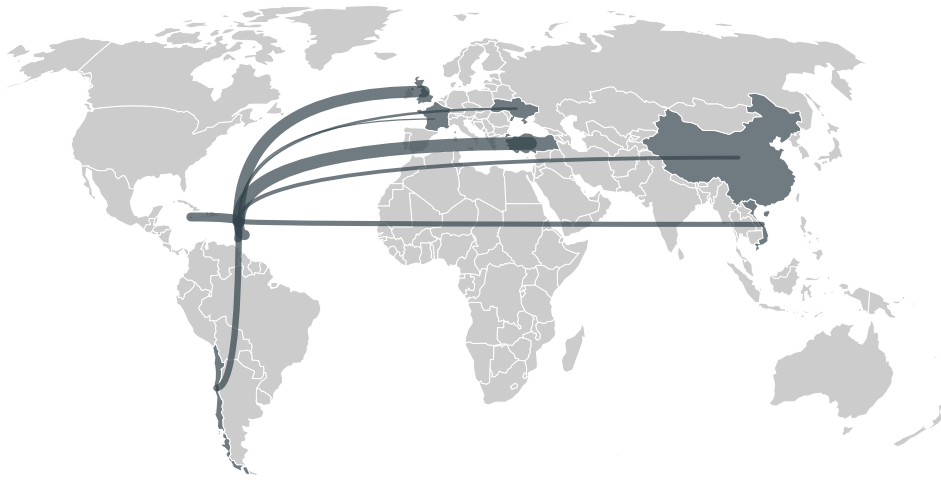


TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF CHICKEN IN ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA IN 2018



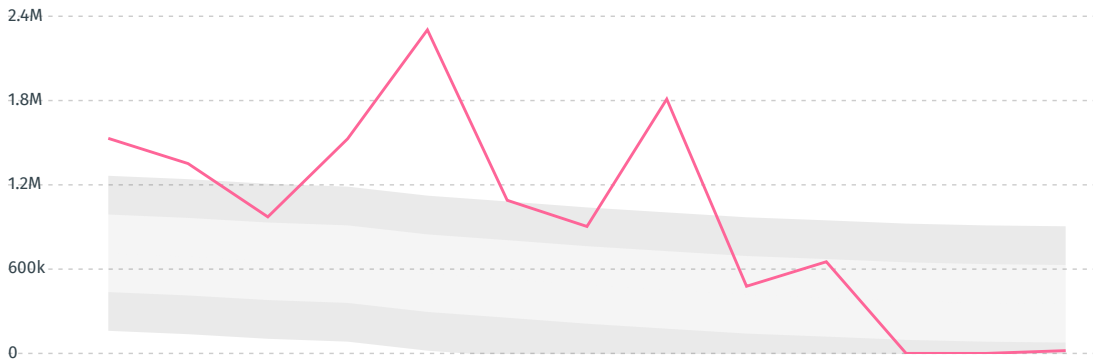

There were **19,863** GLAD alerts reported in the week of the **18th of January 2021**. This was **low** compared to the same week in previous years.

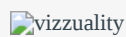
