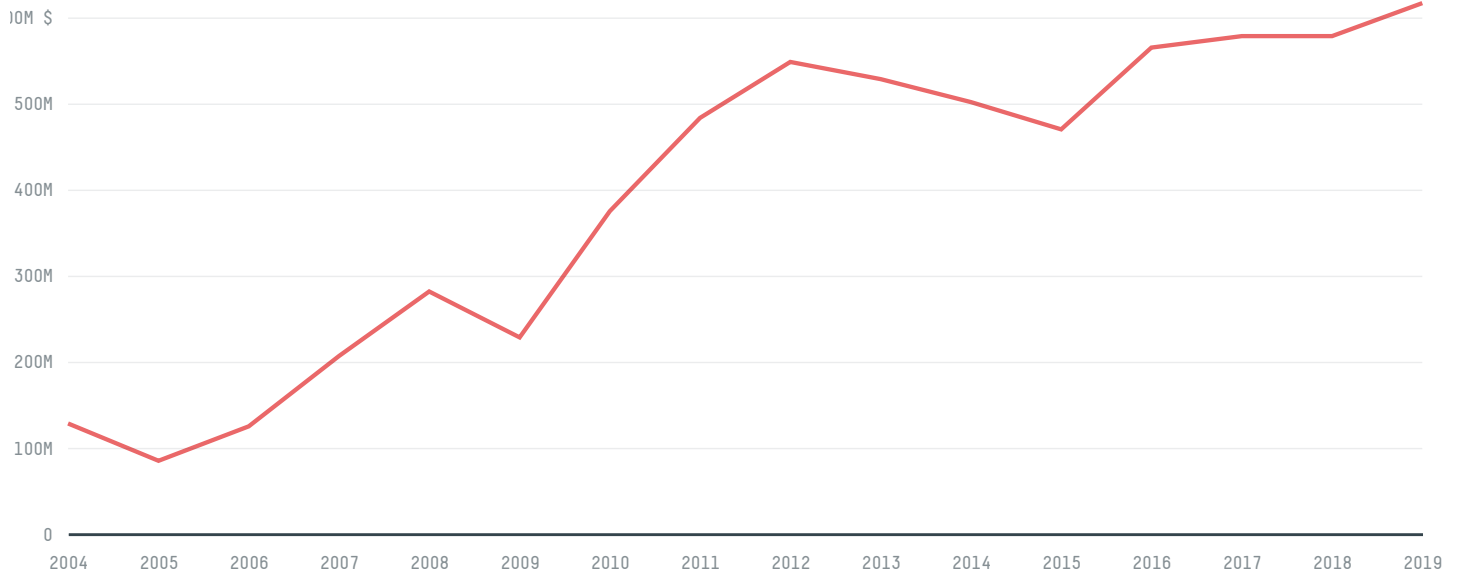

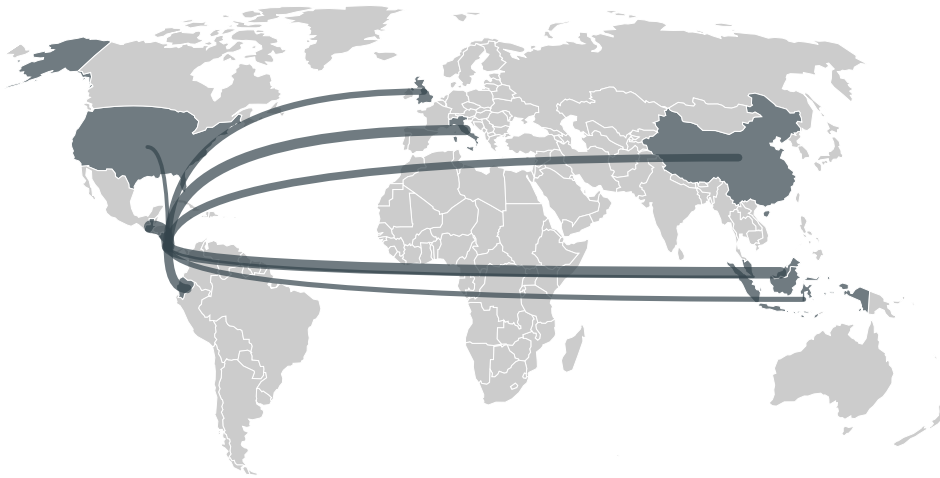
IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF COSTA RICA



TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF PALM OIL IN COSTA RICA IN 2018



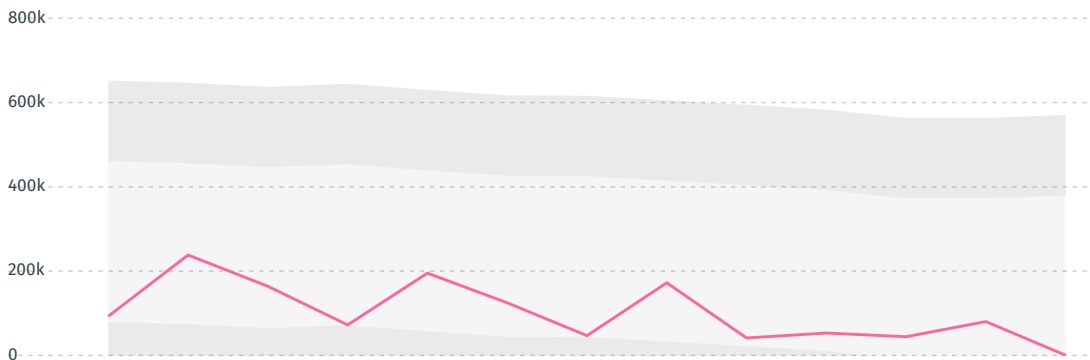

There were **376** GLAD alerts reported in the week of the **25th of January 2021**. This was **normal** compared to the same week in previous years.

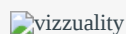
