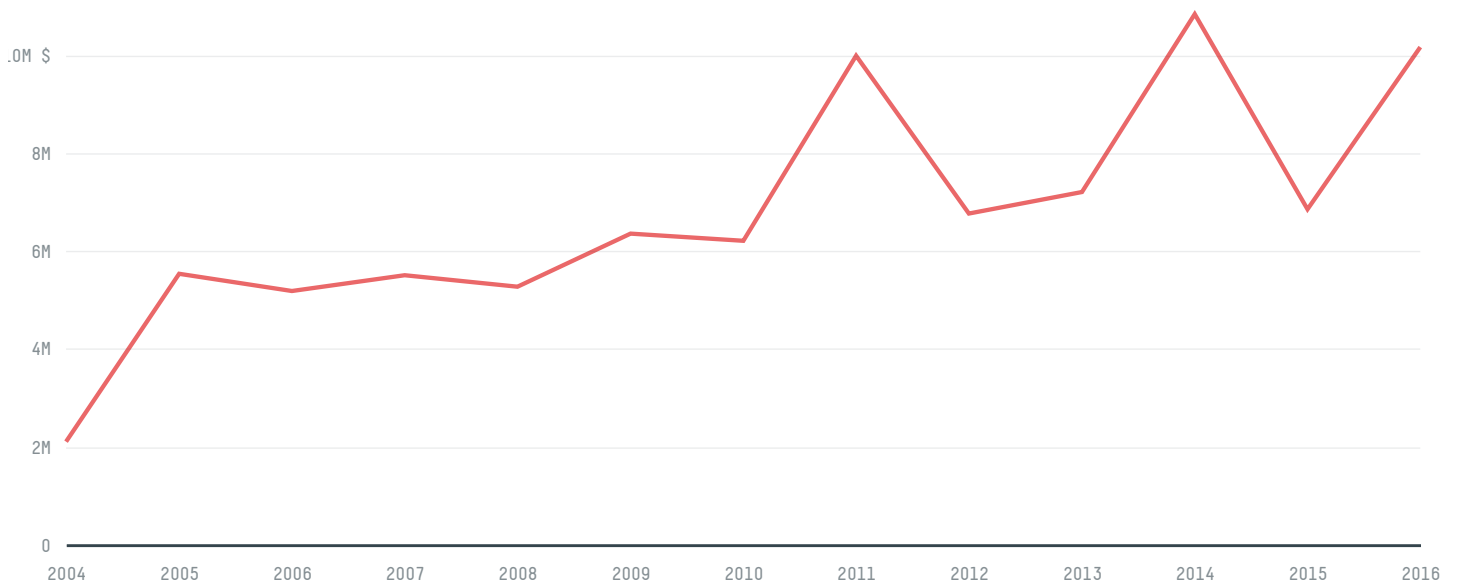

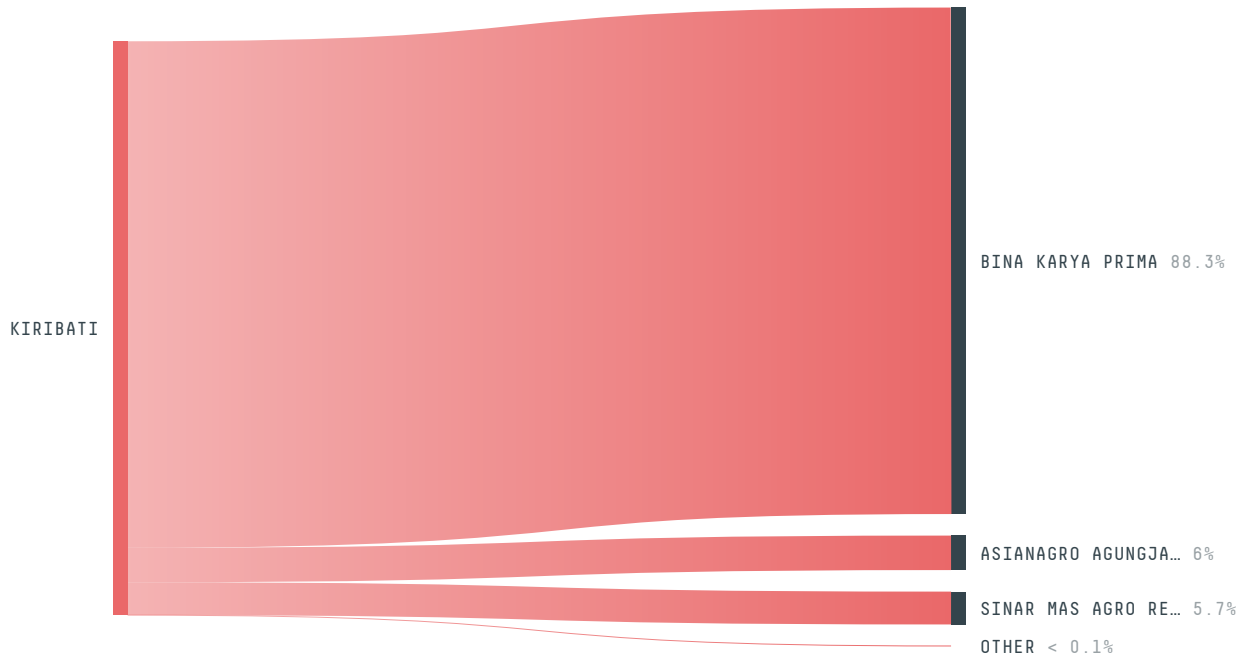

## TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF PALM OIL IN KIRIBATI IN 2018

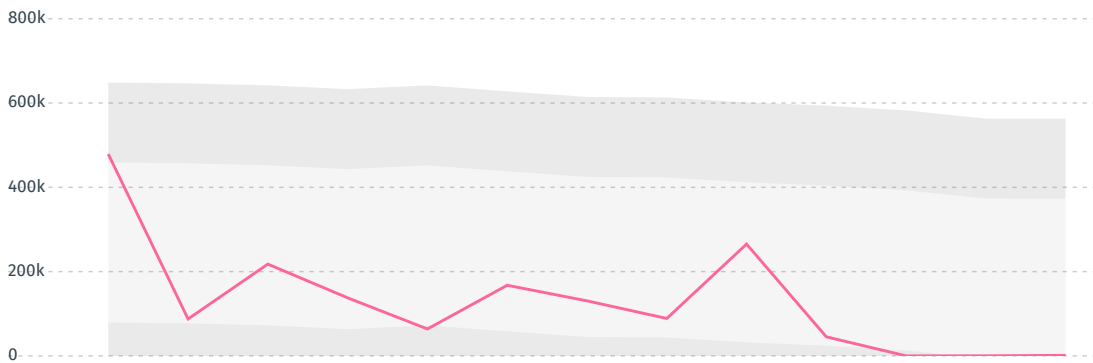


## TOP EXPORT COUNTRIES OF PALM OIL TO KIRIBATI IN 2018
