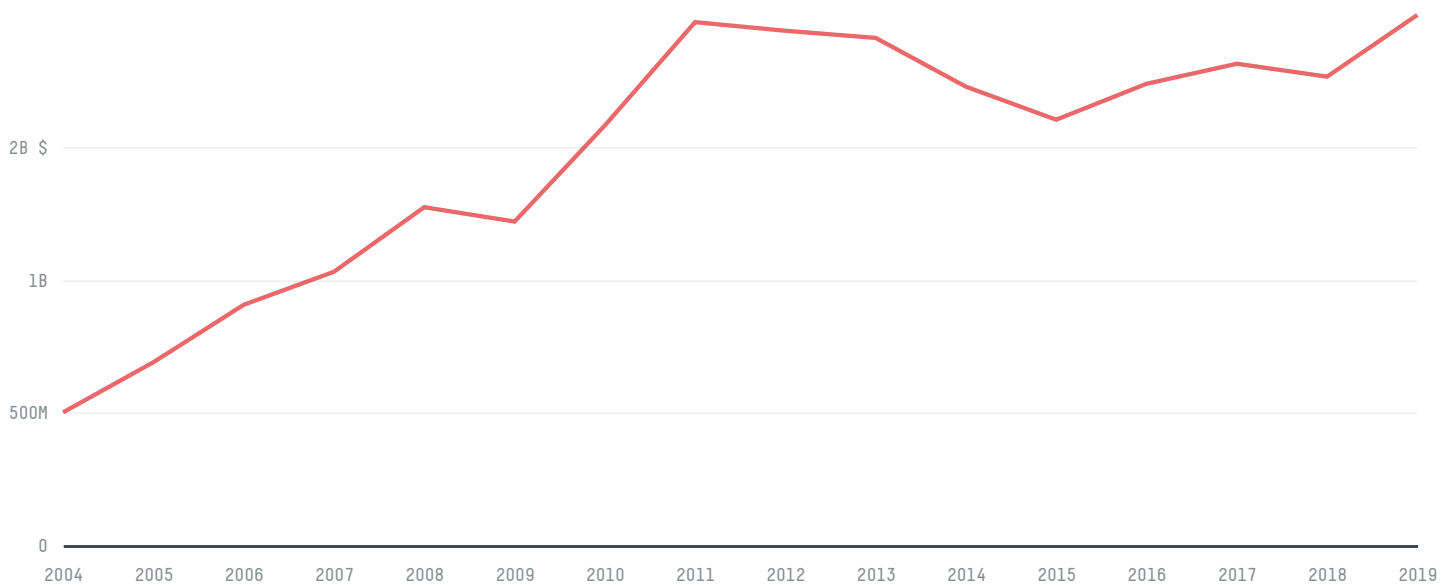

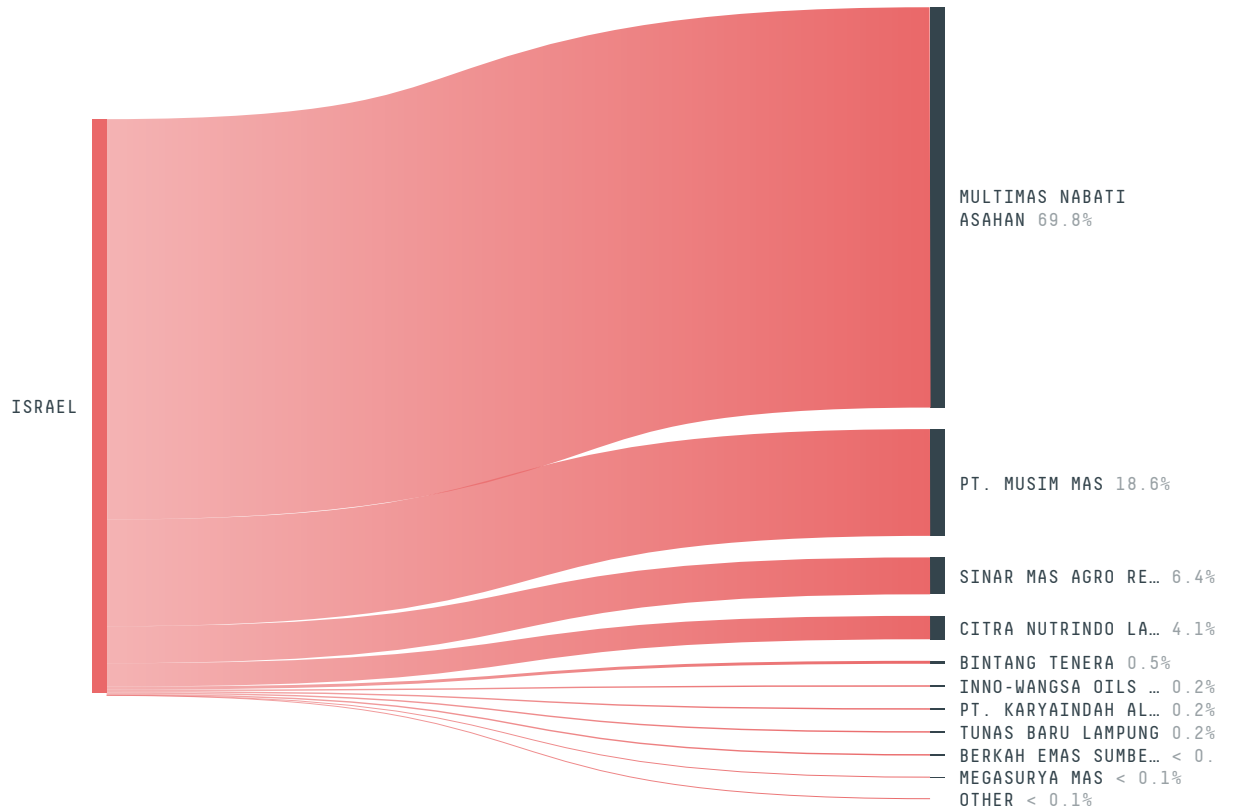

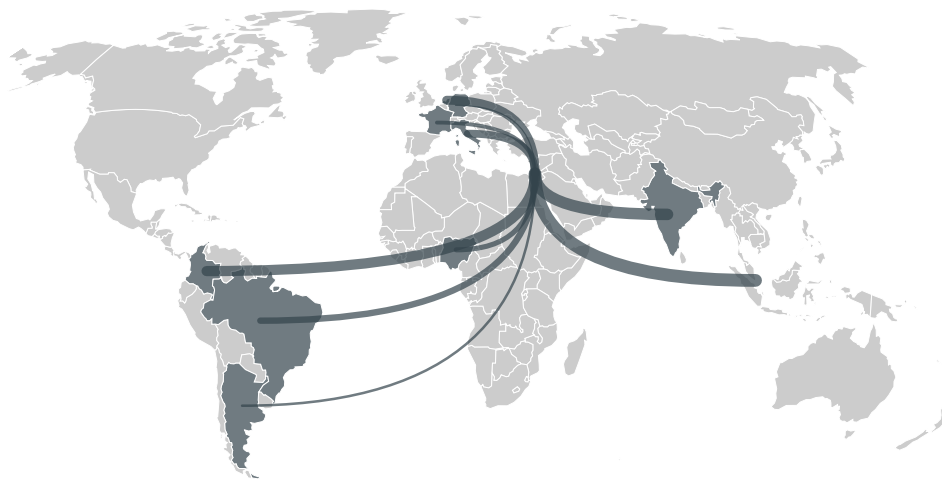
IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF ISRAEL



TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF PALM OIL IN ISRAEL IN 2018



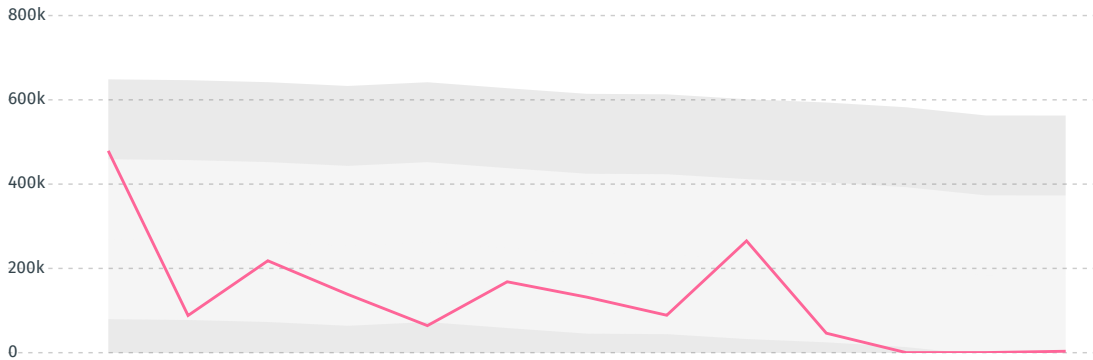

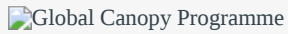
DEFORESTATION ALERTS IN INDONESIA

There were **3,431** GLAD alerts reported in the week of the **18th of January 2021**. This was **normal** compared to the same week in previous years.

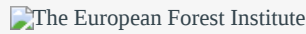
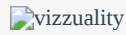
