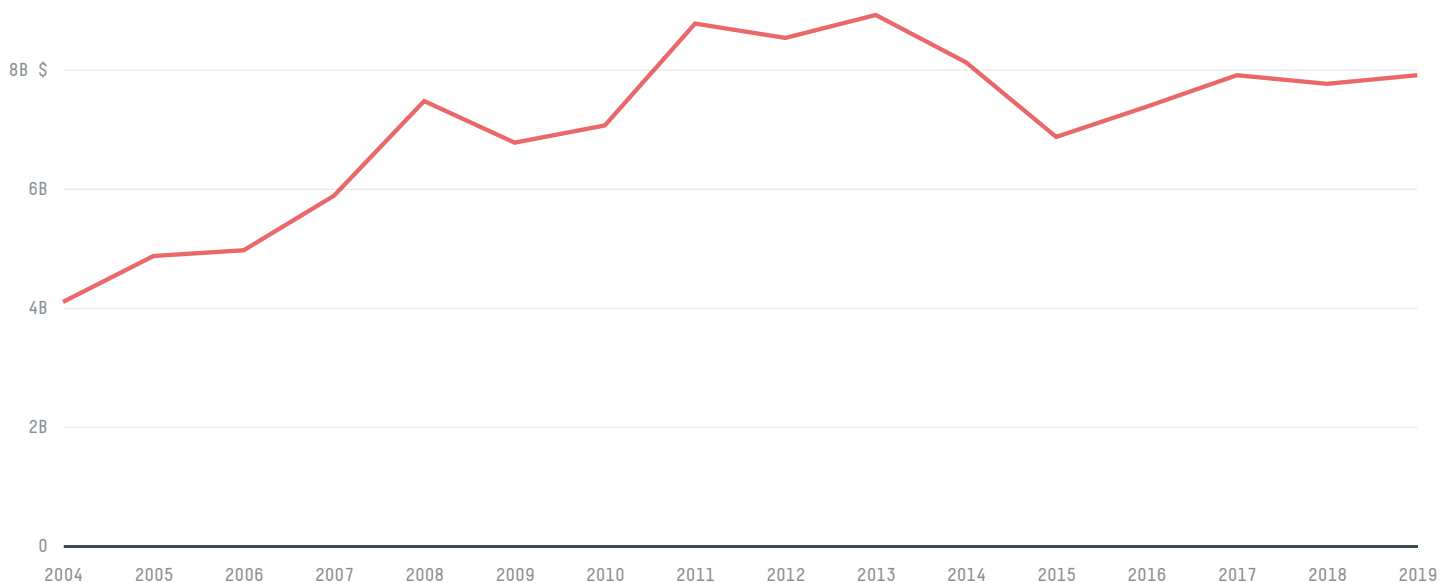

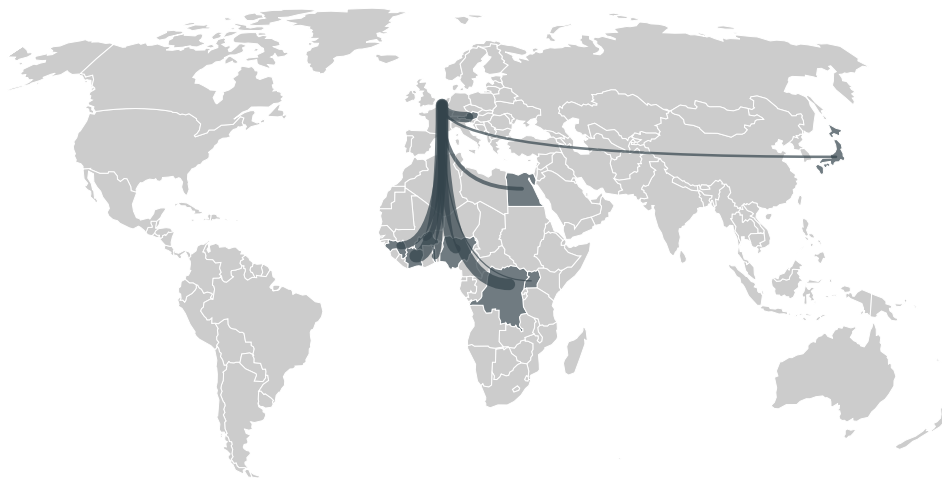
IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF BELGIUM
