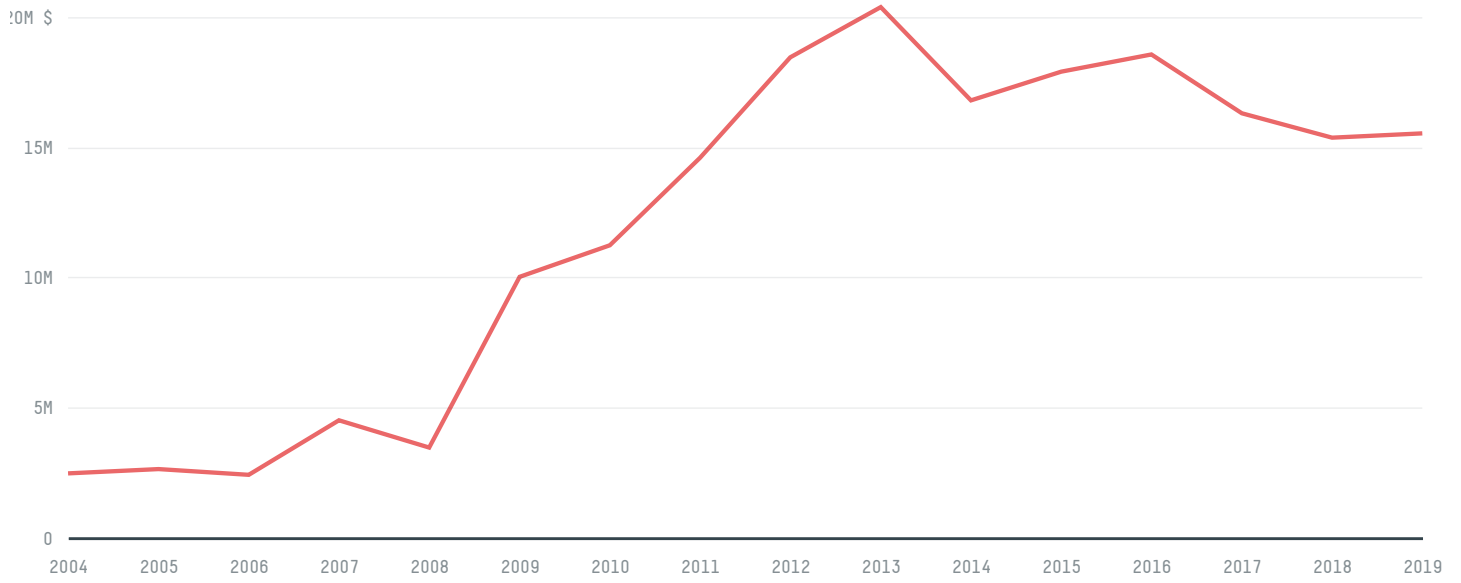

TOP EXPORT COUNTRIES OF COFFEE TO BELIZE IN 2017



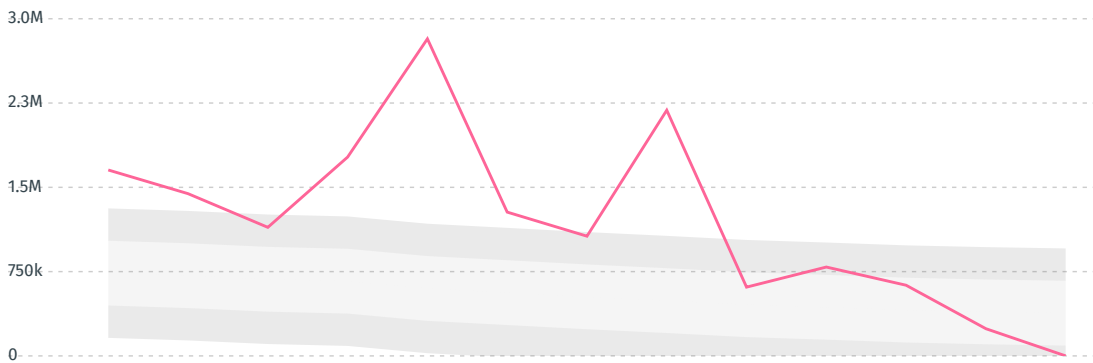
