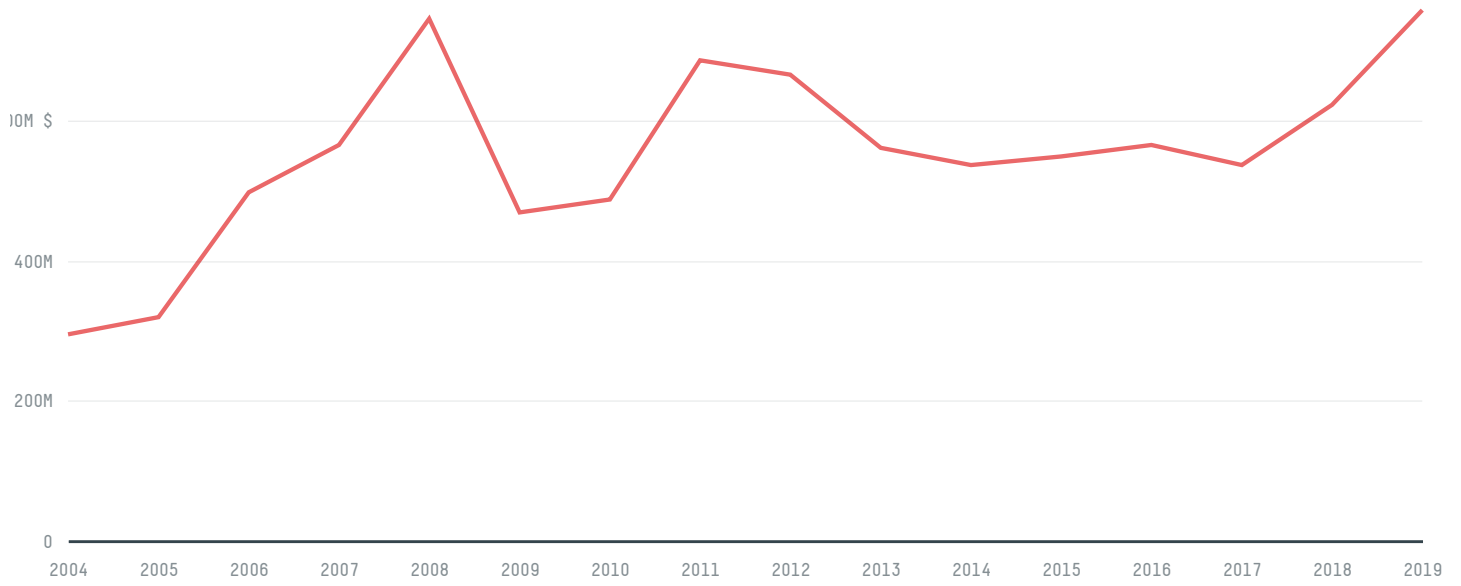

IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF EL SALVADOR

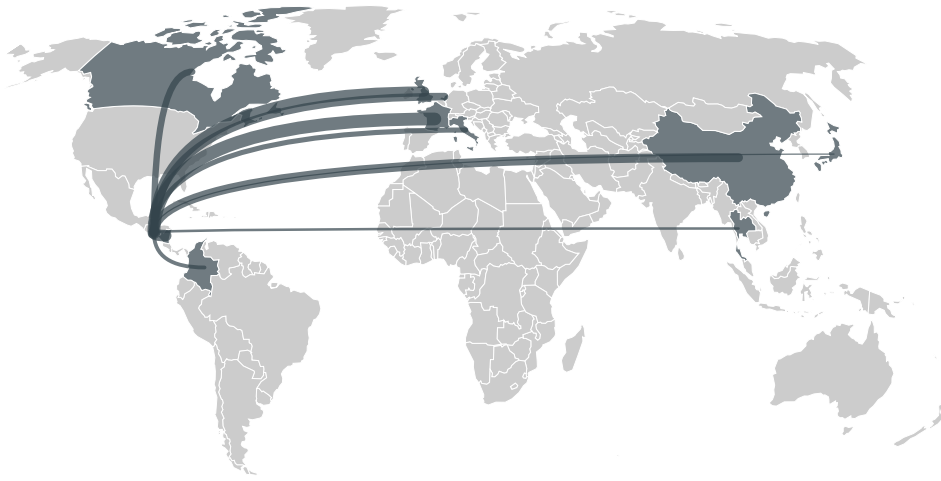


TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF CORN IN EL SALVADOR IN 2017
