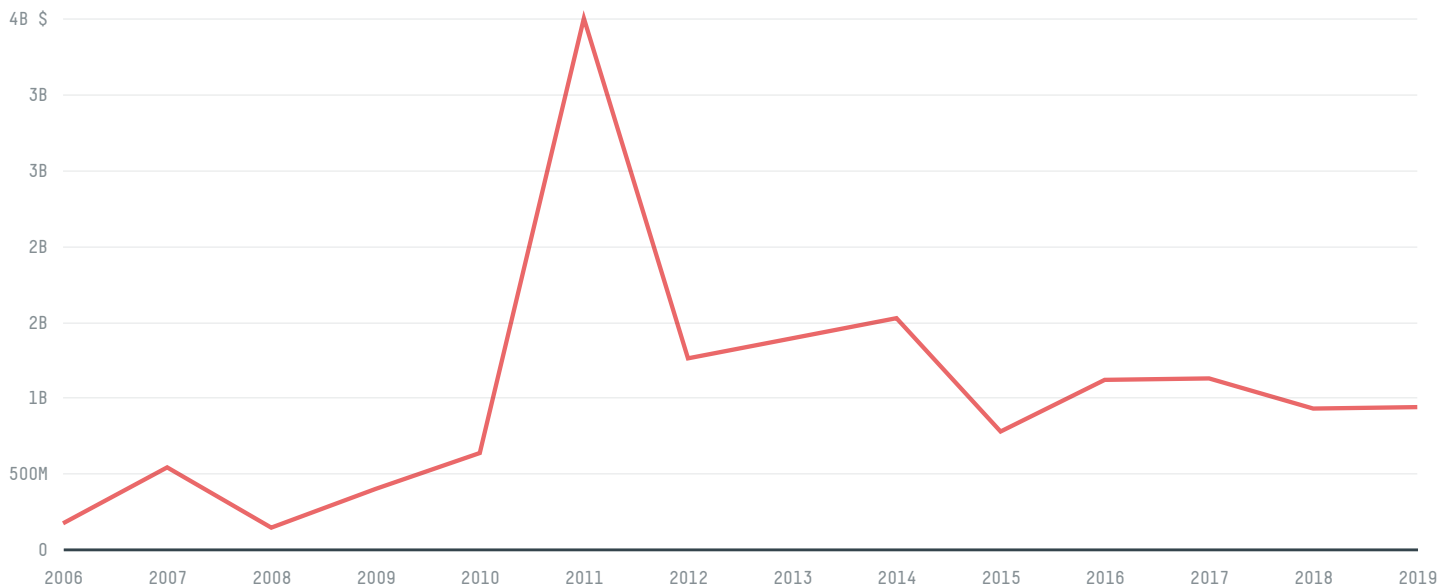

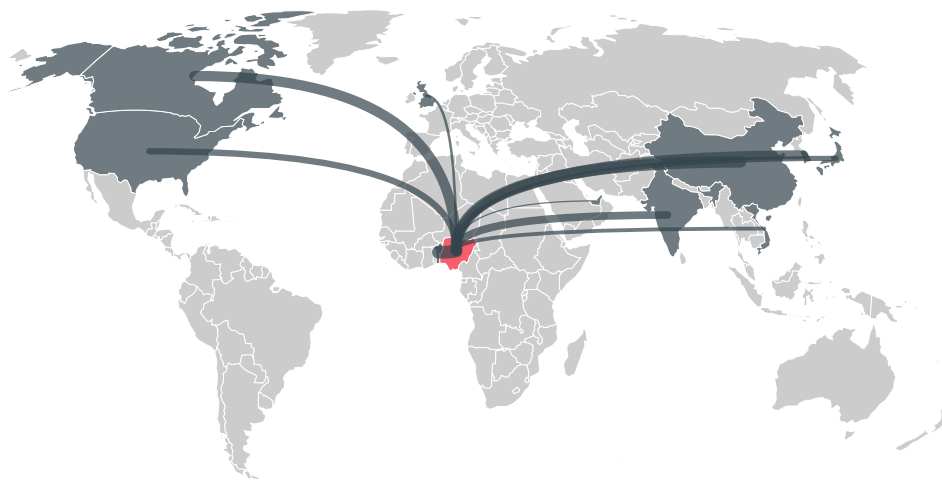
## IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF NIGERIA



## TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF COTTON IN NIGERIA IN 2016



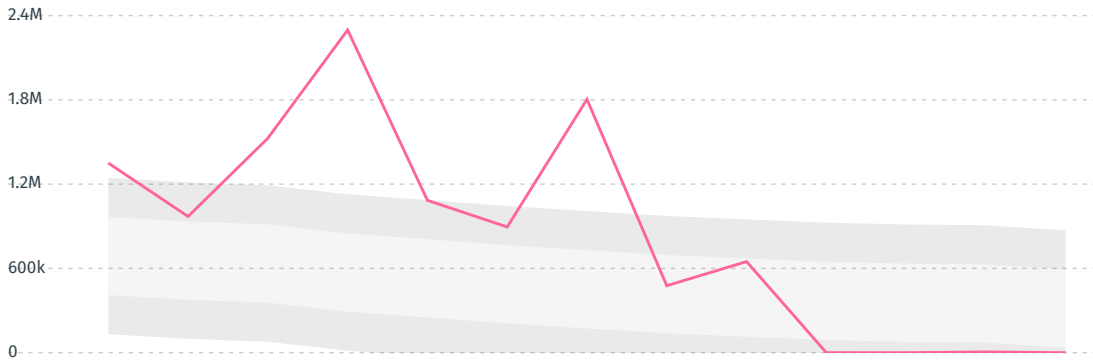
