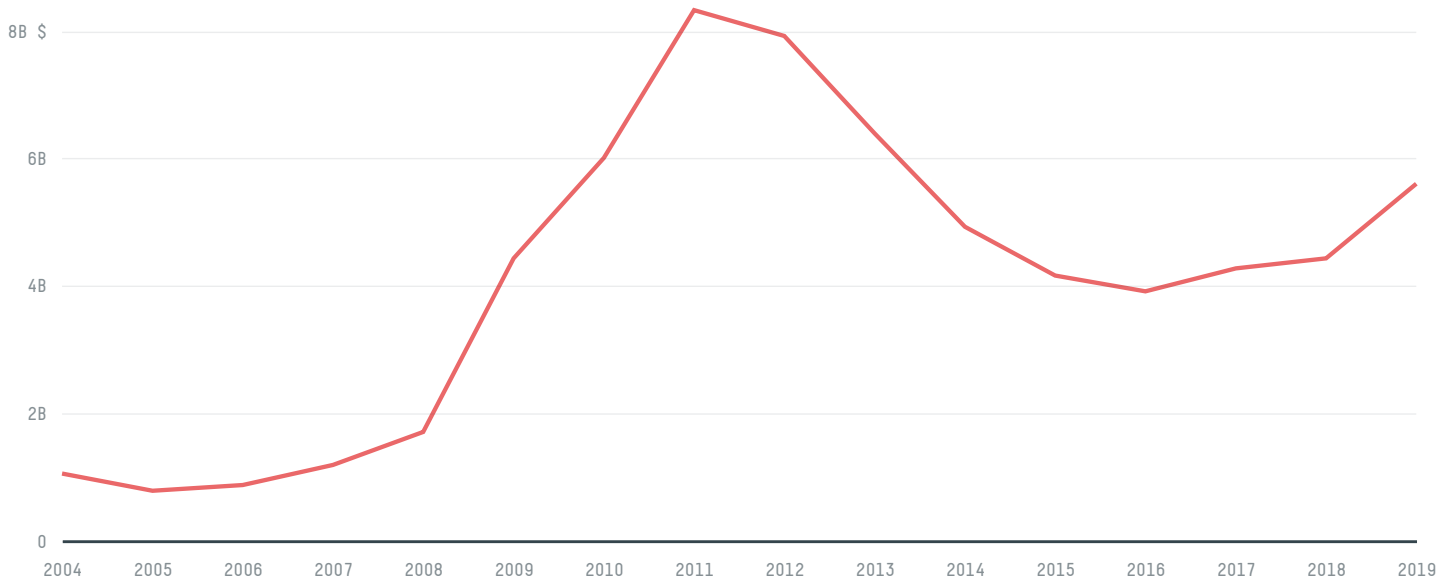

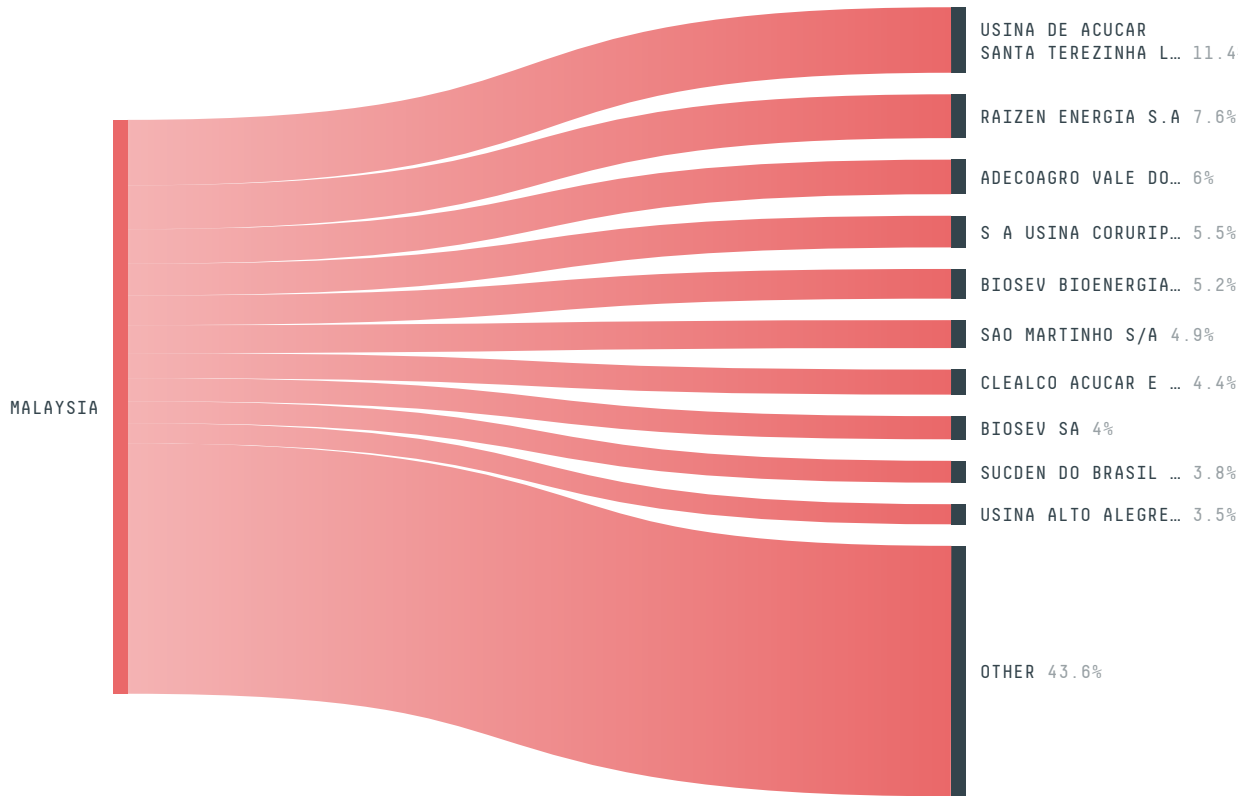

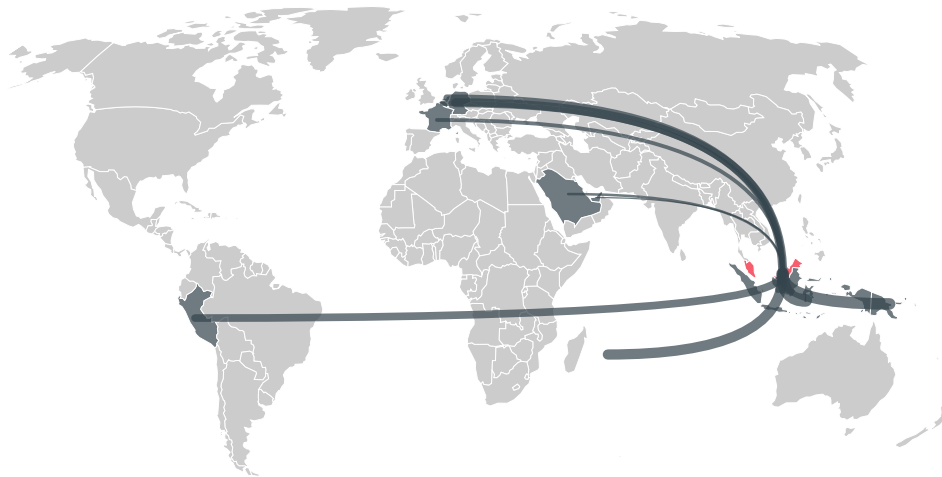
## IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF MALAYSIA

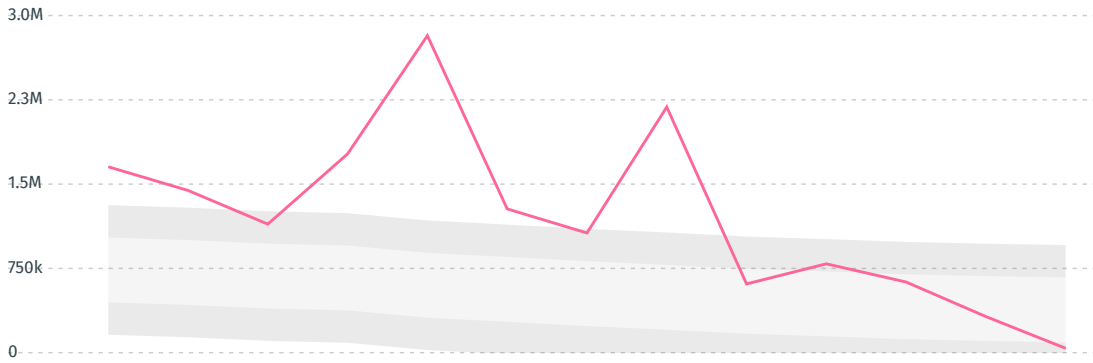
